Highways Act 1980

The Leicestershire County Council (A511 Growth Corridor) (Side Roads) Order 2023

The Leicestershire County Council ("the Council") hereby give notice that they have made, and are about to submit to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation, an Order under Section 14 and Section 125 of the Highways act 1980 authorising the Council to:-

- (a) Improve highways (including raising, lowering or otherwise altering),
- (b) Stop up highways,
- (c) Construct new highways,
- (d) Stop up private means of access to premises, and
- (e) Provide new means of access to the said premises.

All on or in the vicinity of the classified road known as the A511, the A50 and the Bardon Link Road which the Council are proposing to construct between the A511 Bardon Road to connect south to the spine road being delivered as part of the Grange Road residential development.

Any person may not later than 15 January 2024 object to the confirmation of the order by notice to the Secretary of State for Transport, Casework Team, Tyneside House, Skinnerburn Road, Newcastle Business Park, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE4 7AR or by email to nationalcasework@dft.gov.uk stating the title of the Order and the ground of their objection.

In submitting an objection it should be noted that your personal data and correspondence will be passed to the Council to enable your objection to be considered. If you do not wish your personal data to be forwarded, please state your reasons when submitting your objection and the Secretary of State will copy your representations, with your name and address removed to the Council, and if there is to be a Public Local Inquiry they will be seen by the Inspector who may give them less weight as a result.
