To impose a 30-mph speed limit on parts of Ashby Road, Paske Avenue, Pasture Lane, Rearsby Lane and Rotherby Road, Gaddesby

To impose a Restricted Road on parts of Ashby Road, Park Hill, Paske Avenue and Rearsby Lane, Gaddesby and on Barrow Crescent, Chapel Lane, Church Lane, Cross Street, Main Street and Nether End, Gaddesby for their entire lengths.



STATEMENT OF REASONS

Leicestershire County Council proposes to make this order.

On behalf of the developer Cadeby Homes (planning application 20/00591/OUT) it is necessary to extend the existing 30mph speed limit along Pasture Lane, Gaddesby.

The 30mph speed limit will be extended to incorporate the new housing development entrance and will provide a safe highway environment and safe egress for the development.

Additionally due to an irregularity discovered within the original 30mph speed limit Traffic Regulation Order for Gaddesby an update is needed to correct this anomaly. This is solely an order update, therefore there will be no other changes on site.

The proposals are shown in plan DCSTRO-018/T1/1

- This Order may be cited as "The Leicestershire County Council (Various Roads, Gaddesby, Borough of Melton) (Imposition of 30mph Speed Limit and Restricted Road) Order 202"
- 2. The Order shall come into force on the day of 202
- 3. The Order specified in Schedule 1 to this Order is hereby revoked in part.
- 4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 MPH on the lengths of roads as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- That length of road as specified in the Schedule 3 to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purpose of Section 81 of the Act.

The plan annexed to this Order and marked drawing number DCSTRO-018/T1/1 is for identification purposes only.

Chapel Lane - for its entire length, which extends from its centre-line junction with Rearsby Lane in a northerly direction for an of approximate distance of 272 metres.

Cross Street - for its entire length, which extends from its centre-line junction with Chapel Lane in a north easterly to its centre-line junction with Main Street an approximate distance of 102 metres.

- 3. "The Leicestershire County Council (Various Streets, Parish of Tilton on the Hill) (30 and 40 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order 1985" is hereby revoked.
- "The Leicestershire County Council (40 M.P.H. Speed Limit) (Leicester Road And Melton Road Tilton on The Hill) Order 1975" is hereby revoked.
- "The Leicestershire County Council (Main Street and Somerby Road/Leesthorpe Road, Pickwell Parish of Somerby) (30 M.P.H. and 40 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order 1996" is hereby revoked.
- 6. "The Leicestershire County Council (Various Roads, Parish of Gaddesby) (30 M.P.H. and 40 M.P.H. Speed Limits) Order 1994" is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

BROOKSBY - PARISH OF HOBY WITH ROTHERBY

The road running from Route the A607 at Brooksby towards Hoby past Brooksby College - from a point 100 metres to the north-west of the western channel of Route the A607 in a generally north-westerly direction to a point 47 metres to the north-west of the centre-line of the railway at the Level Crossing.

The road running from Brooksby College to Rotherby - from the eastern channel line of the road between Brooksby and Hoby in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 9 metres.

The road running between Cold Overton and Knossington - from its junction with Somerby Road for a distance of approximately 155 metres in a generally south-westerly direction.

The road known in part as Main Street - from its junction with the road running between Cold Overton and Langham in a northerly, then easterly, then northerly direction a total distance of approximately 733 metres.

The Brentingby to Stapleford Road - from a point 303 metres west of its junction with the road leading to Wyfordby Grange in an easterly direction to a point 167 metres east of its junction with the road leading to Wyfordby Grange, a distance of 470 metres.

STAPLEFORD

The Cuckoo Hill to Saxby Road - from a point 30 metres south of its junction with the Wyfordby to Stapleford road northwards to a point 195 metres north of its junction with the Wyfordby to Stapleford road, a distance of approximately 225 metres.

The Wyfordby to Stapleford Road - from its junction with the Cuckoo Hill to Saxby Road in a westerly direction to a point 53 metres west of its junction with the road leading to Stapleford Manor, a distance of approximately 180 metres.

The road leading to Stapleford Manor - the whole length of the road from its junction with the Wyfordby to Stapleford road in a northerly then easterly direction to Stapleford Manor and Manor House Farm, a distance of approximately 200 metres.

BESCABY

Mary Lane - from a point 58 metres south of the boundary of houses Nos. 2/4 in a northerly direction to a point 25 metres north of the boundary of house Nos. 10/12, a distance of approximately 220 metres.

RAGDALE

Six Hills Road - That length of road known as Six Hills Road from a point 100 metres north of the northern boundary of the property known as Old Hall Croft in a generally south east direction to its junction with Main Street and Hoby Road a distance of approximately 346 metres.

Hoby Road - That length of road known as Hoby Road from its junction with Main Street and Six Hills Road in a generally north east direction to a point 6 metres south of the southern boundary of the property known as Paddock Rise a distance of approximately 174 metres.

Main Street - That length of the road known as Main Street from its junction with Six Hills Road and Hoby Road in a generally westerly direction for its entire length a distance of approximately 303 metres.

SHOBY

Main Street - That length of road known as Main Street from a point 50 metres north east of its junction with Route the A6006 in a generally north east direction to a point 20 metres north of the northern boundary of Aylesford's Farm a distance of approximately 442 metres.

