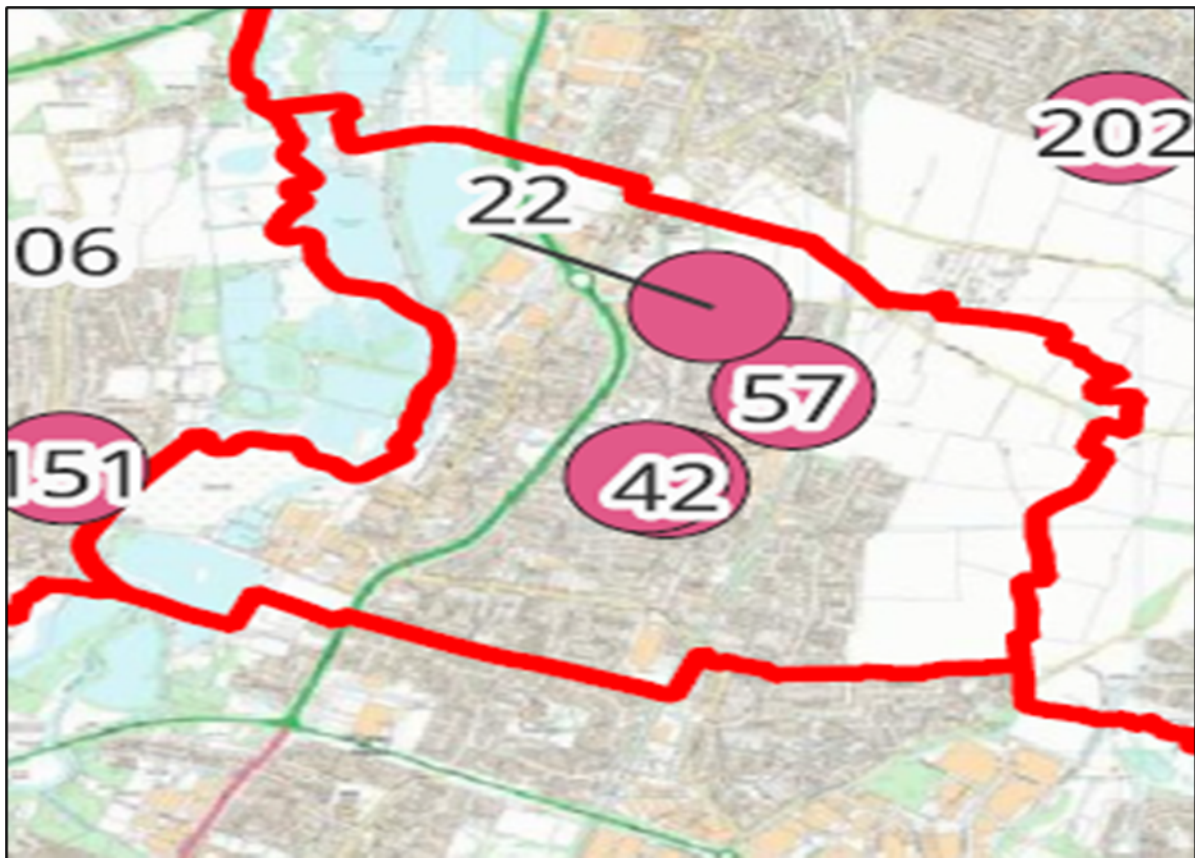

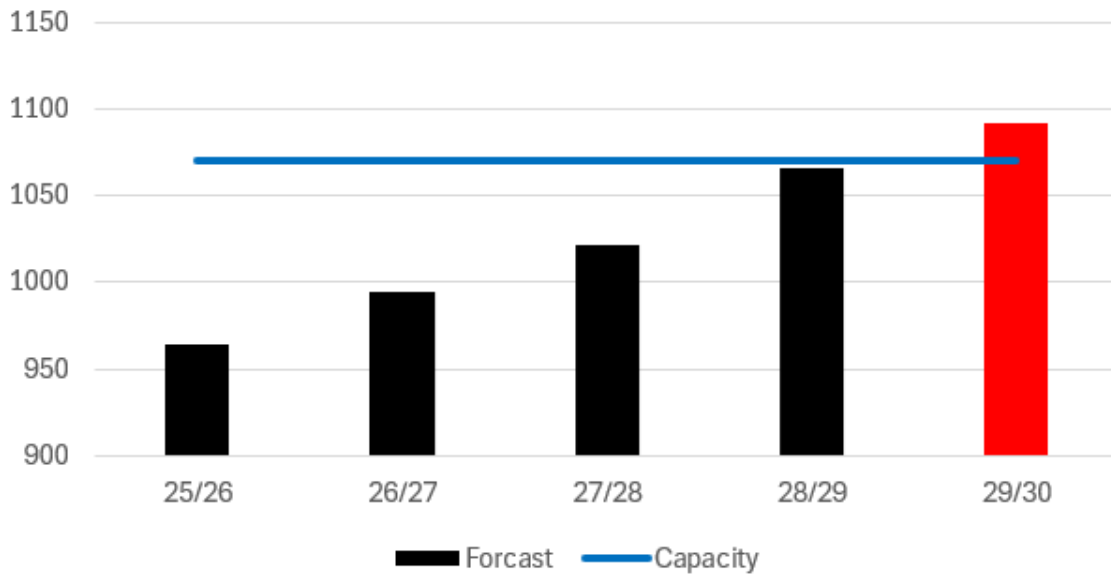


A map showing the Charnwood Primary planning area. There are 4 primary schools. The table below provides the map reference numbers alongside relevant school names.

