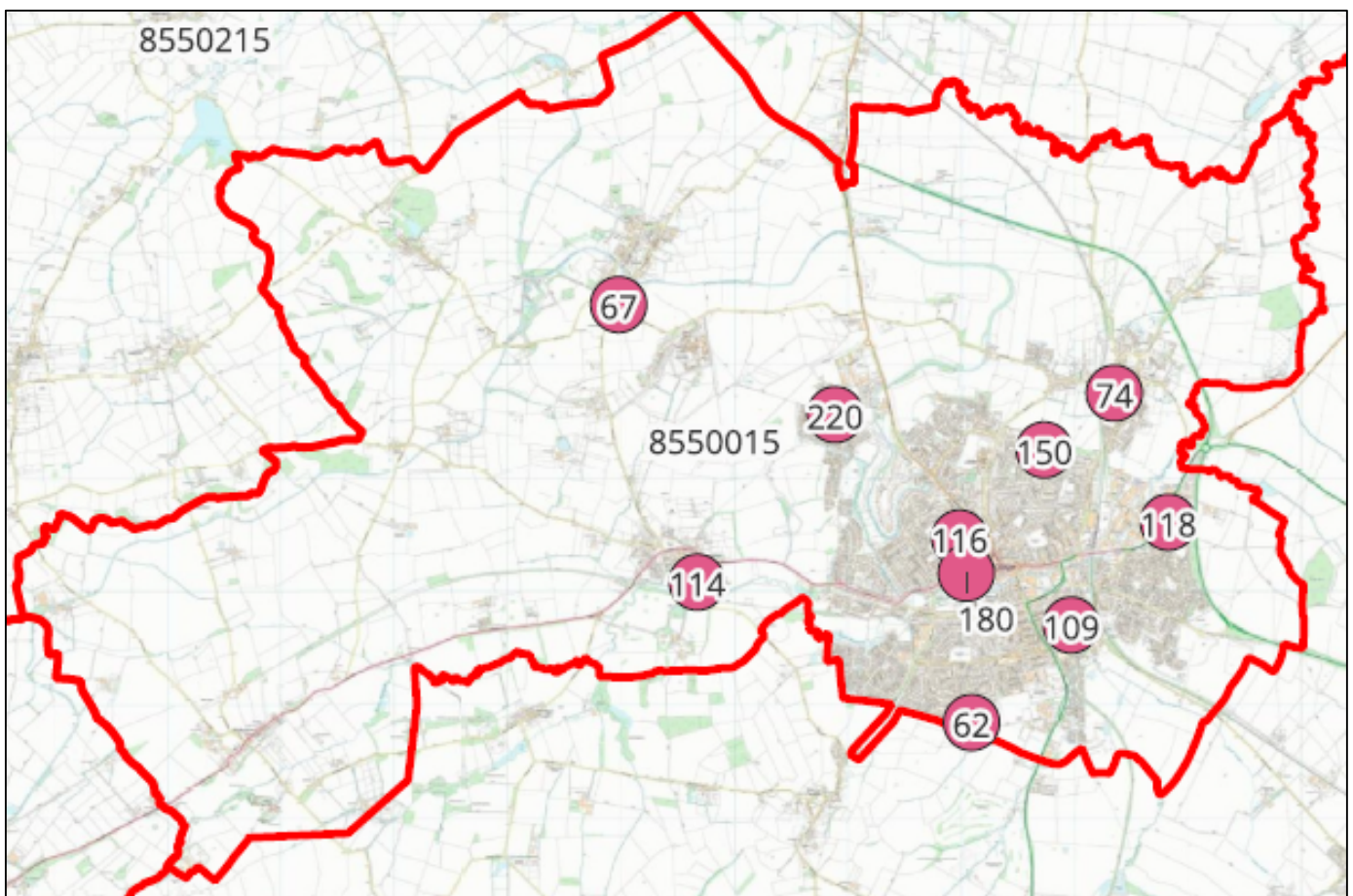

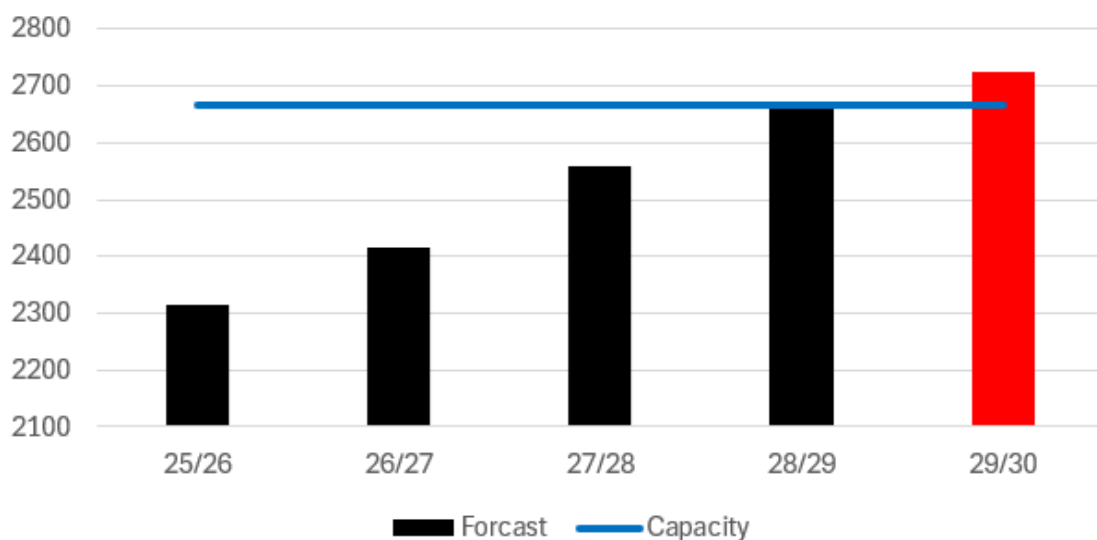

## Current Overview

Significant housing developments around Market Harborough over the last few years with more planned. Resultant increased demand for primary school places in the planning area. Significant surplus places forecast for 2025/26 (13.2%) due to establishment of new school (2052) to serve large scale housing development, reducing to deficit of places (57 places) by 2029/30.

Additional significant housing development expected to be allocated in emerging Local Plan.

## Future Actions

A new 1FE primary school (2052) to service a large-scale housing development opened in AY 2024/25 with a reception year group and will continue to open year groups on a phased basis. The school has been built with 2FE infrastructure to accommodate future expansion as the housing development matures.

A development of 600 dwellings at the opposite side of Market Harborough includes provision of land and part funding for a 1FE primary school, timings for delivery of this school will be based on future forecasts.

Several schools in the planning area (2176, 2036) have reduced PAN to address the current shorter-term surplus of places and discussions will be held with these schools and MATs regarding alternative uses and safeguarding of surplus capacity going forward.

