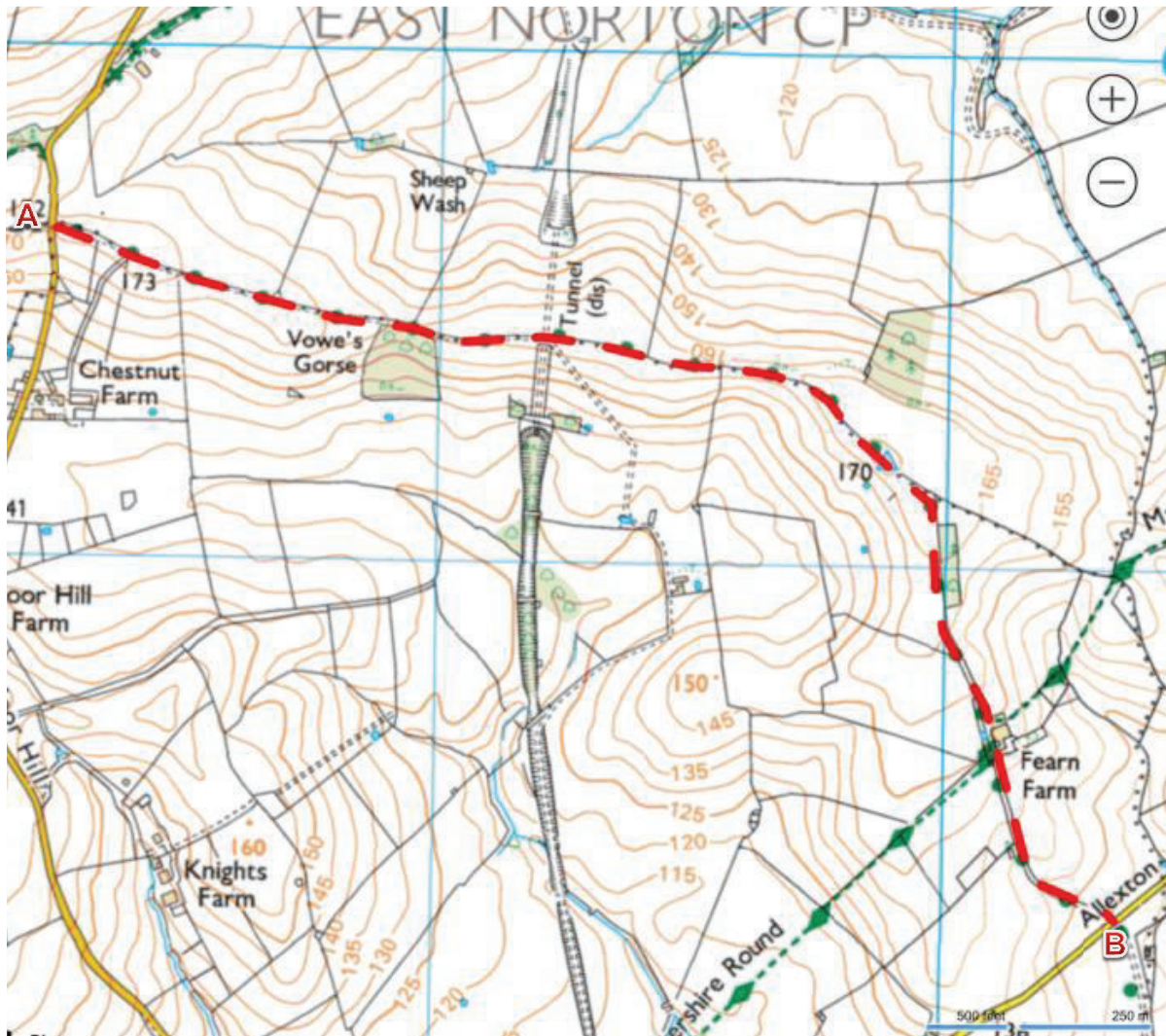

Map of Path: Route applied for is shown in RED DASHES starting at the junction of Moor Lane, East Norton and Moor Hill, Hallaton goes in an easterly direction along a track before turning southwards to end at Allextion Road, Hallaton. The route is shown as an ORPA on OS Maps and is not on the online Definitive Map however it is on the List of Streets but as the route is unsurfaced it is felt a DMMO is required to establish status. The application is for a Restricted byway however higher rights may exist.
