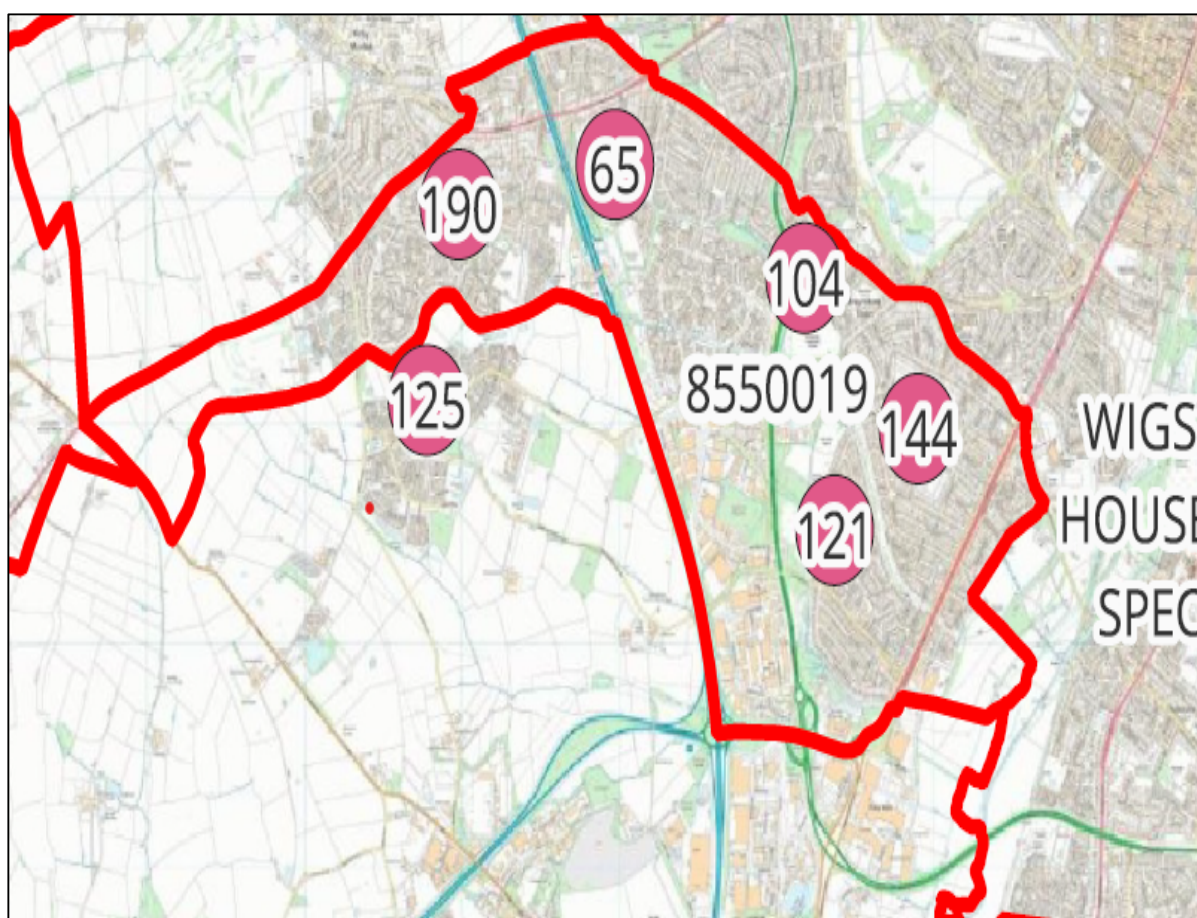

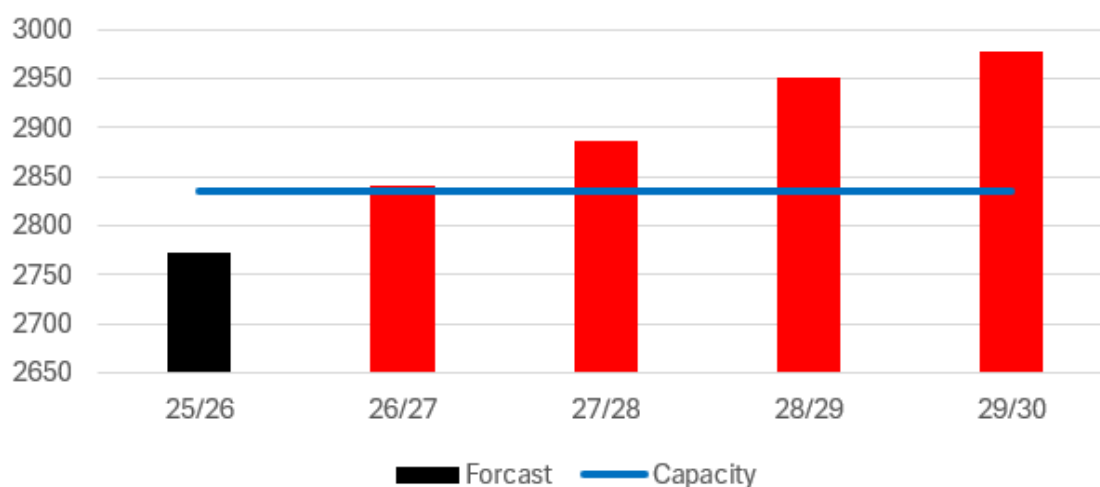

There is enough capacity in the 4 Braunstone schools 2027, 2181, 2005 and 2375 which share a catchment area. 151 City pupils in planning area.

2039 - New Lubbesthorpe Primary opened in Sep 19. September 2024 is the first-year pupil numbers (65) from the catchment area were above the 60 PAN. This was a 60% increase from 2023's 37 pupils.

Future Actions

2039 – New Lubbethorpe Primary non catchment applications pushed back to catchment schools for 2024. Analysing early years uptake from the catchment area to help forecasting for 2025. Working with the developer to open a new 210 place block at this school by 15 - 30 places per year places from 2026. Possible need to add an extra 15 from September 2025 to enable all catchment children to attend. In discussions with the trust.

