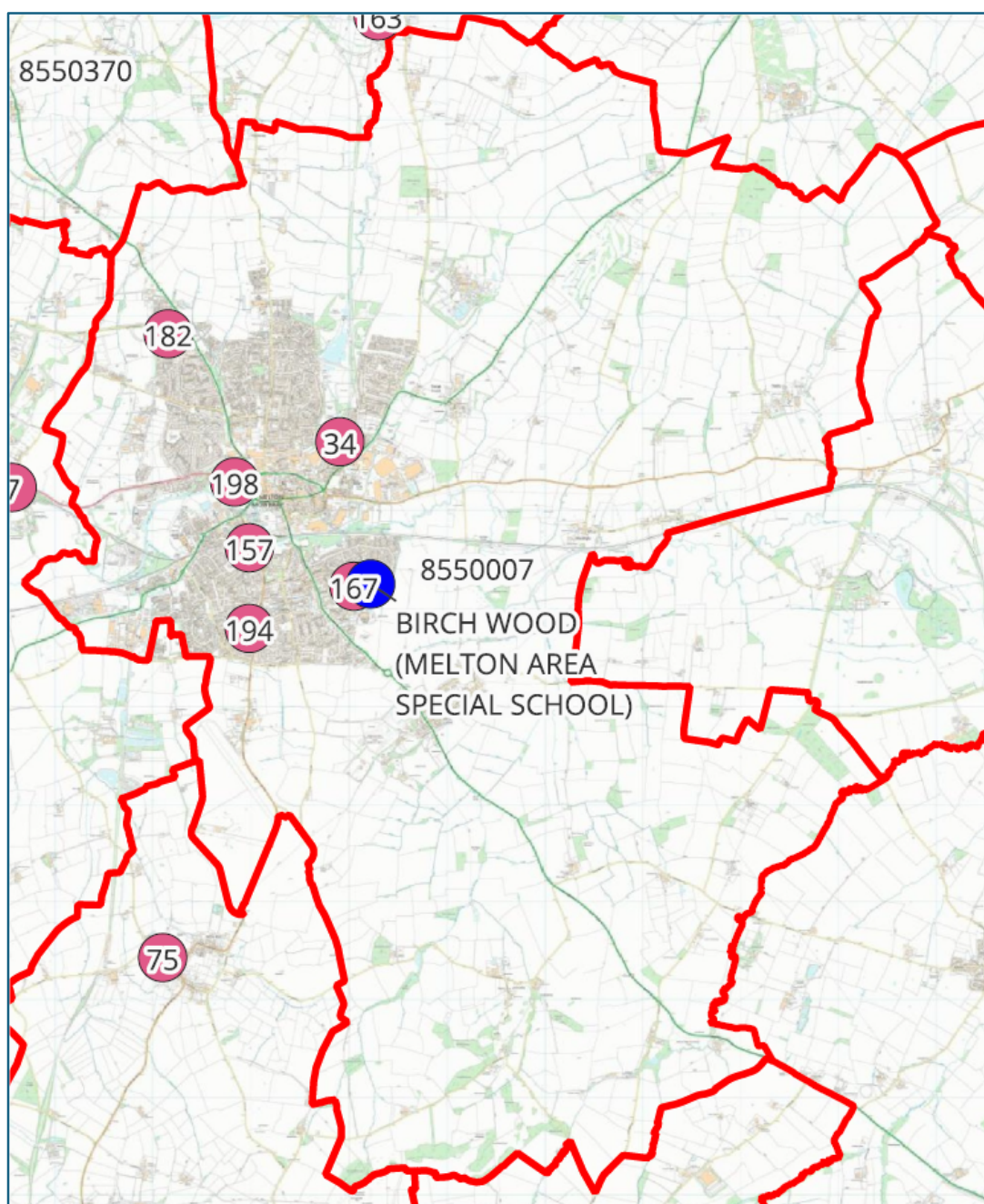

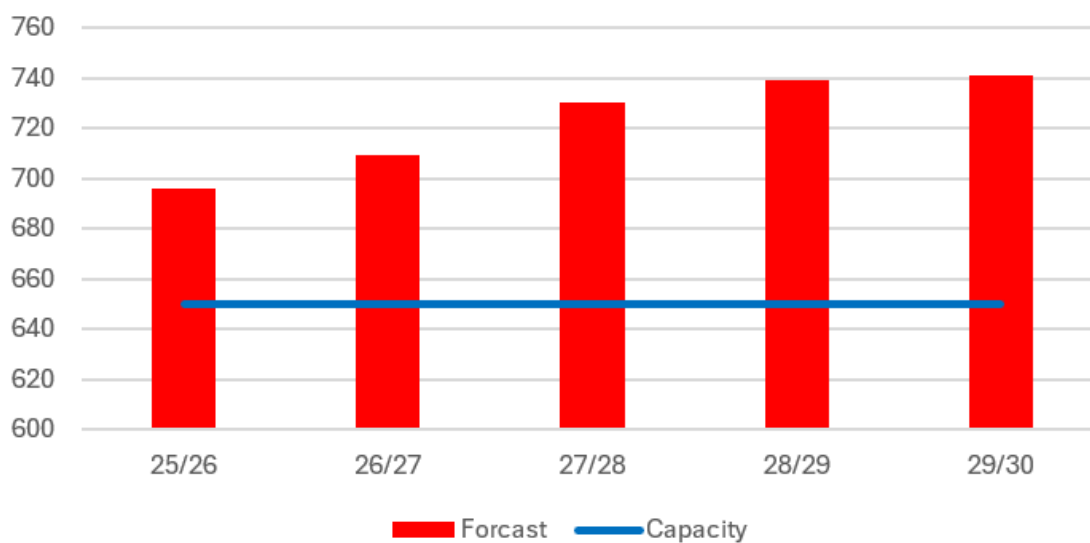

Current Overview

There is large scale development planned in Melton town as part of the Melton North and Melton South masterplan.

Some of the development is now underway using a Roof Tariff methodology for developer contributions. Discussions continue between Senior Officers at LCC and Melton Borough Council regarding how the development will move forward following delays in the building of the Melton Mowbray Distributor Road and the significant increase in building costs. Planning future school places is difficult until this is resolved.

The forecasts show sufficient places in Melton Town until 2029/30. There are a total of 2,156 primary places in Melton Town and 2,048 places are required in 2028/29. However, the additional capacity is primarily located to the south with development to both the north and south.

Future Actions

The Melton North and Melton South Masterplans include the provision of 630 new school places across the PA. This is made up with a mixture of a new school and development on existing sites. This is currently under review and not captured fully in the data submitted in this SCAP return.

Existing schools will need to accommodate pupils from these developments until the new schools are delivered.

