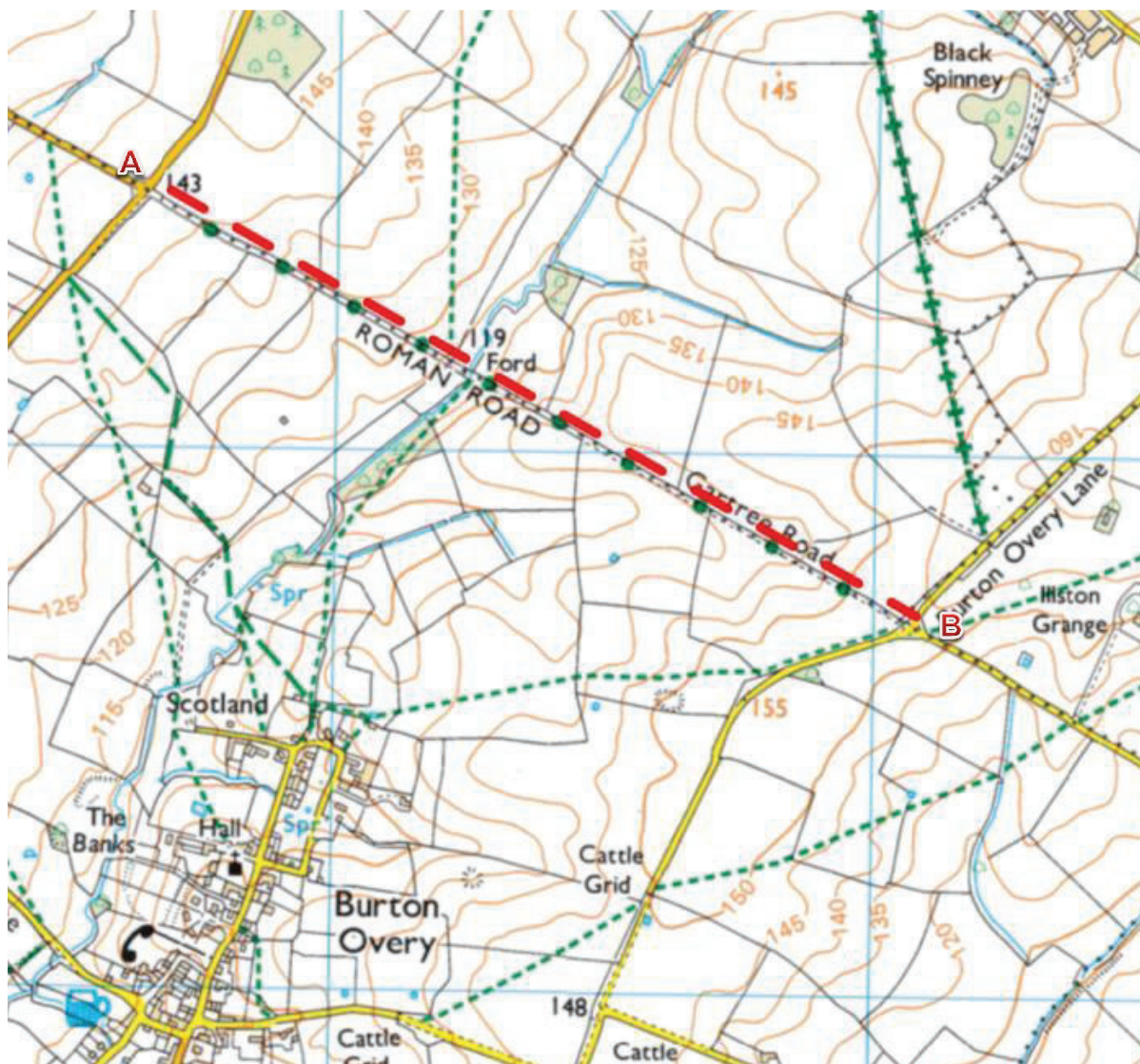

**Parish:** Burton Overy, Kings Norton and Illston on the Hill **Grid Reference:** SP676994

**Map of Path:** Route applied for is shown in RED DASHES starting at the junction of Great Glen Road, Kings Norton and Oaks Road, Burton Overy goes in a south easterly direction along the line of the old Roman Road – Gartree Road to end at the junction of Burton Overy Road, Illston on the Hill and Burton Overy Lane, Burton Overy. The route is shown as an ORPA on OS Maps and is not on the online Definitive Map however it is on the List of Streets but as the route is unsurfaced it is felt a DMMO is required to establish status. The application is for a BOAT.
