

Map of Path: Route applied for is shown in RED DASHES starting at the end of the unsurfaced section of Covert Lane, Scraptoft continues easterly along Covert Lane, Keyham to end at Ingarsby Lane, Ingarsby Hungarton. The route is shown as an ORPA on OS Maps and is not on the online Definitive Map however it is on the List of Streets but as the route is unsurfaced and described in one section as a track it is felt a DMMO is required to establish status. The application is for a Restricted byway.