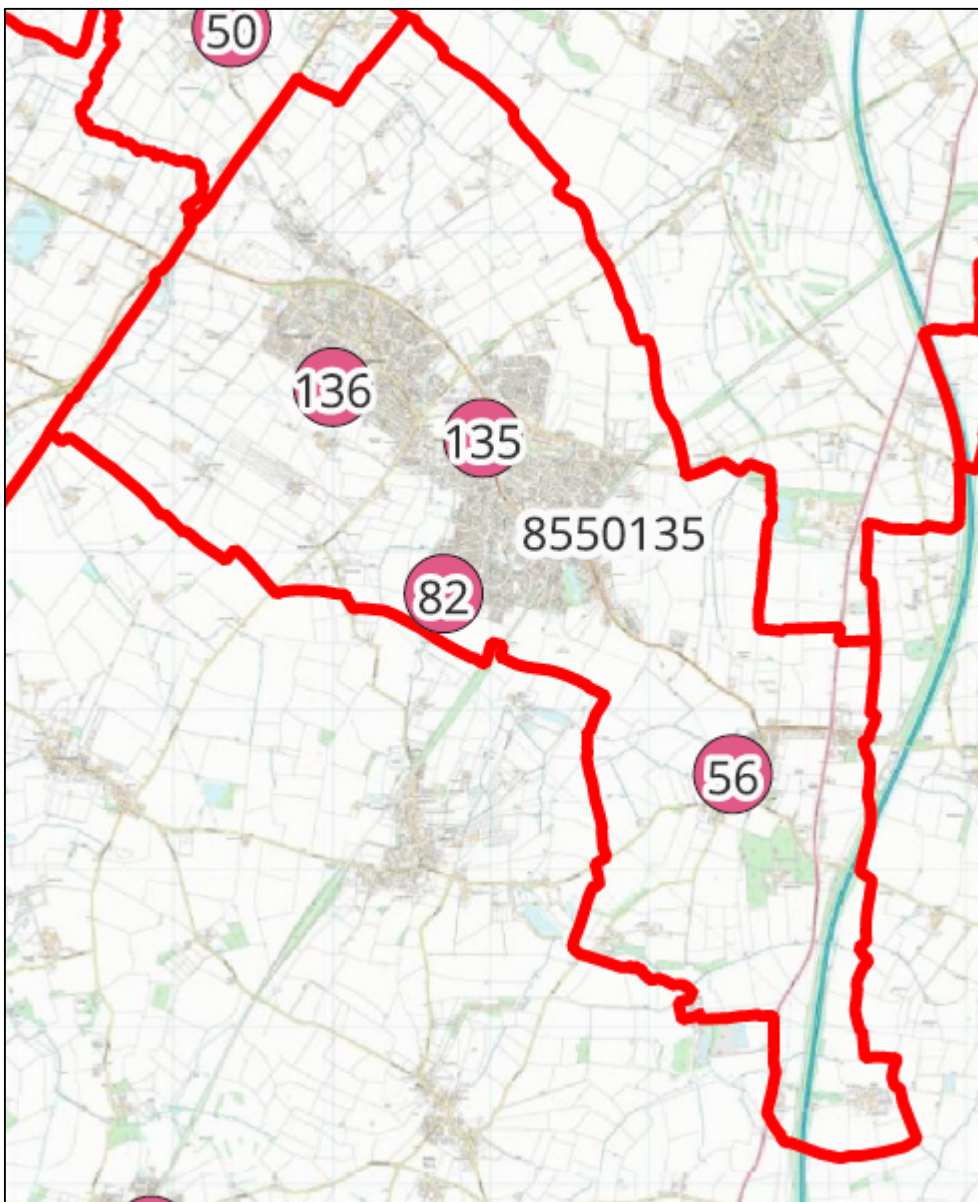

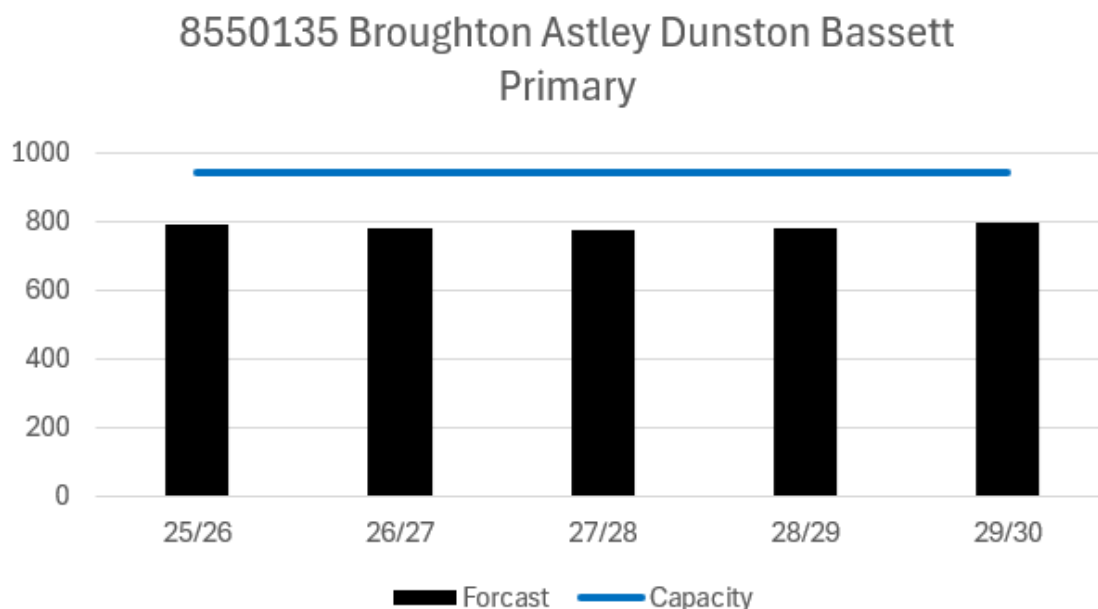

