

2	Vesak (Buddha Day) Festival that commemorates the birth, enlightenment, and death of Gautama Buddha in Theravada. The most important of the Buddhist festivals
4	Trinity Sunday (Christian)
16	Martyrdom of Guru Arjan Dev (Sikh) Guru Arjan Dev was the fifth Sikh Guru and the first Sikh martyr.
21	Summer Solstice - Litha (Pagan) Longest day of the year
26	Hajj (Muslim) Pilgrimage to Mecca, which takes place in the last month of the year and which all Muslims are expected to make at least once during their lifetime if they can afford to do so. It is one of the Five Pillars of Islam. Ends 1 July
27	Waqf al Arafa (Islam) The holiest day in the Islamic calendar - the day where, if sought after, millions of Muslims' sins are forgiven by Allah
28	<b>Eid-Ul-Adha (Islam)</b> Festival of Sacrifice marking the day after Arafat, the most important day in the Hajj ritual. This is a four day holiday
29	St Peter and St Paul's Day (Christian) The martyrdoms of both these saints are observed by the Church today

3	Asalha Puja (Dharma Day) (Buddhist) The anniversary of the start of Buddha's teaching - his first sermon, "The Wheel of Truth", after his enlightenment.
9	Martyrdom of the Bab (Bahai) Anniversary of the Bab's execution in 1850
19	Al-Hijra/Muharram (Islam) Islamic New Year. Marks the migration of Prophet Mohammad from Mecca to Medina
23	Birthday of Haile Selassie I (Rastafari) Haile Selassie was the Emperor of Ethiopia. Rastas believe Haile Selassie is God, and that he will return the black community who are living in exile to Africa.  Birthday of Guru HarKrishan (Sikh)
27	Tisha B'Av (Jewish) A solemn day that commemorates a series of tragedies that have befallen the Jewish people over the years, many of which have coincidentally happened on this day.  Ashura (Islam) Marks the martyrdom of the Prophet's grandson, Hussein.
