COUNTRY PARKS BYELAWS 2024

THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it intends to make new byelaws under Section 41 of the Countryside Act 1968 and in accordance with Section 236 of the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which will be:

To impose restrictions on the means of access to, use of, activities on and interference with the flora, fauna and structures (both natural and man-made) at various Country Parks specified within the byelaws, across the County of Leicestershire