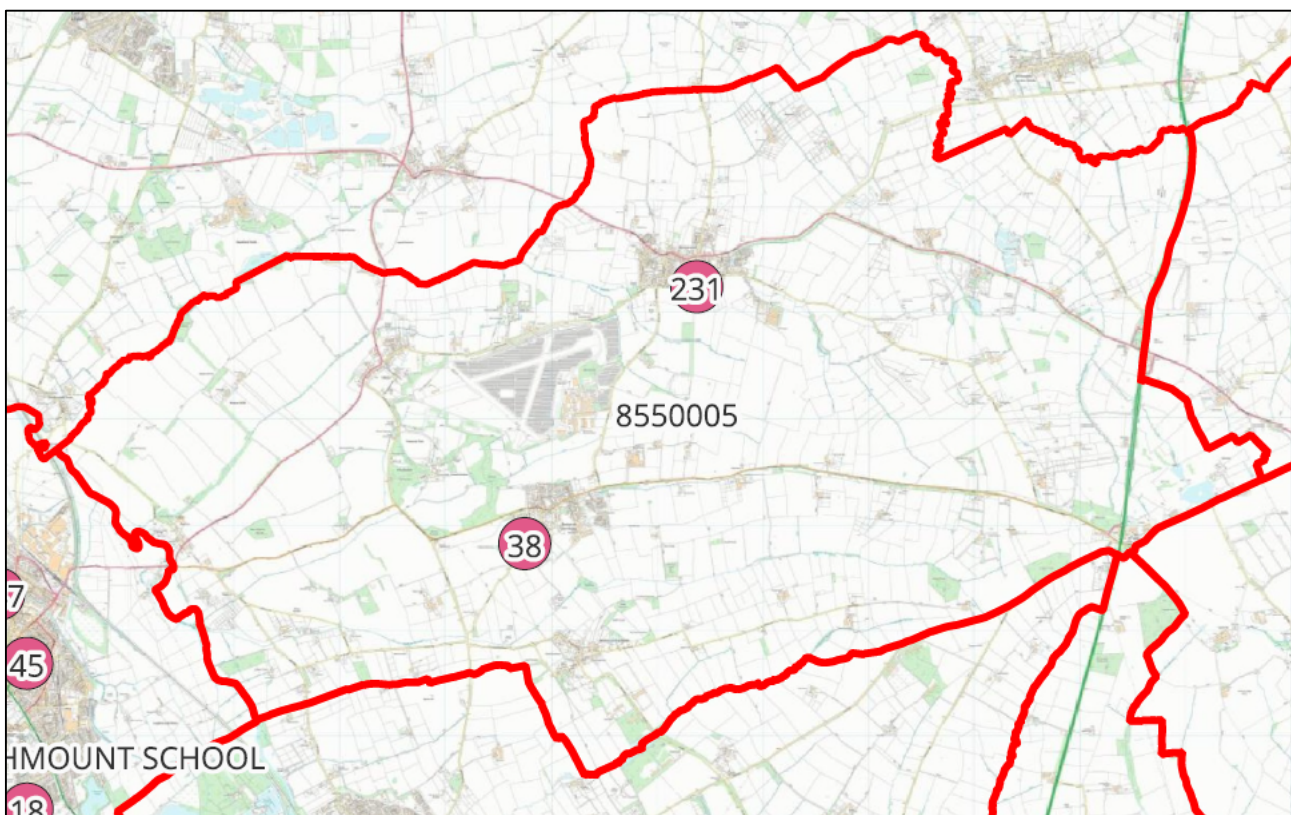

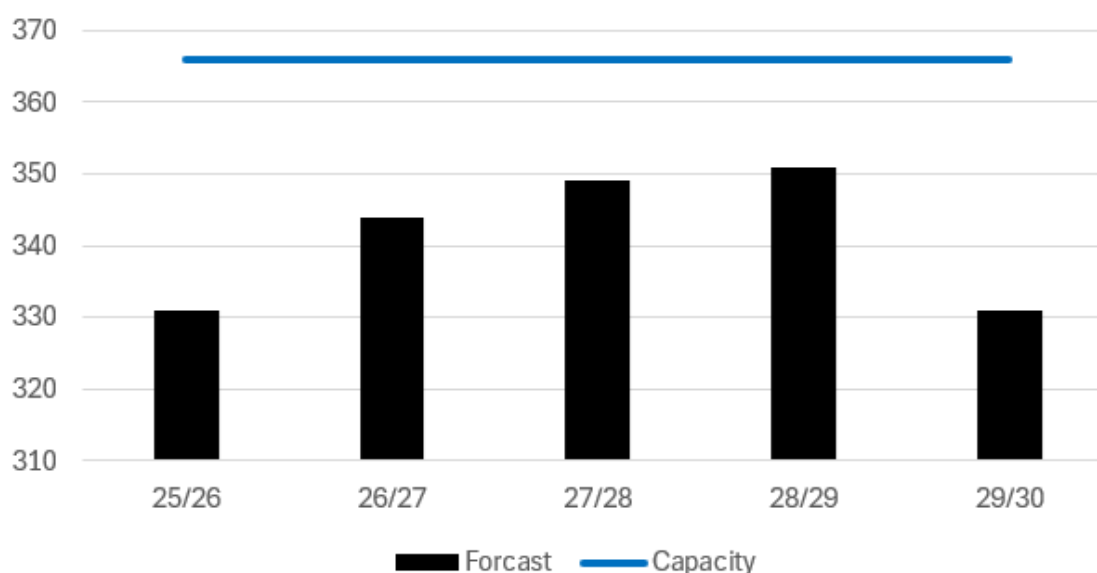


A map showing the Burton Wymeswold Primary planning area. There are 2 primary schools. The table below provides the map reference numbers alongside relevant school names.

