Progress and upcoming works

Summary of work progressed or completed in September 2023

- Archaeological works 85% complete.



- Haul Road works 85% complete.



- Piling Platform work at River Eye ongoing.
- Construction of protection slab for gas main at Melton Spinney Road completed.
- Severn Trent Water 450mm main diversion works ongoing.

Summary of planned and ongoing work for October 2023

- Bridge foundation works will commence at Scalford Brook, Thorpe Brook and River Eye.
- Road construction works will commence at A606 Nottingham Road to Scalford Road.
- Service diversions works will be on going.
- Earthworks and drainage works will be on going.

A temporary road closure is required on Scalford Road located at the roundabout adjacent to the Bloor Homes housing development and will include the closure of the unnamed road between the A606 Nottingham Road and Holwell Lane. The closure will be in place during half term break to help minimise disruption on the local road network. The closure will take place from **6:00am Monday 16th October** and reopen at **6:00am on Monday 23rd October 2023**. This closure is required for drainage works and BT cable diversions.

Please Note: National Grid have a planned road closure on the **14-15th October** on Scalford Road/Holwell Lane junction. This closure is not part of the NEMMDR project requirements.

If travelling from Melton: Access will be possible up to the Bloor Homes new housing development roundabout, just north of John Fernley College. Scalford Road will be closed from this roundabout to the north and no further access permitted. For Scalford village, please follow the diversion via Melton Spinney Road.

If travelling from Scalford: The road will be closed from Holwell Lane with access for residents only up to the closure point (adjacent to Grammar School Farm). Scalford Road will be closed towards Melton from this point and no further access permitted. For Melton, please follow the diversion via Melton Spinney Road.

There will be temporary two way traffic lights across the scheme as and when required throughout delivery of the project. For your own safety and that of our workforce please adhere to traffic light systems when operational.
