THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Sections 5, 84 and part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

1. To impose a 20-mph speed limit on parts of Medbourne Road, Nevill Holt Road, Main Street, The Green and Hall Lane, Drayton
2. To impose a 30 -mph speed Limit on part of Great Easton Road, Drayton

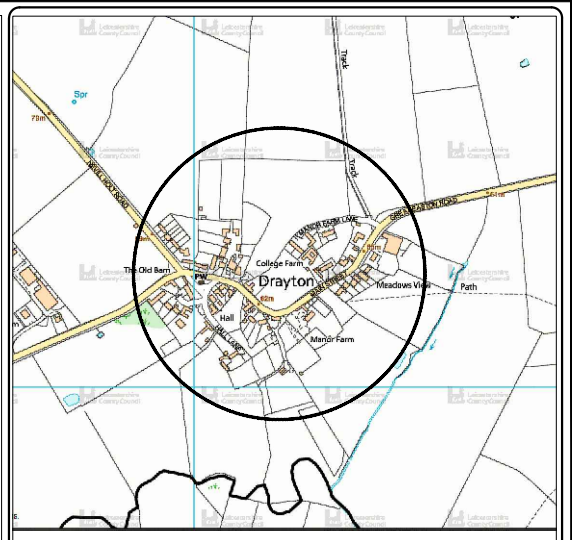
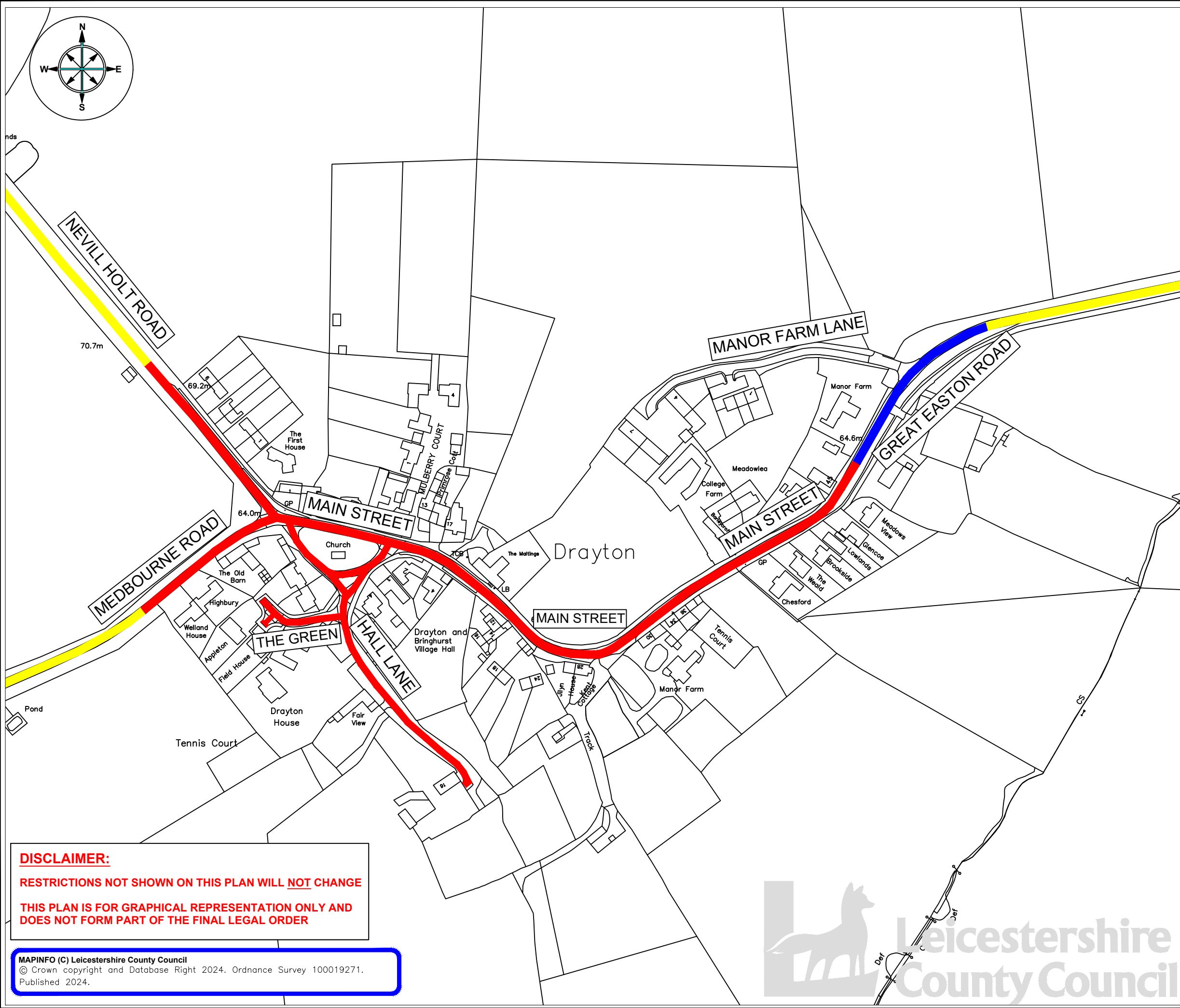
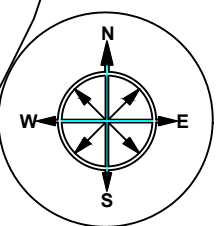

PROPOSED 20MPH AND 30MPH SPEED LIMITS

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Leicestershire County Council (LCC) is proposing to lower the speed limit from 30mph to 20mph on the following roads Medbourne Road, Nevill Holt Road, Main Street, The Green and Hall Lane in the village of Drayton.

The 20mph speed limit is being introduced after speed surveys showed the mean speed to be conducive with a 20mph speed limit. However, Great Easton Road did not meet the criteria for a signed only 20mph speed limit.

Therefore, on Great Easton Road the 30mph speed limit will remain and act as a buffer speed limit before entering the 20mph speed limit proposed on Main Street, Drayton.

To formalise the 30mph speed limit on Great Easton Road it has been included in this order.

The order is being introduced to improve road safety.

The Leicestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 5 , 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act and Regulation 23 of the Local Authorities Traffic Order (Procedure) England and Wales Regulations 1996, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Leicestershire County Council (Various Roads, Drayton, District of Harborough) (Imposition of 20mph and 30 mph Speed Limits) Order 202 "
2. The Order shall come into force on the day of 202
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 MPH on the lengths of roads as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 MPH on the lengths of roads as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
5. The plan annexed to this Order and marked drawing number TM5140/T1/1 is for identification purposes only.
