

# **TOUCAN CROSSING**

### STATEMENT OF REASONS

Leicestershire County Council intends to upgrade the existing crossing point to a staggered signalised toucan crossing facility on Lutterworth Southern Bypass (A4303), Lutterworth.

The Toucan Crossing will provide connectivity for both pedestrians and cyclists from the new Leaders Farm development to the existing infrastructure on the northern side of the A4303 carriageway and along Coventry Road, Lutterworth.

This is part of the planning conditions to improve the crossing facilities across the eastern arm of the A4303/Coventry Road/ Fairacres Coventry Road roundabout.

The new toucan crossing will allow both pedestrians and cyclists to cross the road and access the new development safely.

This is being funded by Leicestershire County Council and linked to the Leaders Farm development site.