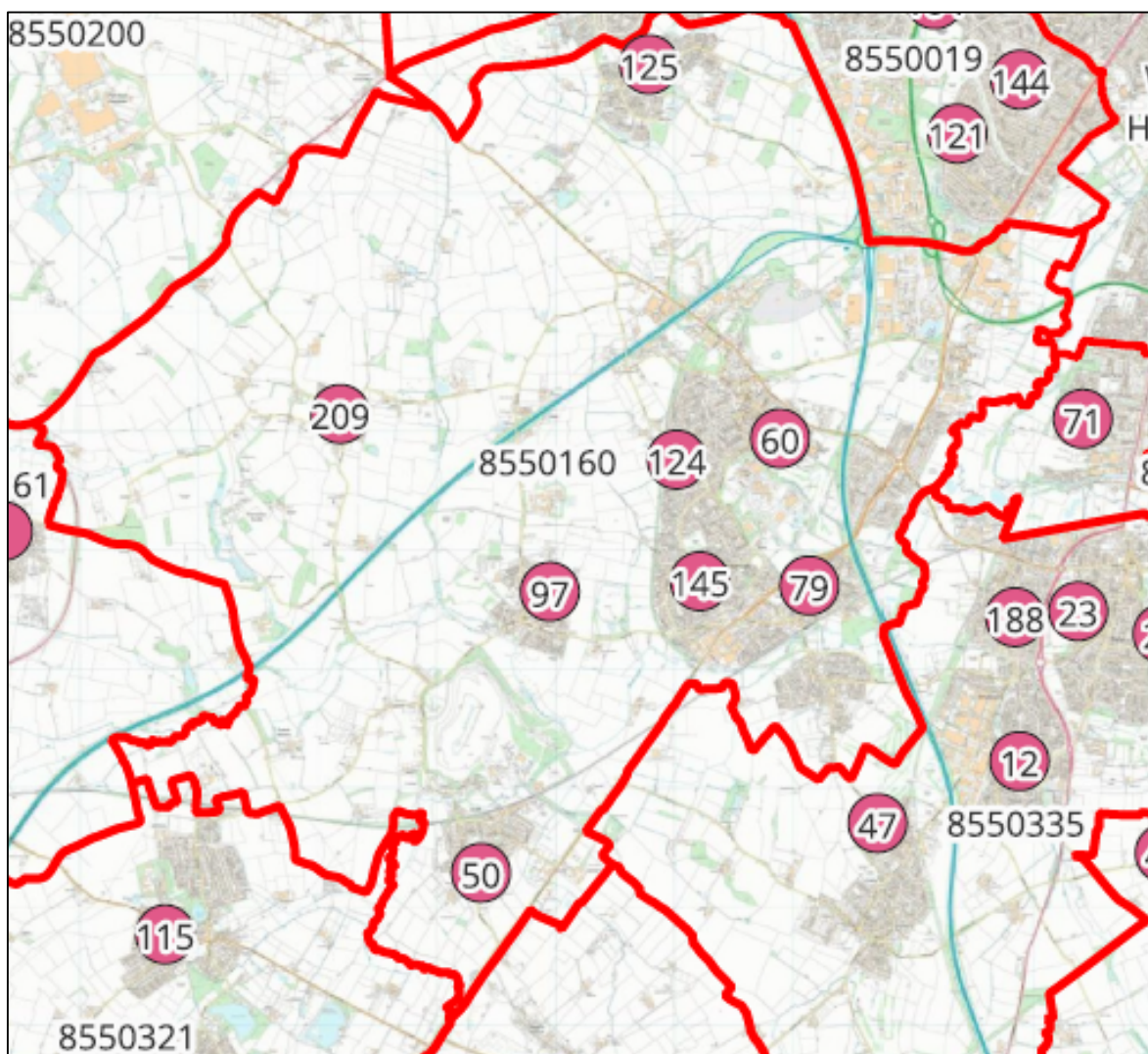

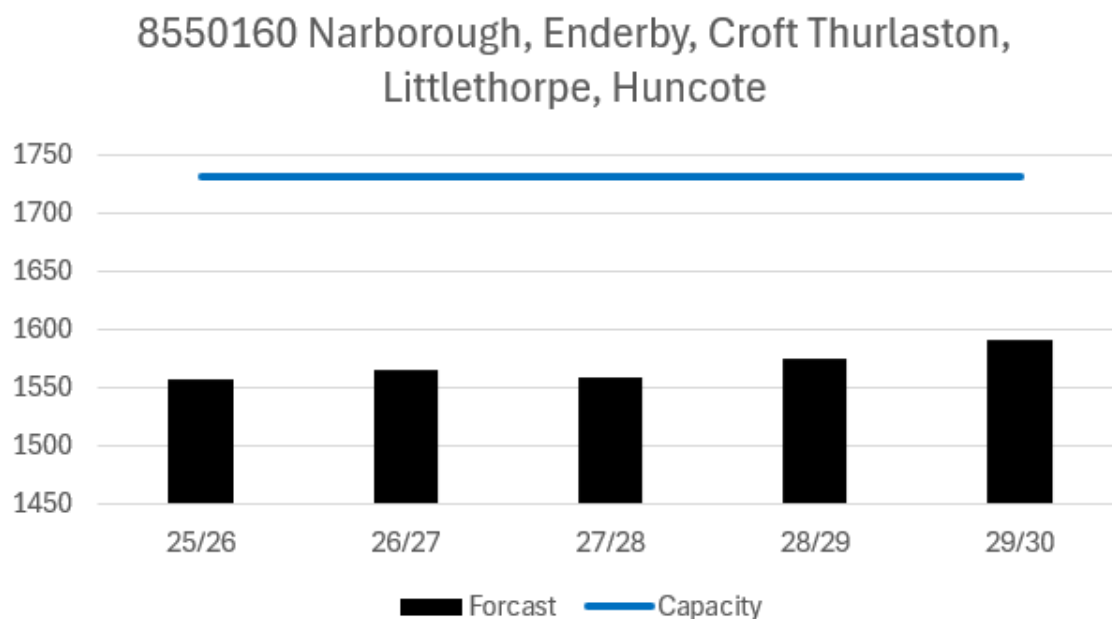

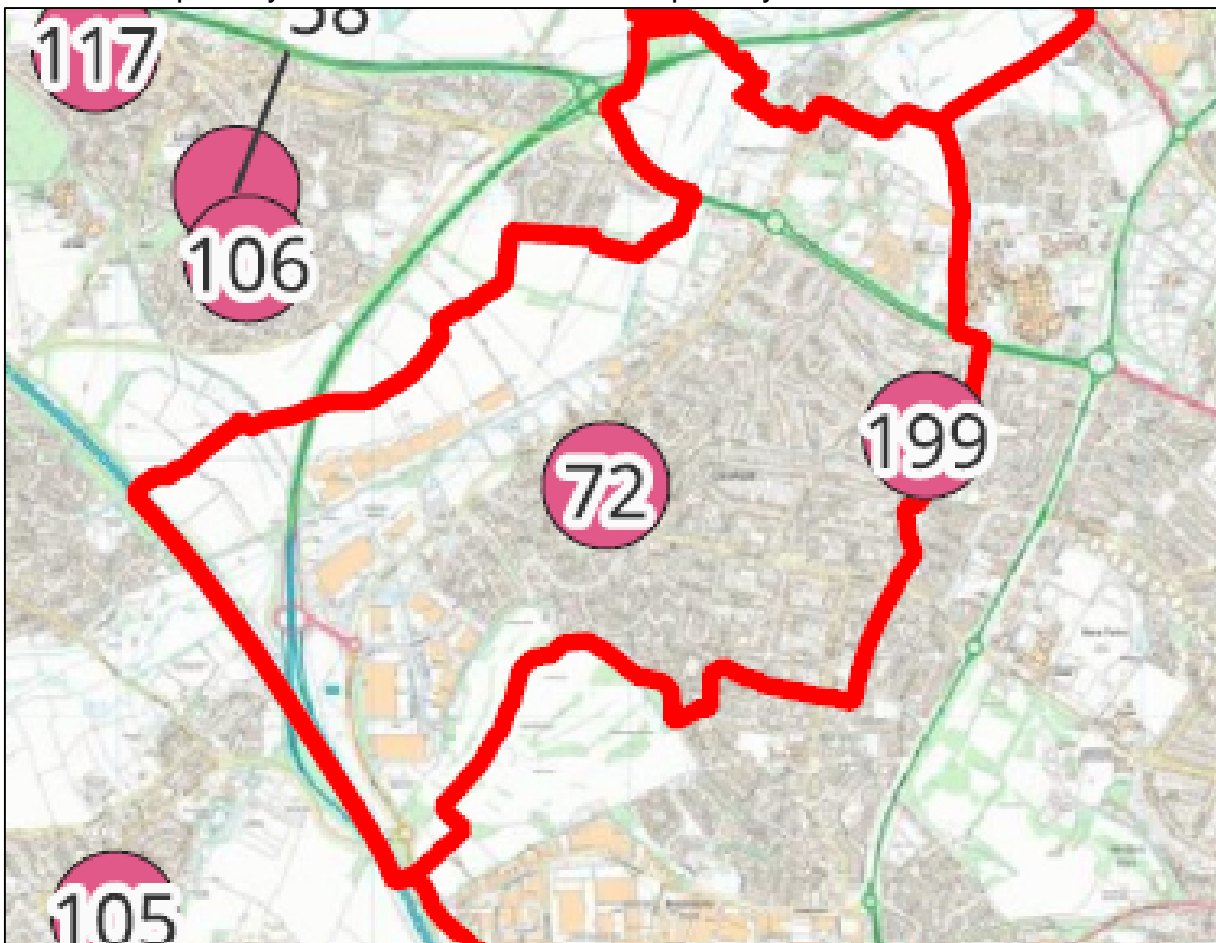

