

**Map of Path:** Route applied for is shown in RED DASHES starts off Hamilton Lane, Leicester opposite Keyham Lane West continues east along a track to end at Beeby Road, Scraptoft opposite Keyham Lane East. The route is shown as an ORPA on OS Maps and is not on the online Definitive Map however it is on the List of Streets but as the route is unsurfaced and described as a track it is felt a DMMO is required to establish status. The application is for a Restricted byway.
