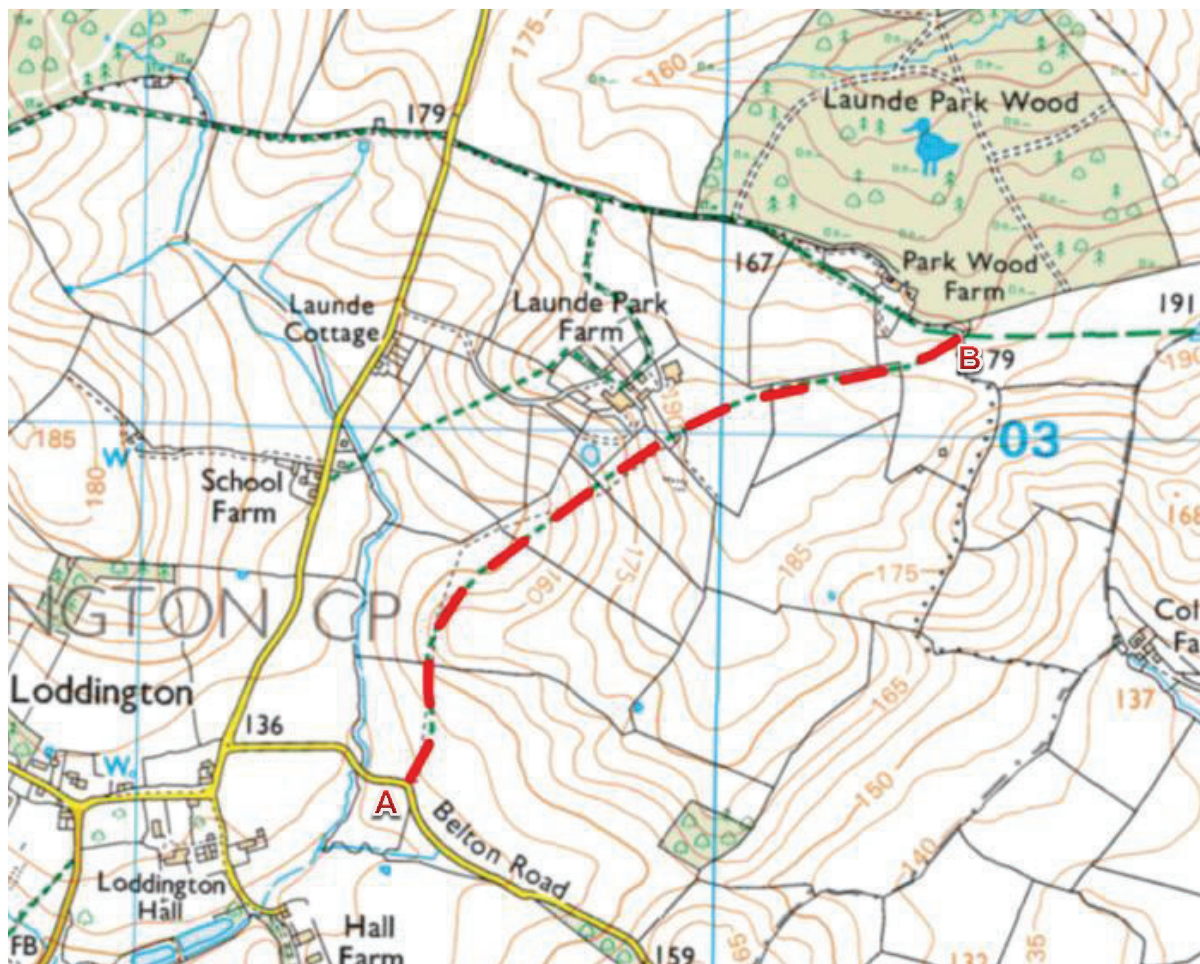

### Description of Path:

Path starts at Belton Road, Loddington at approximate grid reference SK79460239 goes in a north east direction along footpath C68A Loddington to end at Bridleway C73, Launde to the east of Park Wood Farm and on the parish boundary at approximate grid reference SK80410318. The route is shown as a footpath on OS Maps and the online Definitive Map.
