Primary, Secondary School and Post 16 Engagement Careers Fairs and Events

The Workforce Team has attended 28 events across the district and engaged with 1501 students! We are working with schools and colleges through the Careers and Enterprise Hubs and Leicestershire Education Business Company (LEBC), to provide sessions that allow students to explore a variety of careers and engage in sessions, inspiring students to consider a Career in Childcare. Sessions include 'What's my Job', Mock Interviews and Speed Networking, alongside the Careers in Childcare information and workshop sessions. Careers fairs continue to be in full swing, and we attended some fantastic events as part of National Apprenticeship Week in February and Careers Week in March. National Apprenticeship Week