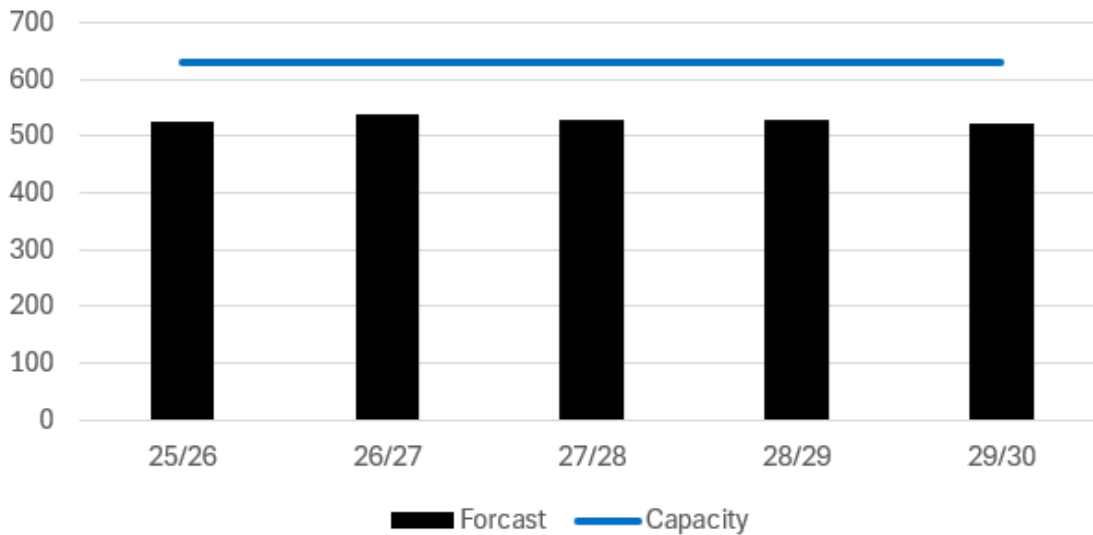

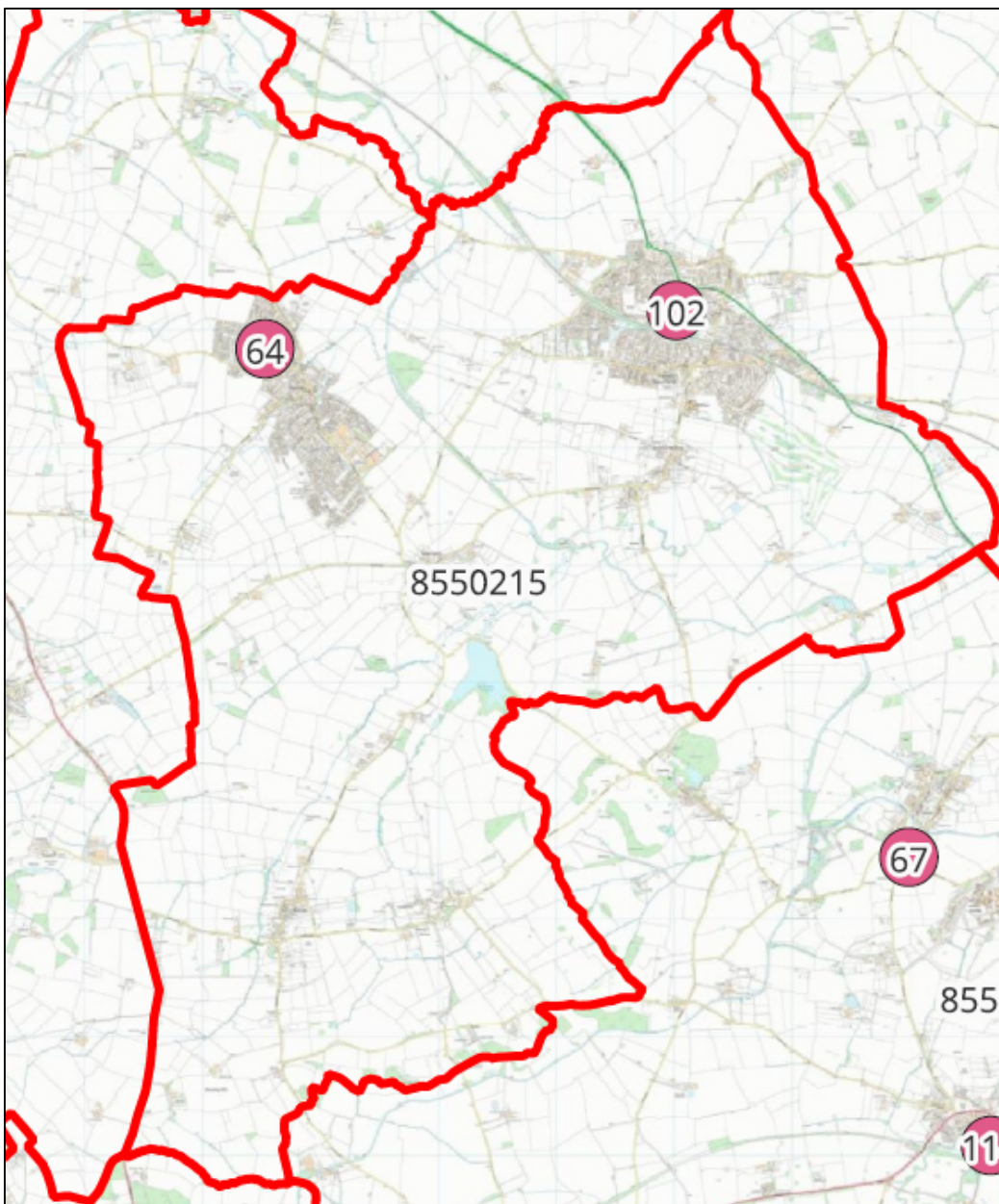