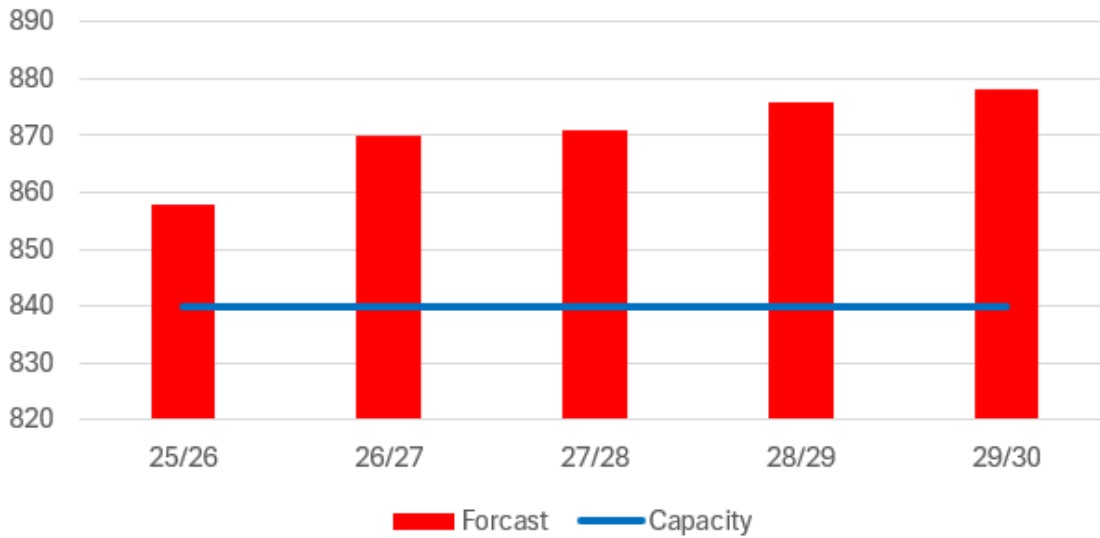


A map showing the Glenfield Primary planning area. There are 2 primary schools. The table below provides the map reference numbers alongside relevant school names.

