Scalford Road Closure Notification 15 July to 25 August 2024

Dear Neighbour,

As you may be aware, Galliford Try are working with Leicestershire County Council to deliver the construction of the NEMMDR project. We would like to take this opportunity to provide you with advanced notice of the planned road closure of Scalford Road and apologise for any inconvenience caused. The closure is on the section of Scalford Road between the Bloor Homes development and Holwell Lane.

Why is the closure required?

A full road closure is required to safely complete the new roundabout construction works as part of the NEMMDR project. This work cannot be carried out using a partial lane closure due to the narrow nature of the existing road and the level differences between existing and new construction. There would be insufficient width to undertake this section of works safely under temporary traffic lights.

Some of the works include removal of the existing carriageway and reconstruction to a new alignment with service trenches and excavations across the full length of the carriageway. We anticipate this closure will enable the completion of the new roundabout without the requirement for further closures at this location..

Closure Details

The closure will be in place from **6:00am on Monday 15 July until 8:00 pm on Sunday 25 August 2024**. The closure has been planned and programmed within the school holidays to minimise disruption, the closure is unable to start any earlier due to advanced enabling works required at this location.

Currently there are no footpaths along the section of road being closed and to confirm access will be restricted for all through the closure points this includes pedestrians and cyclists.

The road will reopen on Sunday 25 August 2024. Please take care and be aware that the road layout will have changed.

Temporary Traffic Lights

As a contingency, should any final works be required to complete the installation of signage, lighting columns and roadside works, there may be a requirement to complete these elements under temporary 2-way traffic lights. If required, temporary 2-way traffic lights will be in in place from **6:00am on Tuesday 27 August until 8:00pm on Friday 13th September 2024**.

Diversion Routes

Details of the official signed diversion route are as follows:

Travelling from Melton: Access will be possible up to the Bloor Homes new housing development roundabout, just north of John Fernley College. Scaford Road will be closed from this roundabout to the north and no further access permitted. For Scaford village, please follow the diversion via A607 to Waltham on the Wolds.

Travelling from Scaford: The road will be closed from Holwell Lane with access for residents only up to the closure point (adjacent to Grammar School Farm). Scaford Road will be closed towards Melton from this point and no further access permitted. For Melton, please follow the diversion via A607 Waltham on the Wolds.
