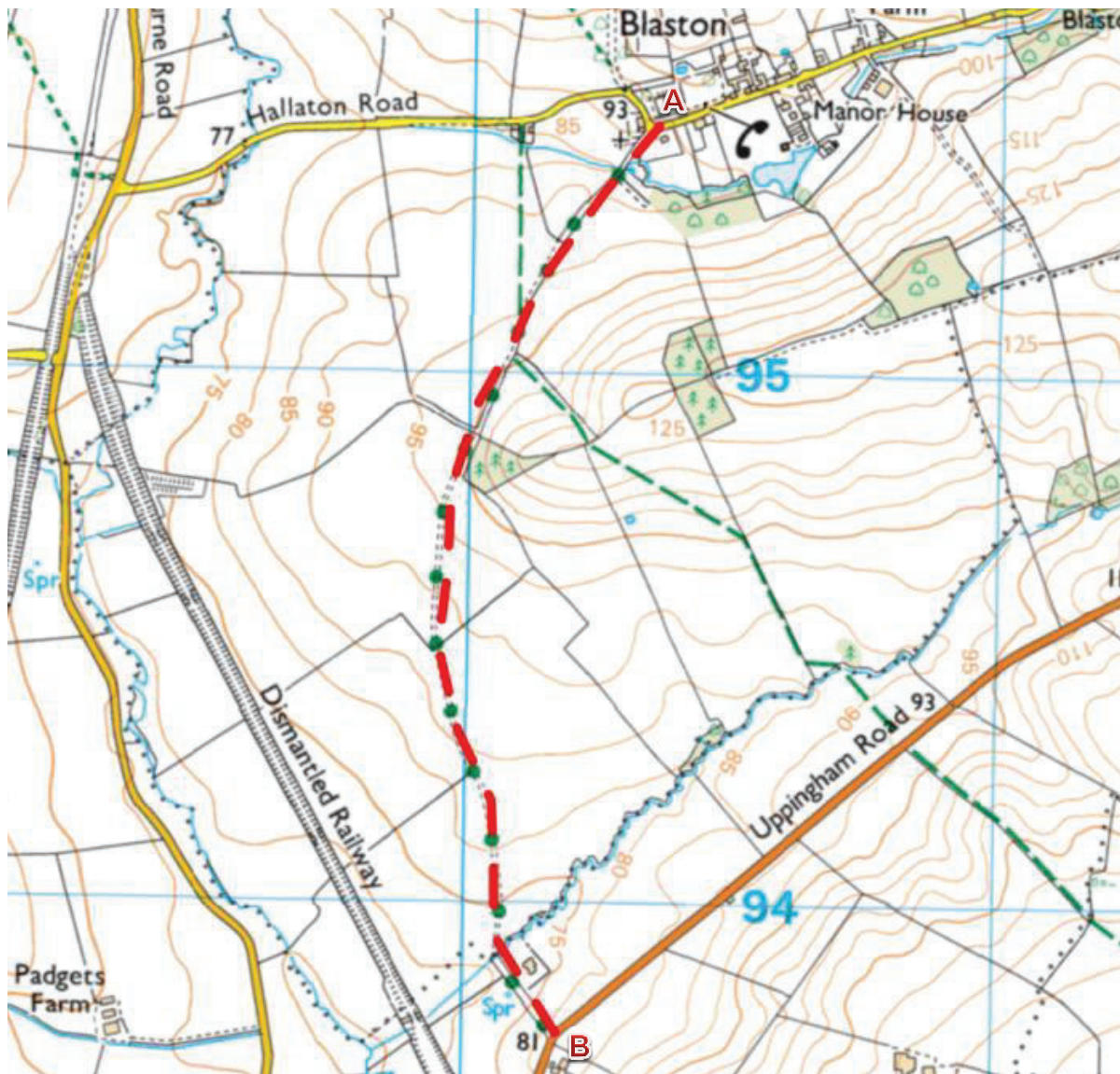

**Map of Path:** Route applied for is shown in RED DASHES starting at Main Street, Blaston goes in a southerly direction along a track to end at Uppingham Road, Medbourne. The route is shown as an ORPA on OS Maps and is not on the online Definitive Map however it is on the List of Streets but as the route is unsurfaced it is felt a DMMO is required to establish status. The application is for a BOAT.
