The Fostering Process

We've simplified the process of fostering into four steps:

 Read our newsletter – but you already know that!

If we're all ready to go then we can get started (we collect paperwork etc) – if you need more time, then you can come back to us at a later date. After you've found out a bit about fostering and got in contact with us, you can book an 'initial visit' which is where a member of our team visits you at home to talk in more detail about you and your interest in fostering.

We'll arrange a suitable time to visit you in your home, where we want you to feel comfortable and relaxed.

The visit also provides you a further opportunity to ask any questions and help you decide if fostering is right for you and your family.

It's nothing to worry about, we want you to feel at ease and just chat to us over a cuppa (and some biscuits if you're offering!)

We collect your details and complete mandatory checks.

After you have submitted your application, we'll request checks and references.



We kickstart your journey with a 'skills to foster' training course, which runs flexibly to allow for working hours and other commitments you may have.

You then move on to more in-depth fostering training, giving you the opportunity to hear from children in care and other foster carers. Fear not, training isn't limited to just this, we continuously invest in carers by providing **training and support**.

We also allocate a social worker to visit you at home, several times, to find out all about you. This helps us to find out the types of fostering you're most suited to, as there are a few <u>different ways to</u> <u>foster</u>.