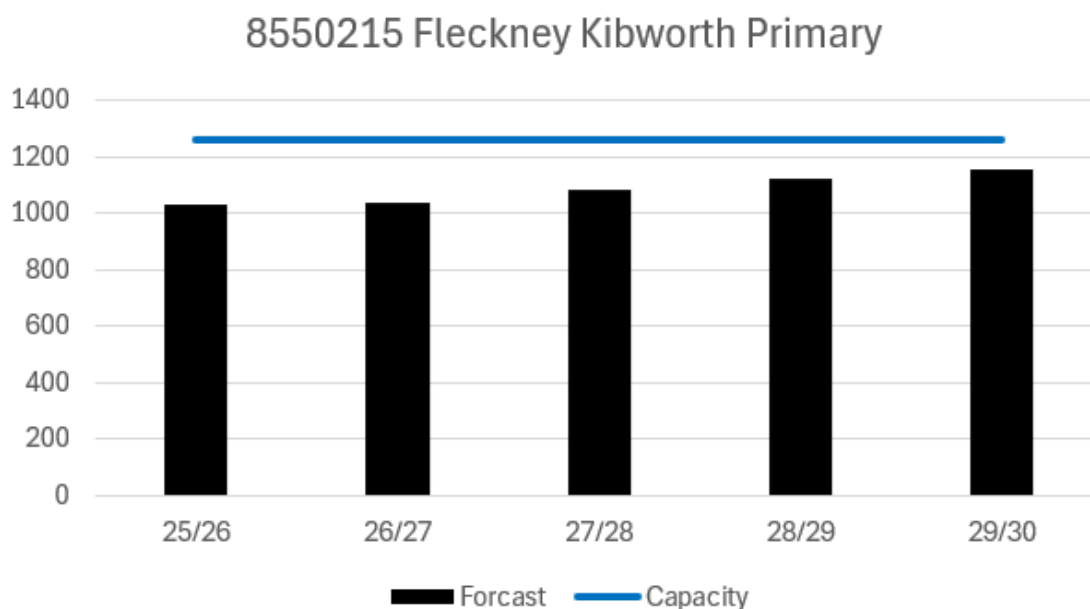

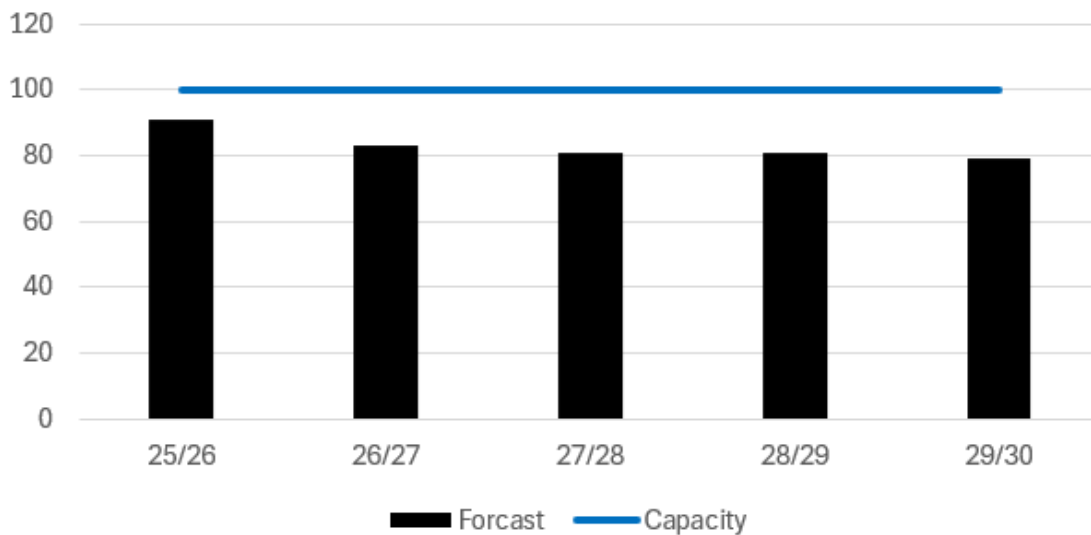