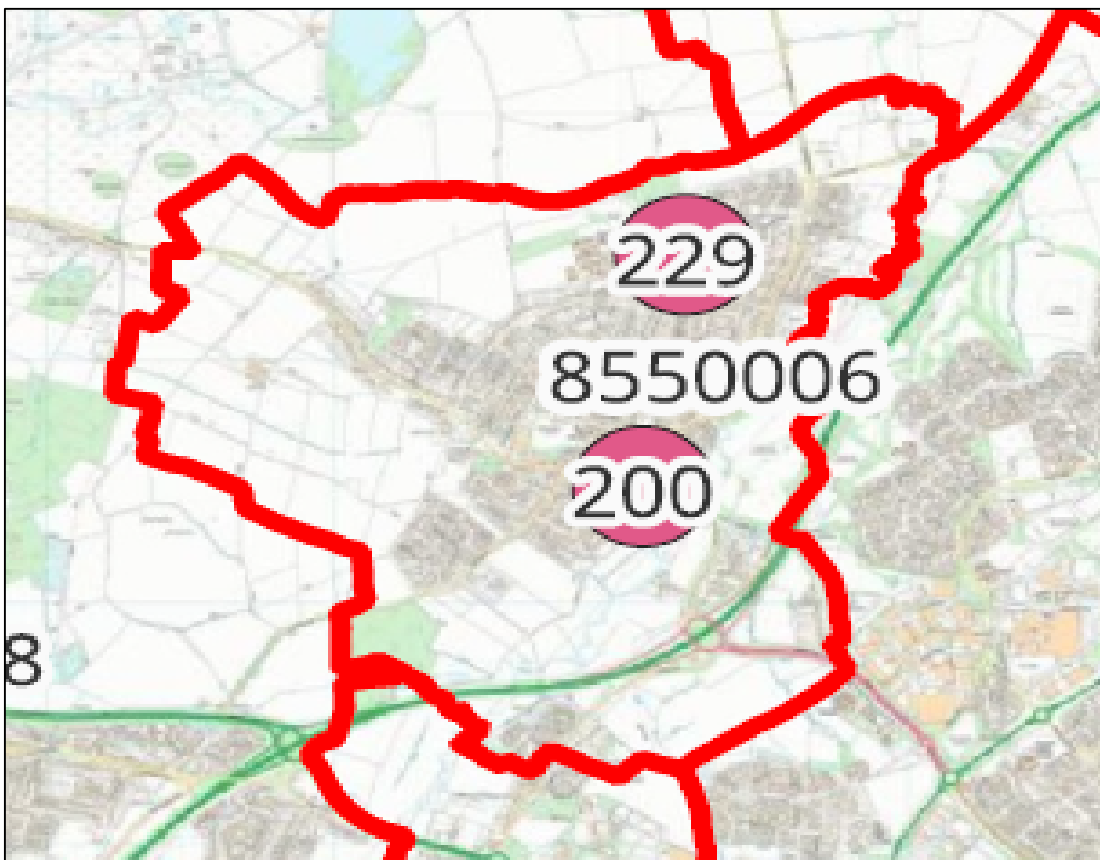

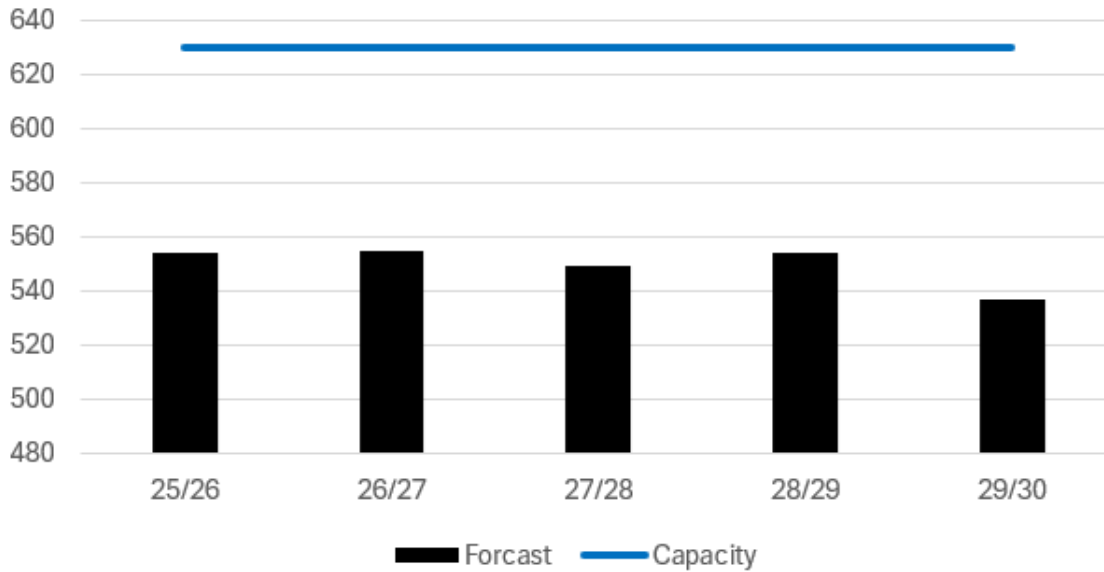

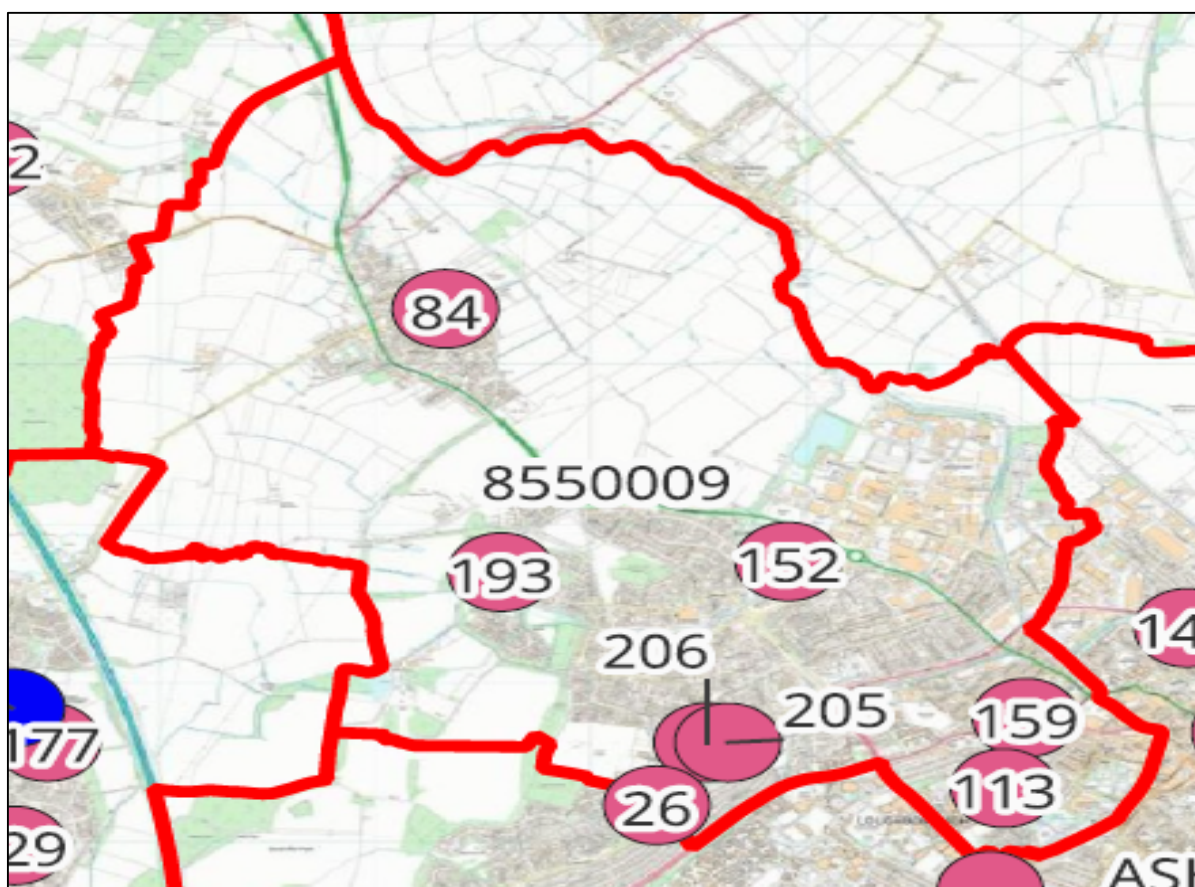

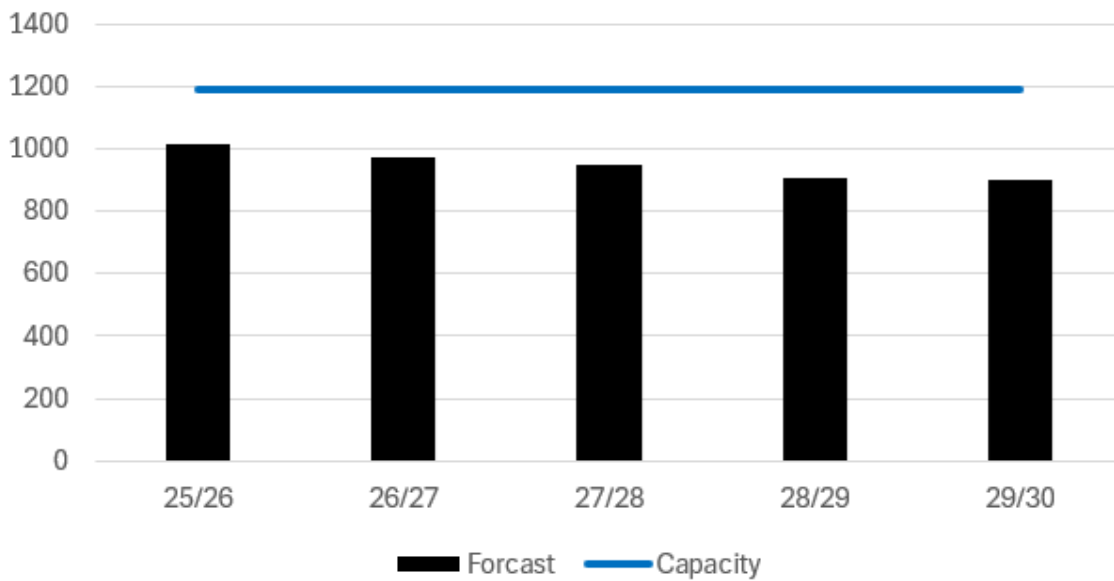


A map showing the Loughborough North Primary planning area. There are 5 schools. The table below provides the map reference numbers alongside relevant school names.

