- ✓ Be able to commit to a 10-week virtual course, including one day of face-to-face training for paediatric first aid

The paediatric first aid module is a blended delivery approach, which will involve an online, 6-hour e-learning module as well as a 6-hour face to face component that is delivered by our sister company, First Response First Aid (FRFA).