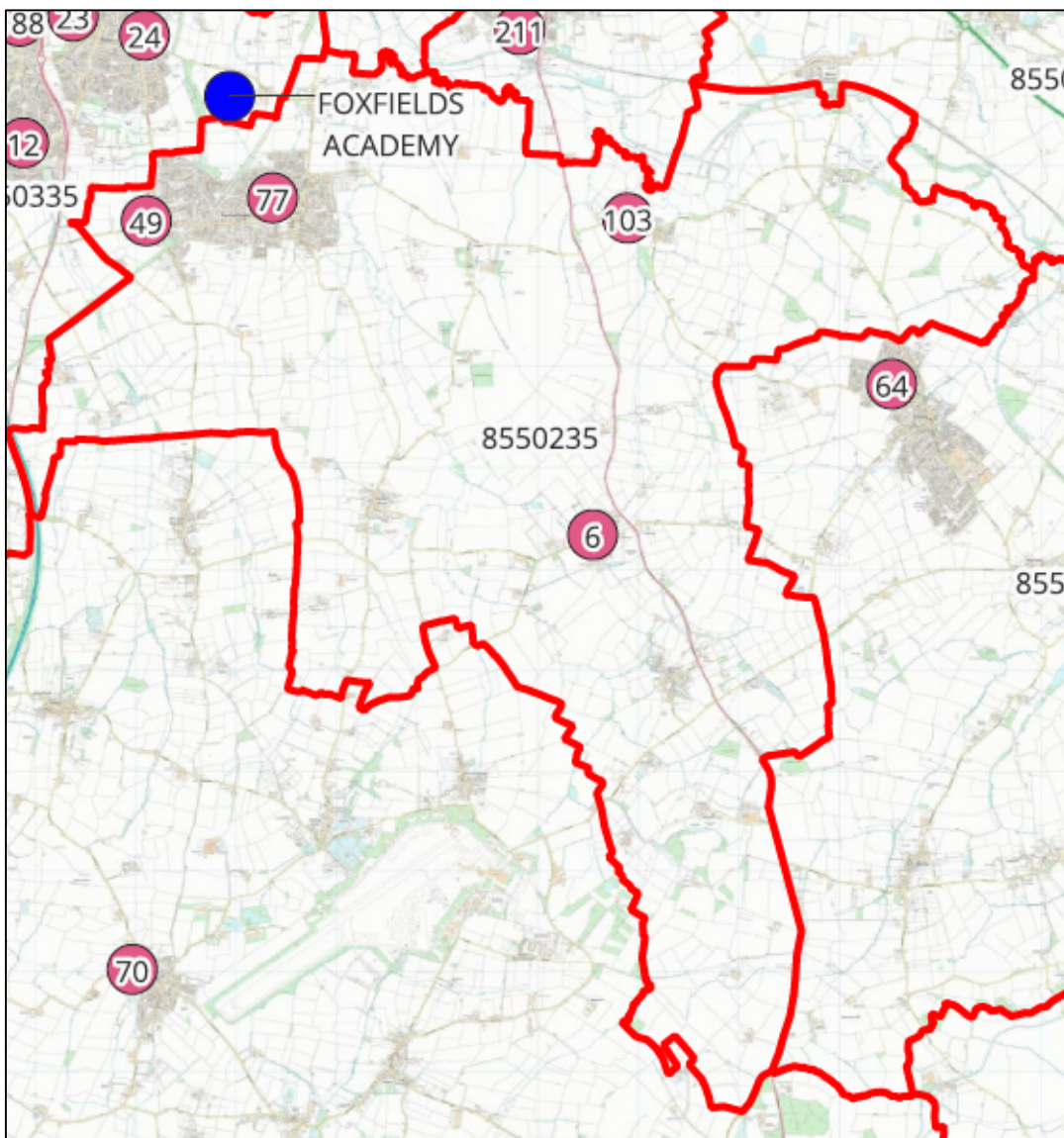

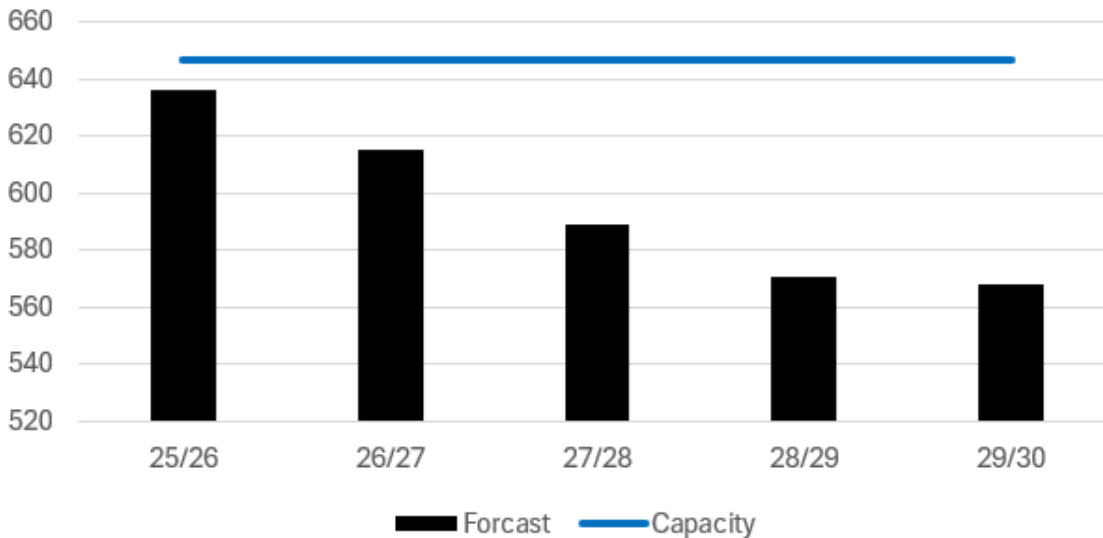


A map showing the Countesthorpe Arnesby Kilby Primary planning area. There are 2 schools. The table below provides the map reference numbers alongside relevant school names.