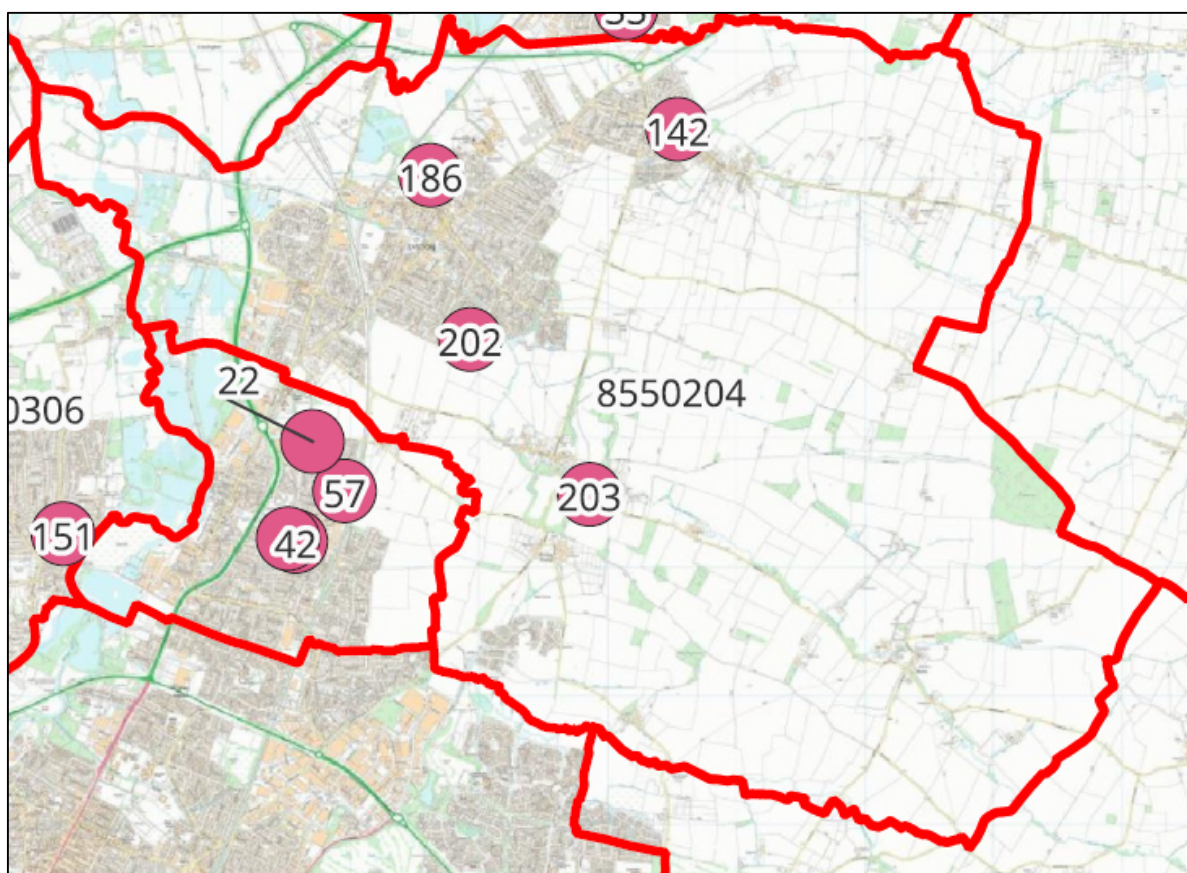

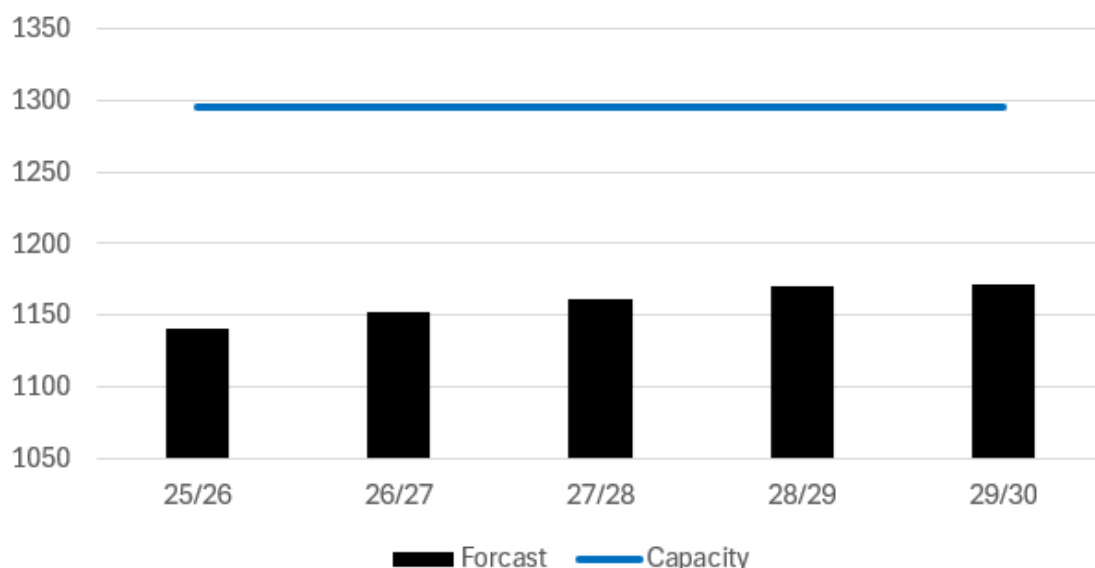


A map showing the Barkby Syston Queniborough Primary planning area. There are 4 schools. The table below provides the map reference numbers alongside relevant school names.

