

Local Offer Roadshow Stallholder Attendance Policy

Leicestershire County Council deliver Local Offer Roadshows for parents and carers who have children aged from 0 to 25 with Special Educational Needs and Disability to showcase services within the Leicestershire SEND service offer. The Roadshows take place across the year and at a variety of venues in each District or Borough in Leicestershire.

The Local Offer Steering Group have agreed the following to attend the Local Offer Roadshow as stallholders:

- Relevant Leicestershire Partnership Trust and University Hospitals Leicester services
- Local and national organisations providing information and support to families
- Play and leisure providers offering inclusive services
- Post-16 and learning providers
- Healthwatch
- SENDIASS representing the provision of free advocacy services
- Leicestershire SEND Hub as the strategic partner of the SEND Partnership for Leicestershire

Stallholders should promote only the provision or service provided that is relevant to the agreed list and should not promote any political or religious beliefs.

A wide range of services and organisations offering support for different needs and age-ranges, attend the Local Offer Roadshow. As services offered to families with children and young people with SEND continue to grow and develop, services offering to attend as stallholders can have competing interests with the agreed stallholder list (see above).

Several private individuals have been requesting to be stallholders at the Local Offer Roadshows that are outside of the agreed list. This may include, but is not limited to paid Psychological, Consultancy, Coaching or Advocacy services. Leicestershire County Council therefore reserves the right to refuse requests to be a stallholder.