SAXELBYE

Main Street. - That length of road known as Main Street from a point 50 metres east of the abutment of the rail overbridge in a generally north east direction to a point 20 metres east of the Bridleway number G64 a distance of approximately 492 metres

Ostler Lane. - That length of road known as Ostler Lane from its junction with Main Street in a generally northern direction to a point 15 metres north of the northern boundary of the property known as Cleveland a distance of approximately 263 metres.

Church Lane. - That length of road known as Church Lane from its junction with Main Street for its entire length a distance of approximately 171 metres.

MAREFIELD

The road through the village running in a generally east - west direction from a point 428 metres to the west of the centre-line of the junction with Dawsons Lane, in a generally western direction for a distance of 230 metres.

COLD NEWTON

The road through the village known as **Main Street** and **Skeg Hill Road** running in a generally north east direction from a point 23 metres north of the northern channel of Hungarton Road in a generally north eastern direction for a distance of 640 metres. **The roads running off Main Street** in the vicinity of The Green for their entire length.

LOWESBY

The road through the village known as **Church Hill** and **Lowesby Lane** from a point 304 metres north east of the northern channel of the road to Lowesby Hall, in a generally south western direction to a point 85 metres south west of the northern channel of the road to Lowesby Hall, a distance of 389 metres.

TILTON

Route the **B6047** known as **Leicester Road** and **Melton Road** - from a point 336 metres south-west of its junction with Leicester Road in a north easterly then northerly direction to a point 208 metres north of that junction, a distance of 544 metres.

The road known as **Oakham Road** which extends from its junction with Main Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 124 metres.

The road known as **Main Street** which extends - from its junction with Back Road to its junction with Marefield Lane in a generally northerly direction.

The road known as **Marefield Lane** which extends from its junction with Main Street in a northerly direction to a point 201 yards north of its junction with Halstead Rise.

The road known as Halstead Rise for its entire length.

The road known as Leicester Road which extends from its junction with Melton Road in an easterly direction to its junction with Main Street/Marefield Lane.

The road known as **Loddington Road** which extends from its junction with Main Street in a south easterly direction for a distance of 244 metres.

The cul-de-sac known as **Digby Close** - from its junction with Route the B6047 Leicester Road for its entire length.

HALSTEAD

The road known as **Oakham Road** which extends from a point 124 metres east of its junction with Main Street, Tilton on the Hill in an easterly direction to a point 122 metres south east of its junction with the unnamed road leading to Halstead House.

PARISH OF FREEBY

Main Street - from its junction with Waltham Road (give way markings), in a generally north easterly direction to a point 135 metres north east of where the south easterly facing wall meets the north easterly facing wall of Brook Cottage, Main Street. An approximate distance of 550 metres.

Church Lane - for its entire length, which extends from its centre-line junction with Ashby Road in a northerly direction for an approximate distance of 132 metres.

Chapel Lane - for its entire length, which extends from its centre-line junction with Rearsby Lane in a northerly direction for an of approximate distance of 272 metres.

Cross Street - for its entire length, which extends from its centre-line junction with Chapel Lane in a north easterly to its centre-line junction with Main Street an approximate distance of 102 metres.

Main Street And Park Hill - from Main Streets centre-line junction with Nether End, in a generally northerly direction for an approximate distance of 653 metres.

Rearsby Lane/Nether End/Ashby Road - from a point 264 metres north west of the Chapel lane centre-line in a generally south easterly direction to a point 501 metres south east of its junction with the Church Lane centre-line, an approximate distance of 1028 metres.

Pasture Lane - from its junction with Park Hill in an easterly direction to a point approximately 20 metres east of the centre-line of its junction with Paske Avenue a total distance of approximately 140 metres.

Paske Avenue - for its entire length from its junction with Park Hill in an easterly direction then northerly direction to its junction with Pasture Lane an approximate distance of 267 metres.

THORPE ARNOLD

Side Road (North Side) - from its junction with Route the A607 for a distance of 105 metres in a northerly direction.

Side Road (South Side) - from its junction with Route the A607 for a distance of 220 metres generally in a southerly direction.

WARTNABY

Main Street - from a point 29 metres south of its junction with Route the G7215 for a distance of 300 metres in a south westerly direction.

Side Road - from its junction with Main Street for a distance of 97 metres in a south easterly direction.

BRANSTON

Waltham Road - from its junction with Main Road in a generally southerly direction for a distance of approximately 302 metres.

The Lane/Track - from its junction with Waltham Road, running in an easterly direction - for its entire length.

The Eaton Road - from the centre-line of Waltham Road for a distance of 50 metres. Main Road - for its entire length.

The Rock - for its entire length.

Main Street - from the centre-line of The Rock in a northerly direction for a distance of 414 metres.

Knipton Road - from the centre-line of Main Street in an easterly direction for 59 metres.

The Lane - from its junction with Main Street, running in an easterly direction to Hall Farm for its entire length.

The cul-de-sac - from its junction with Main Street, opposite Manor Farm, running in an easterly direction for its entire length.

GOADBY MARWOOD

Wycomb Lane - from the centre-line of Main Street in a generally westerly direction for a distance of 125 metres.

Main Street - from its junction with Wycomb Lane in a northerly and then easterly direction for a distance of 530 metres.

The Lane to Brook Cottages - from its junction with Main Street running in a northerly direction, then easterly and then south easterly for its entire length.

The Lane to the property known as The Hollies - from its junction with Main Street running in a northerly direction for its entire length.

The Lane to Field Cottages - from its junction with Main Street running in a northerly direction for its entire length.