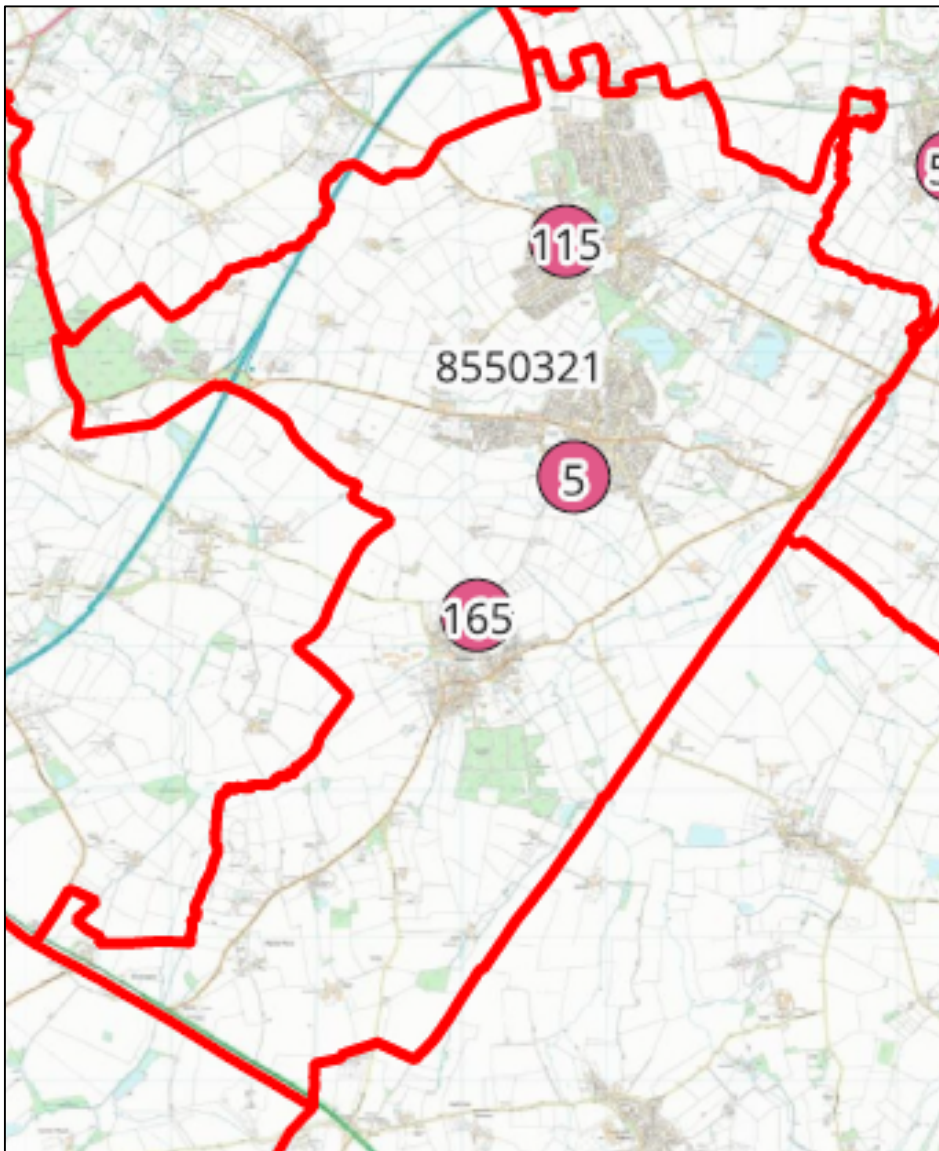

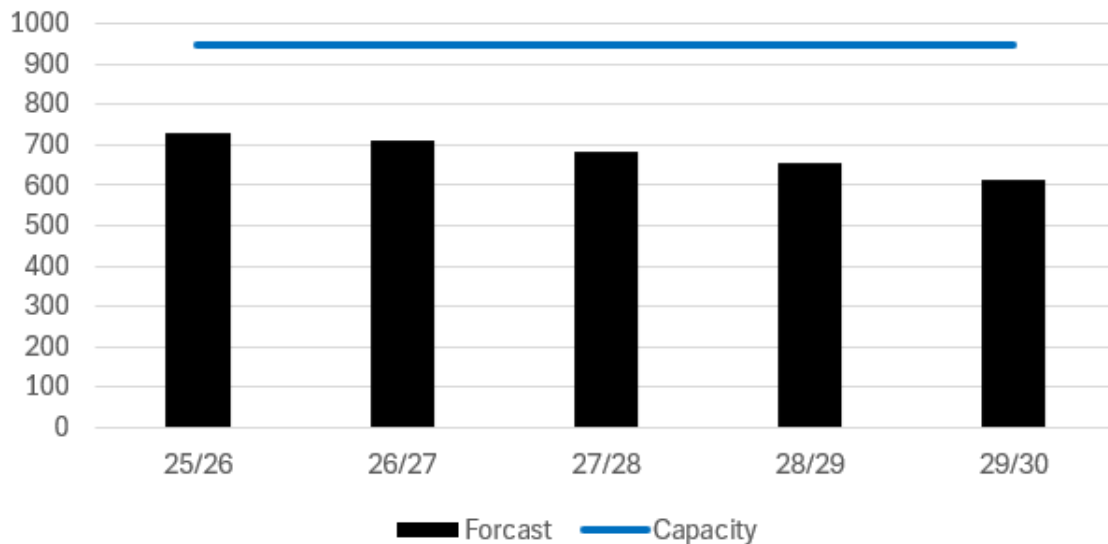


A map showing the Stoney Sapcote Sharnford Primary planning area. There are 3 schools. The table below provides the map reference numbers alongside relevant school names.

