THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (ST JOHNS (SERVICE ROAD) ENDERBY) (DISTRICT OF BLABY) (ONE-WAY SYSTEM) ORDER 2024

The Leicestershire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4 and 5 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Leicestershire County Council (St Johns (Service Road) Enderby) (District of Blaby) (No Entry and One Way System) Order 2024".
 - 2. The Order shall come into force on the sixteenth day of December 2024
- 3. A "motor vehicle" as defined in Section 136 (1) of "the Act" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads
- 4. No person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along that length of road except in the direction as specified in the Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 5. No person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, shall enter that road as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

6. The plan annexed to this Order and marked drawing number TM5113/T1/1 is for identification purposes only.

SCHEDULE 1

IMPOSITION OF A ONE-WAY SYSTEM

ST JOHNS (SERVICE ROAD), ENDERBY

From the junction of St Johns Service Road and Trinity Road to the B114 St Johns for a distance of 25 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

IMPOSITION OF A NO ENTRY SYSTEM

ST JOHNS (SERVICE ROAD), ENDERBY

From the B4114 St Johns to the junction of St Johns Service Road and Trinity Road for a distance of 25 metres.