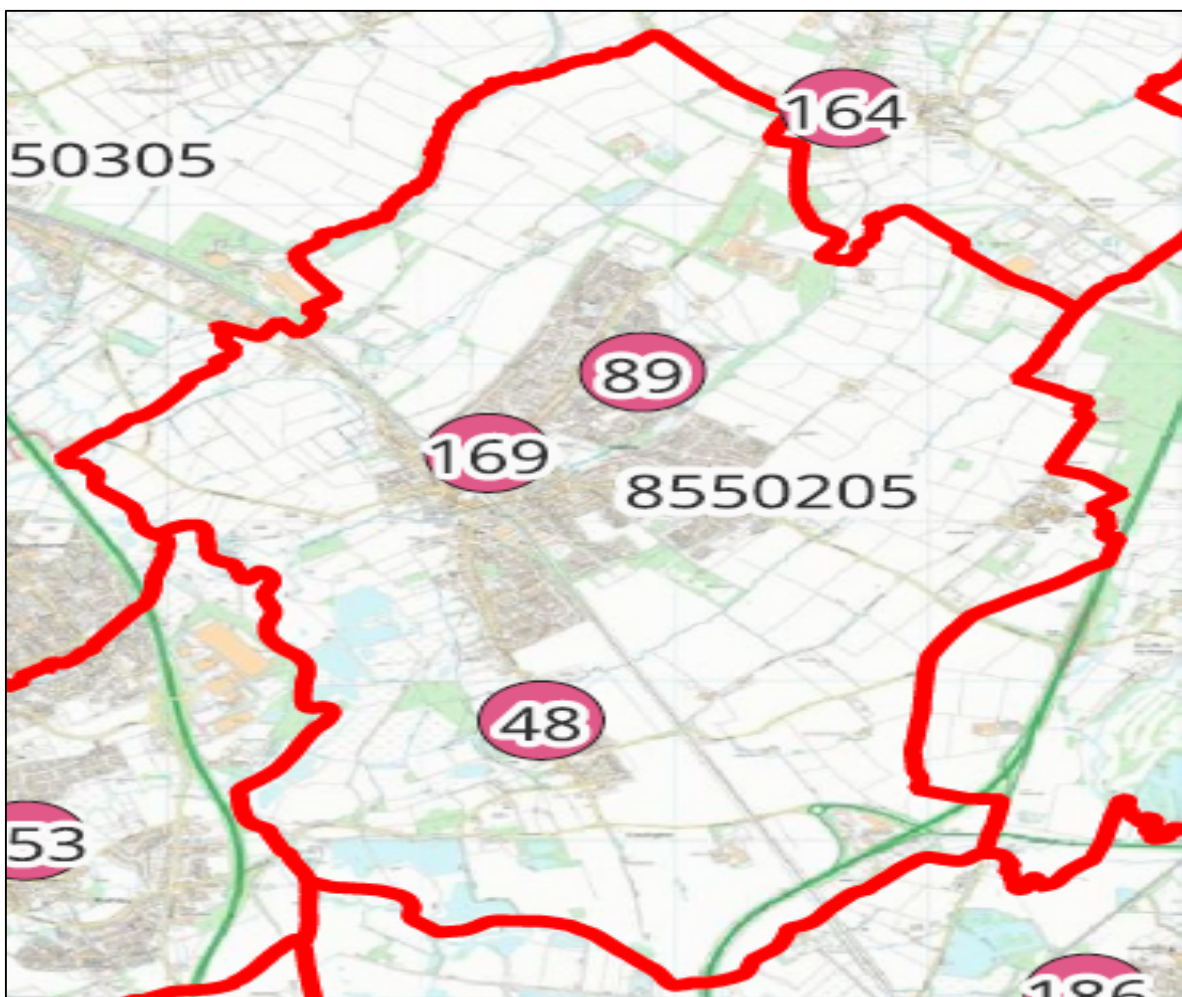

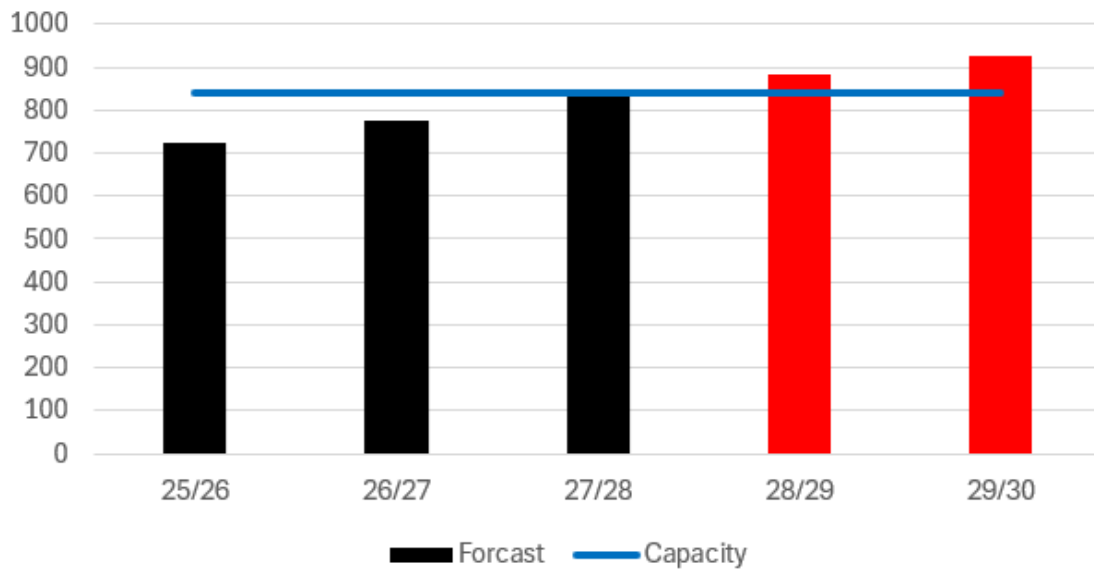

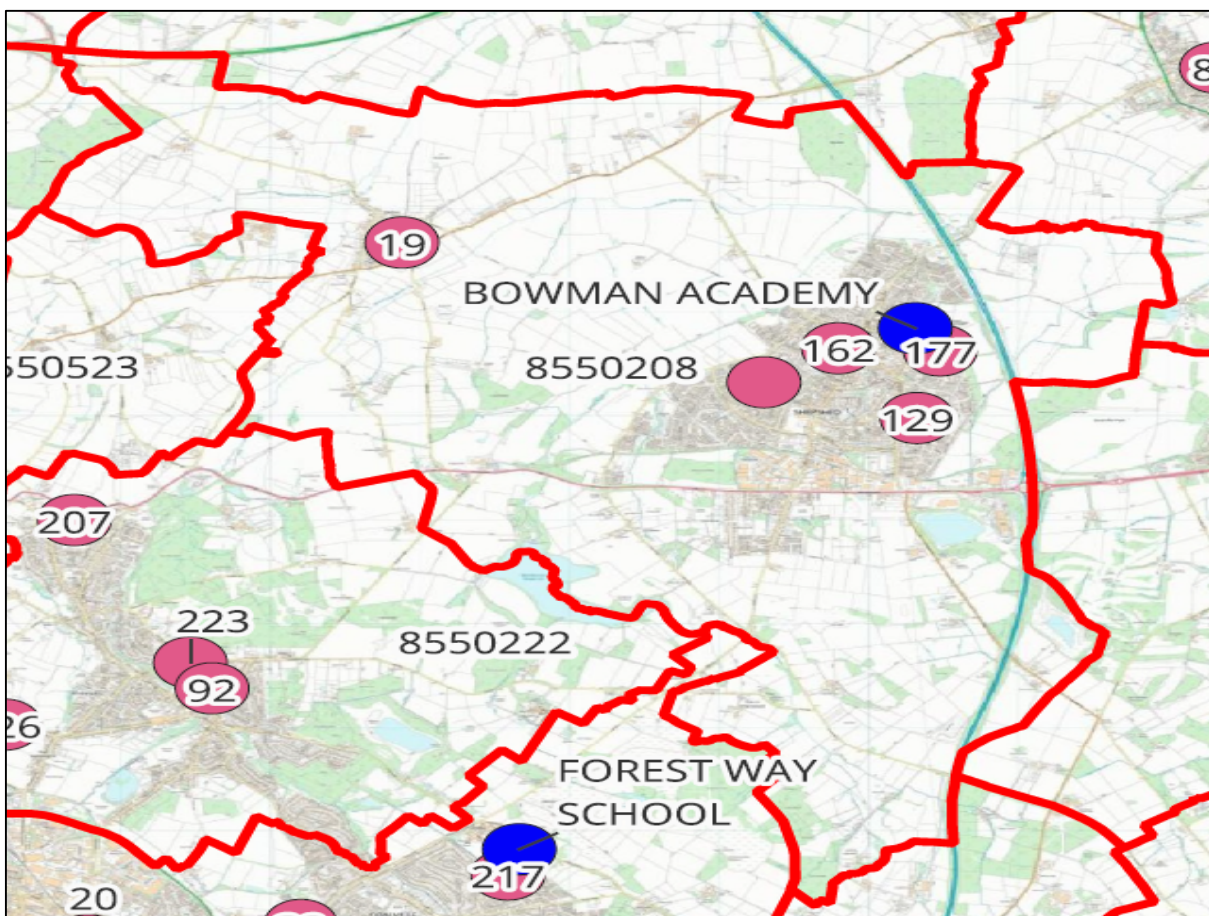

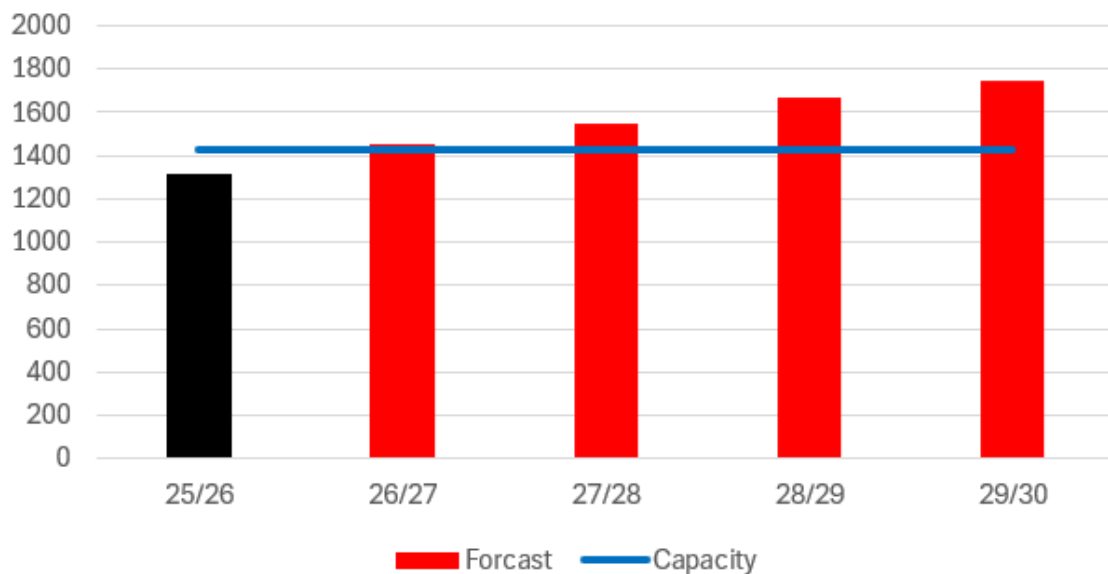


A map showing the Shepshed Belton planning area. There are 5 schools. The table below provides the map reference numbers alongside relevant school names.

