

Parish: Sheepy Magna and Sheepy Parva Grid Reference: SK335022

Map of Path: Route applied for is shown in RED DASHES starting at Watery Lane, Sheepy Magna goes south along an unclassified street via the Ford to end at Wellsborough Road, Sheepy Parva. The route is shown as an ORPA on OS Maps and is not on the online Definitive Map. The application is for a BOAT as the route is unsurfaced, particularly at the Watery Lane end and there are signs at each end describing the route as "unsuitable for motor vehicles".
