

- This Order may be cited as "The Leicestershire County Council (Orchard Street and The Lawns, Hinckley) (Borough of Hinckley & Bosworth) (One Way System) Order 202"
- 2. The Order shall come into force on the day of 202
- 3. A "motor vehicle" as defined in Section 136 (1) of "the Act" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads
- 4. No person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along that length of road except in the direction as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 5. The plan annexed to this Order and marked drawing number TM5192/T1/1 is for identification purposes only.

SCHEDULE

IMPOSITION OF ONE-WAY SYSTEM

Orchard Street - From its junction with The Lawns for 93 metres in a south westerly direction to its junction with Hill Street.

The Lawns - From its junction with Castle Street/London Road for 90 metres in a south easterly direction to its junction with Orchard Street.
