Dear Neighbour,

As you may be aware, Galliford Try are working with Leicestershire County Council to deliver the NEMMDR project. We would like to take this opportunity to provide you with advanced notice of the planned road closures of the A606 Nottingham Road and of St. Bartholomew's Way. We would also like to make you aware of a planned closure at the B676 Saxby Road that will be taking place at same time.

Why is the closure of the A606 Nottingham Road / St. Bartholomew's Way required?

A full closure is required to safely complete the new roundabout construction works as part of the NEMMDR project. This work cannot be carried out using a partial lane closure due us needing to excavate the existing carriageway and construct the new roundabout. We expect to complete all this work in one go and we do not anticipate requiring further closures of the A606 Nottingham Road or St. Bartholomew's Way. In order to minimise the duration of the closure on the A606 Nottingham Road, temporary 2-way traffic lights will be used before and after the road closure which necessitates the closure of St. Bartholomew's Way for an extended period of time.

Closure details

The closure of St. Bartholomew's Way will be in place from 0600 on Monday 16 June until 1900 on Sunday 28 September. The closure will be over a short length of St. Bartholomew's Way from its junction with the A606 Nottingham Road to its junction with Southwell Close.

The closure of the A606 Nottingham Road will be in place from 0600 on Monday 7 July until 19:00 Sunday 31 August. The closure will be over a length of the A606 Nottingham Road from its junction with Brampton Road to Hilltop Farm.

Due to the nature of this work, there will be no pedestrian or cycle access available through the closure and a pedestrian diversion will be put in place from Brampton Road to Southwell Close.

The A606 Nottingham Road will reopen on Sunday 31 August 2025. Please take care and be aware that the road layout will have changed.

We have liaised with key stakeholders including the Emergency Services and Public Transport operators. There will also be mitigation measures implemented on local roads.

Diversion route

The route of the official signed diversion for the A606 Nottingham Road will be via A606 Nottingham Road towards the A46 > A46 southbound to Dalby Intersection > A6006 Paddys Lane to towards Melton Mowbray > A606 Nottingham Road, and vice versa.

Closure of the B676 Saxby Road

Please be aware that the B676 Saxby Road will also be closed from 24 June 2025 to 28 September 2025. Notice of this closure is being given to affected residents by way of a separate letter.

The decision to undertake concurrent road closures has been taken proactively. This approach best utilises the school summer holidays when traffic is typically at a natural low and provides the best opportunity to complete the works during the summer months when the risk of adverse weather is lower. Concurrent working ensures that the project remains on schedule, with a target opening date of Spring 2026. Although the road closures will lead to disruption in Melton Mowbray, for which we apologise, we anticipate that this will be the last round of closures required and we look forward to the benefits the NEMMDR project will bring by reducing HGV through traffic and reducing congestion in Melton town centre.
