Exclusions Module

This module will provide delegates with an understanding of the key causes of autistic pupils being excluded from school and how teaching staff can prevent exclusion occurring or, when it does occur, to provide support for the pupil's successful return or transition to their next placement.

Who is this training for?

This session is suitable for practitioners working with autistic children in mainstream or specialist schools.

What will you learn?

The training will support delegates to:

- understand the legal context of exclusion and autism
- understand the risk of illegal exclusion and how to avoid it occurring
- better understand the triggers and ways of managing distressed behaviours
- eflect on ways to support autistic pupils and their families during the period of exclusion
- Consider ways of transitioning the autistic pupils back into school and how to manage the reintegration meeting.