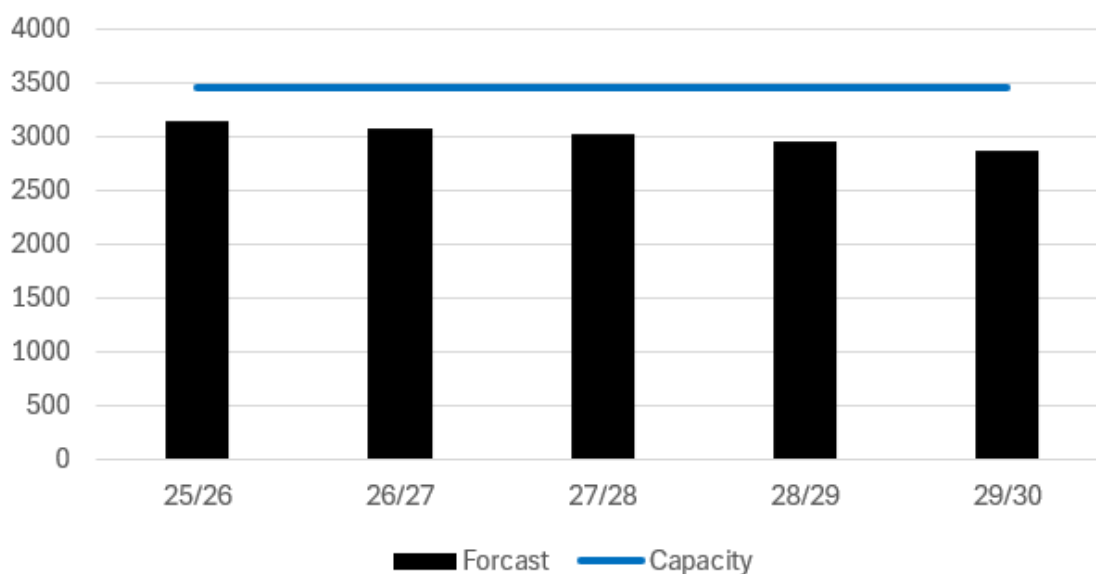

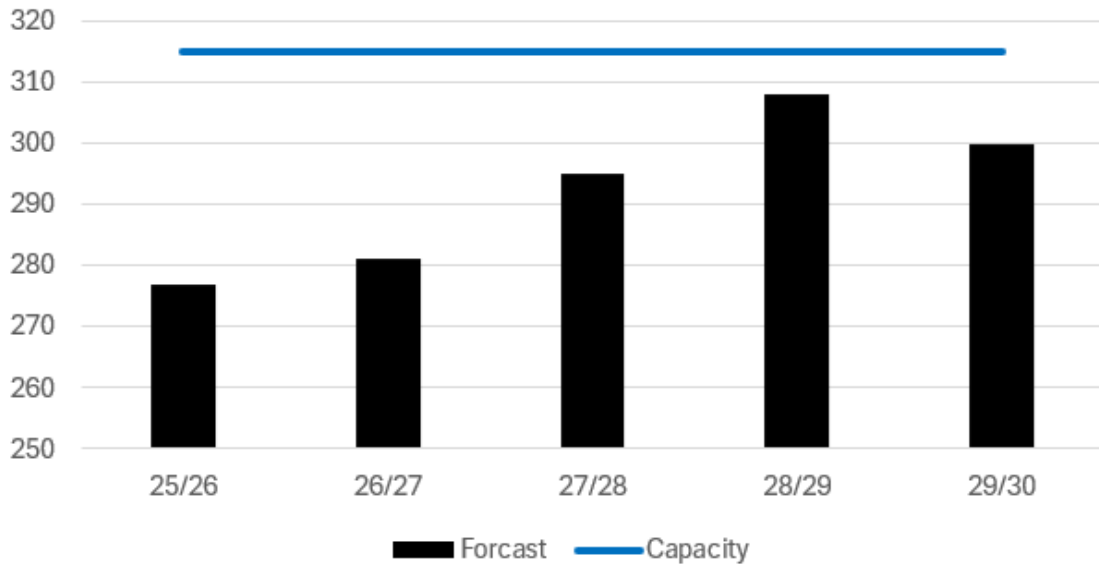

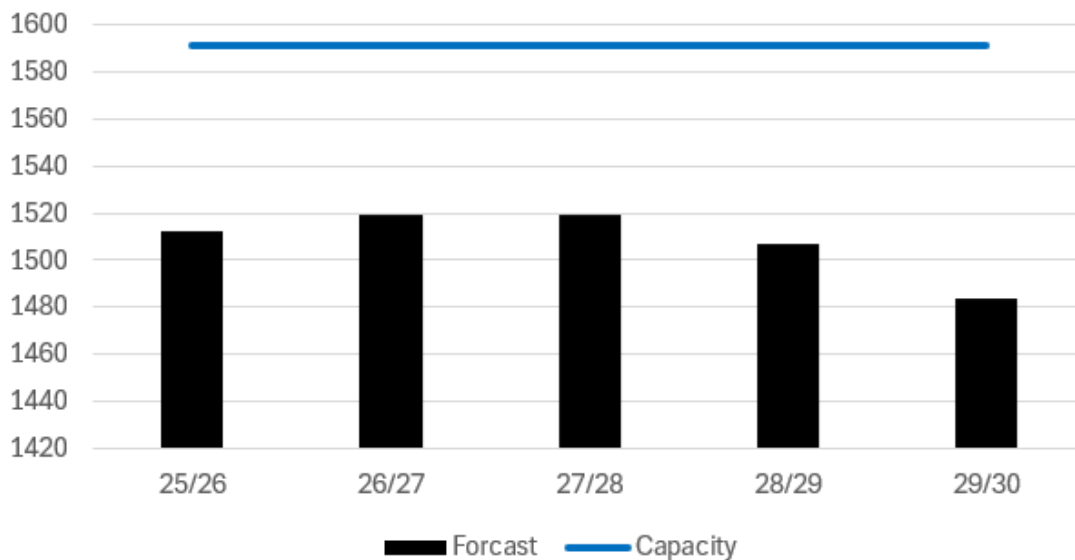

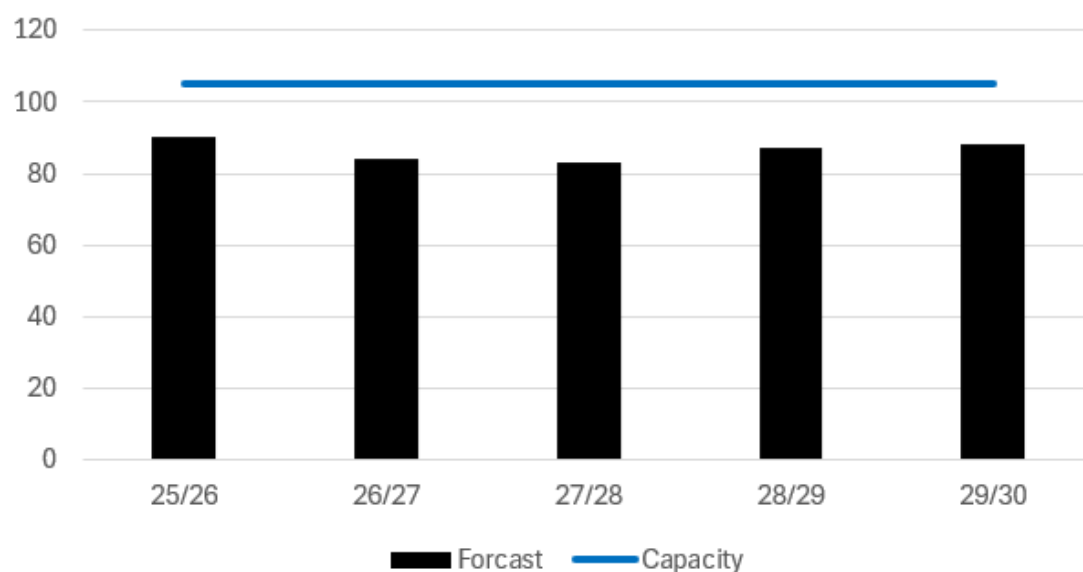