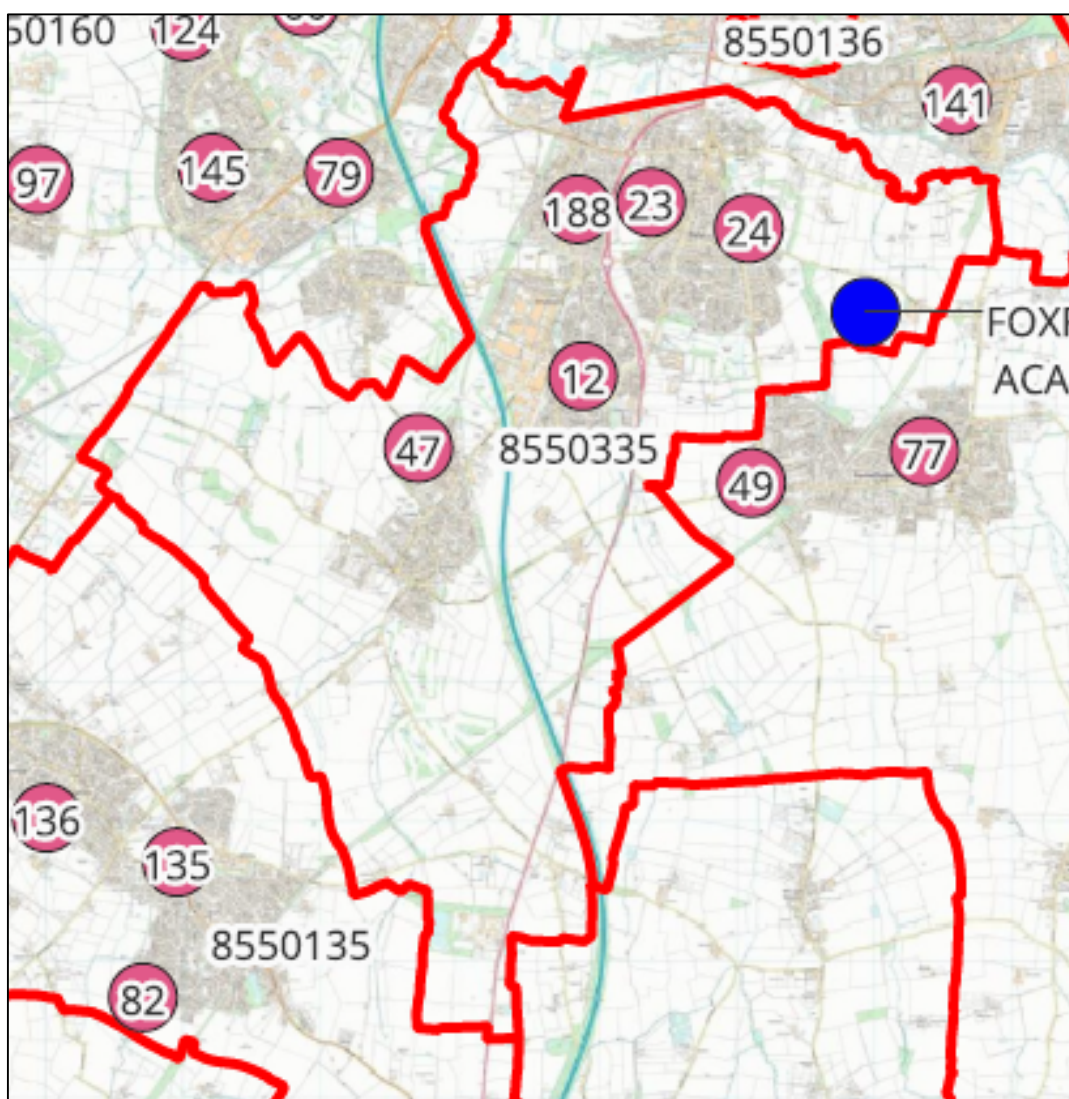

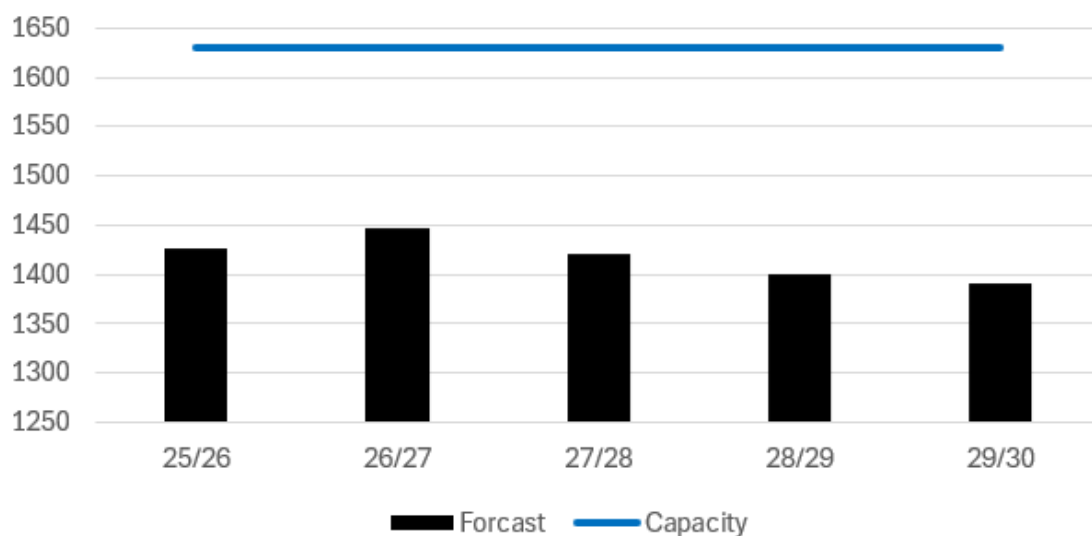


A map showing the Blaby Whetstone Cosby Primary planning area. There are 5 schools. The table below provides the map reference numbers alongside relevant school names.

2038 Blaby Stokes Primary – agreed to re-purpose one school building for SEND provision expected to be open Sept 2026. Resulting in permanent reduction in net capacity of Blaby Stokes to 210 from Sept 2025.
