As you may be aware Galliford Try are working with Leicestershire County Council to deliver the NEMMDR project. As part of our commitment to minimise disruption we provide regular communications for the local community and stakeholders. We would like to take this opportunity to provide you with advanced notice of the planned road closure and apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused during the construction of the project.

B676 Saxby Road Closure Notification

A temporary road closure is required on the B676 Saxby Road located at Lag Lane junction. The closure will be in place from 6:00 am Monday April 29th 2024 and reopen on Friday 3rd May 2024 at 7:00pm Access for pedestrians and cyclists will be available. Cyclists will need to dismount as they pass through the works.

The closure is required to safely undertake the installation of new drainage network as part of the new roundabout construction. All diversion routes will be clearly signposted.