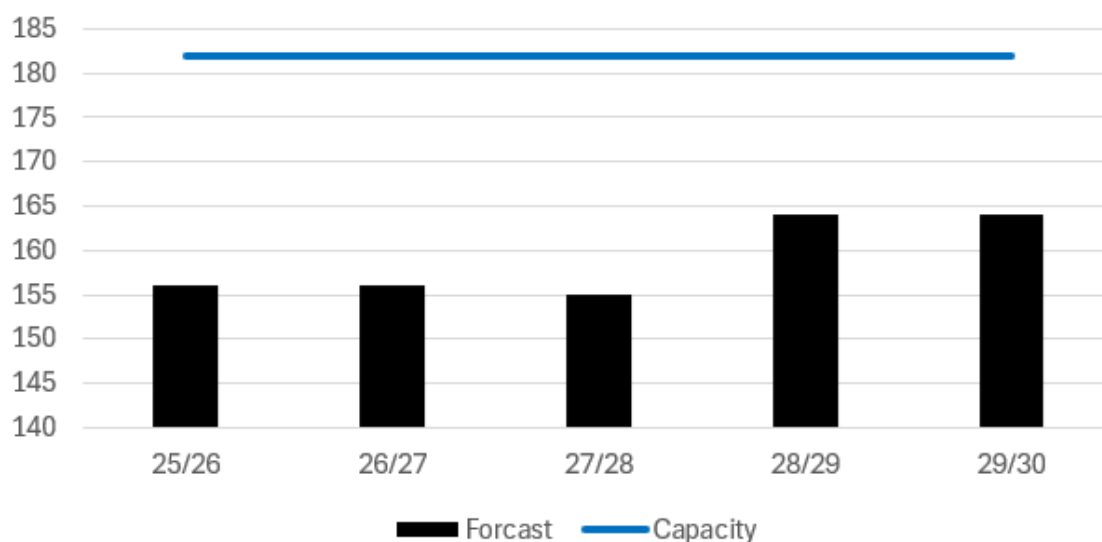

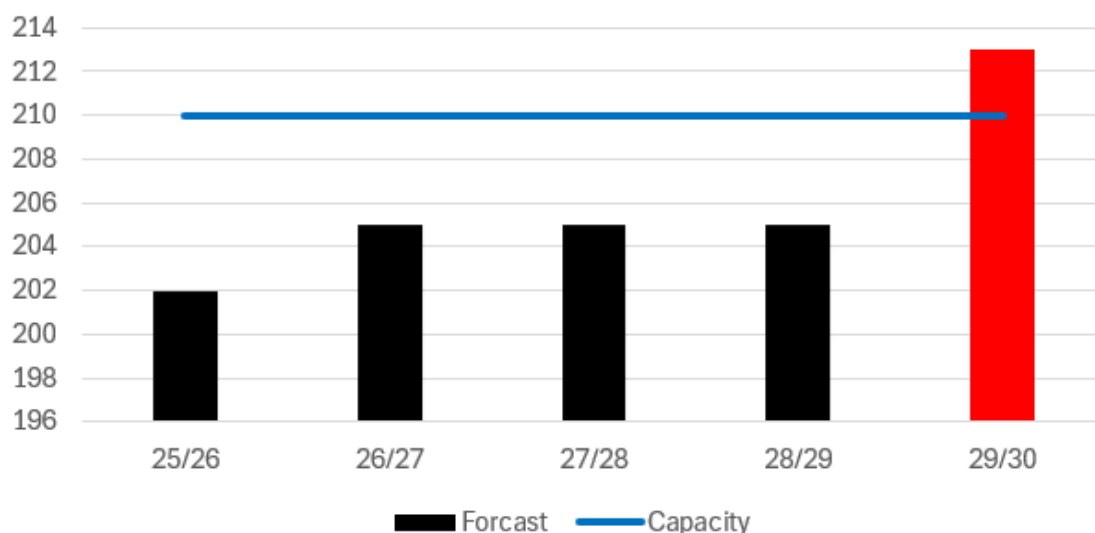
