

## Have your say on our Ashby Canal Transfer Consultation

Your views are important so that we can better understand the current level of community support for the proposal to transfer part of the route of the Ashby Canal to the Ashby Canal Association (ACA) and receive suggestions on any alternative ways the council could pursue the restoration of the Canal.

We previously carried out a consultation in June 2019 and now that we are getting ready to transfer part of the Ashby Canal to the ACA, we would like to hear your views and are particularly interested in those of the individuals, households and businesses that are new to the area.

## **Background Information**

Leicestershire County Council has led on the restoration of the Ashby Canal since 1994, including the purchase of land for that purpose, under a Transport and Works Act Order (TWAO). The Council remains committed to restoration of the canal but is unable to progress as quickly as stakeholders would like, owing to lack of resources.

The next section of canal identified for potential restoration is between Snarestone and Measham. The route is highlighted in red on the map which can be found on the consultation webpage here: www.leicestershire.gov.uk/ashby-canal-consultation

The Council are considering transferring the ownership and the obligations and responsibilities under the TWAO in seeking to restore this section to the Ashby Canal Association. The use of this land would be restricted to the building of a canal and the Council would retain the ownership of the other sections of canal.

The Ashby Canal Association (ACA) is a registered charity (No 1063566) dedicated to the promotion and restoration of the Ashby Canal. Established in 1966, they are a corporate member of Inland waterways Association with over 550 members, and have completed a £10,000 Heritage Lottery Fund (HLF) project to explore and engage local people with the archaeology of llott Wharf and have raised over £100,000 in donations to restore the Gilwiskaw Aqueduct.