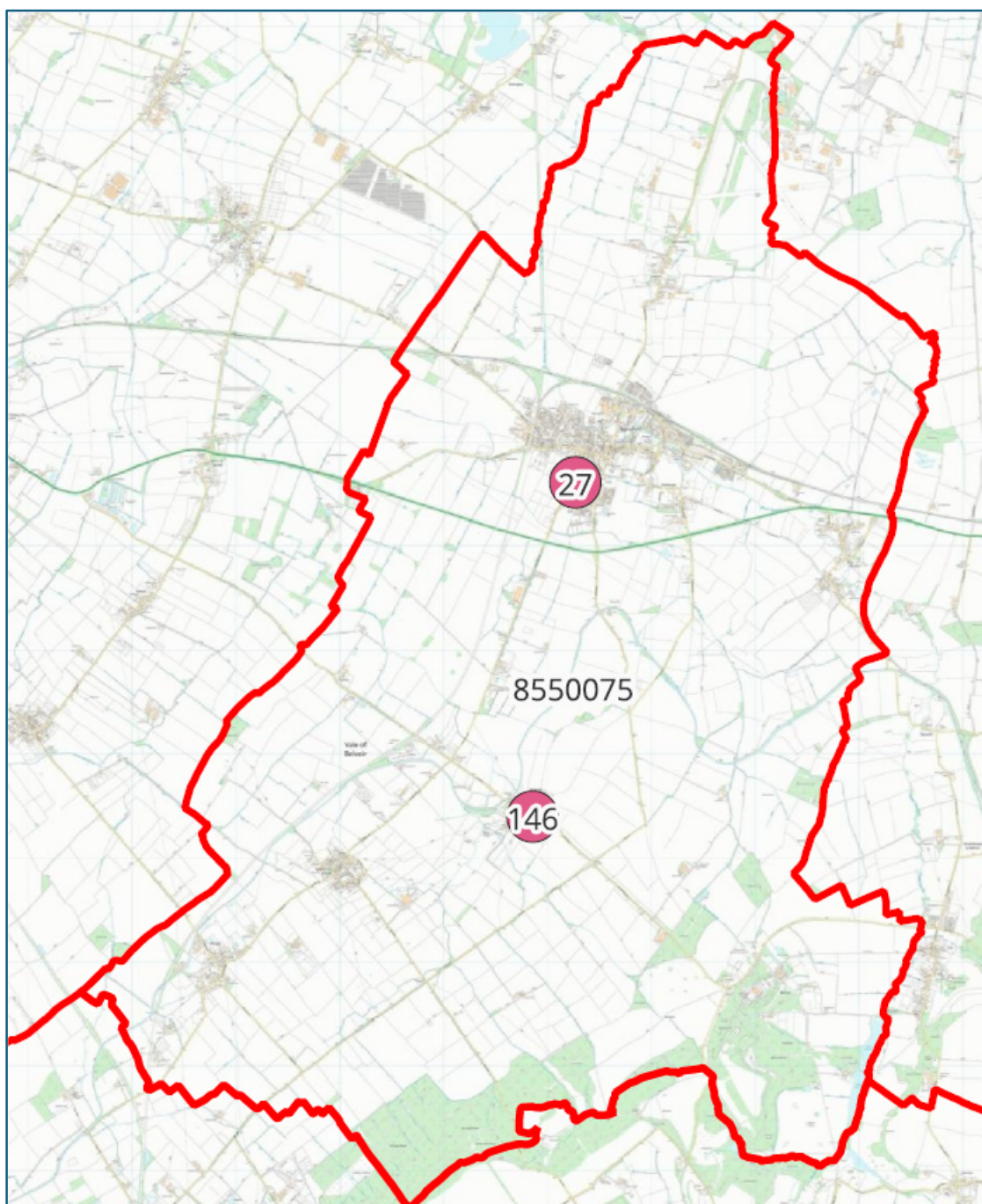

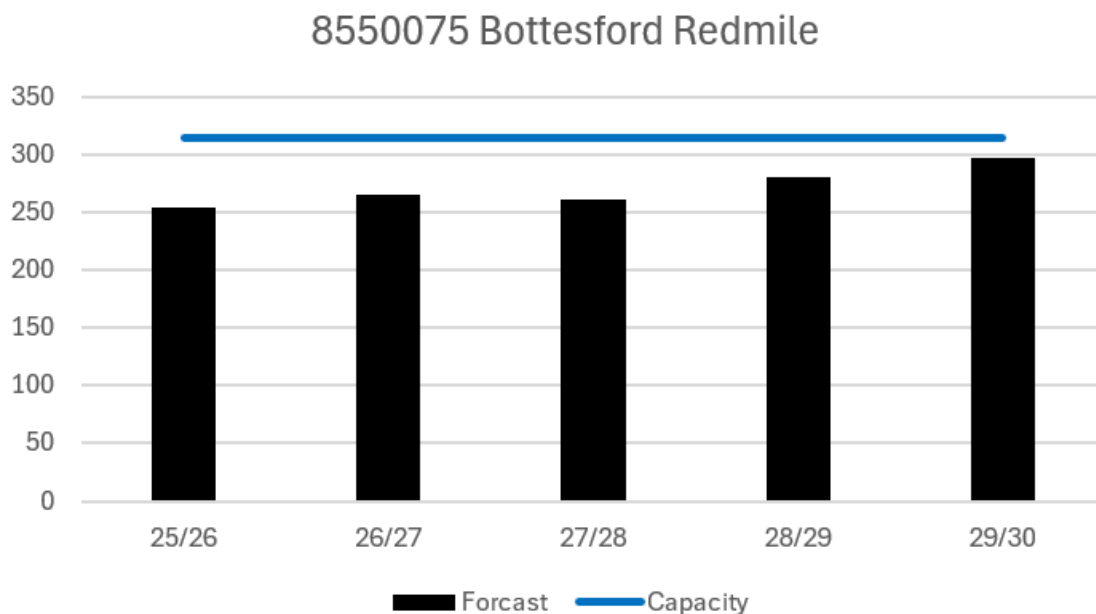

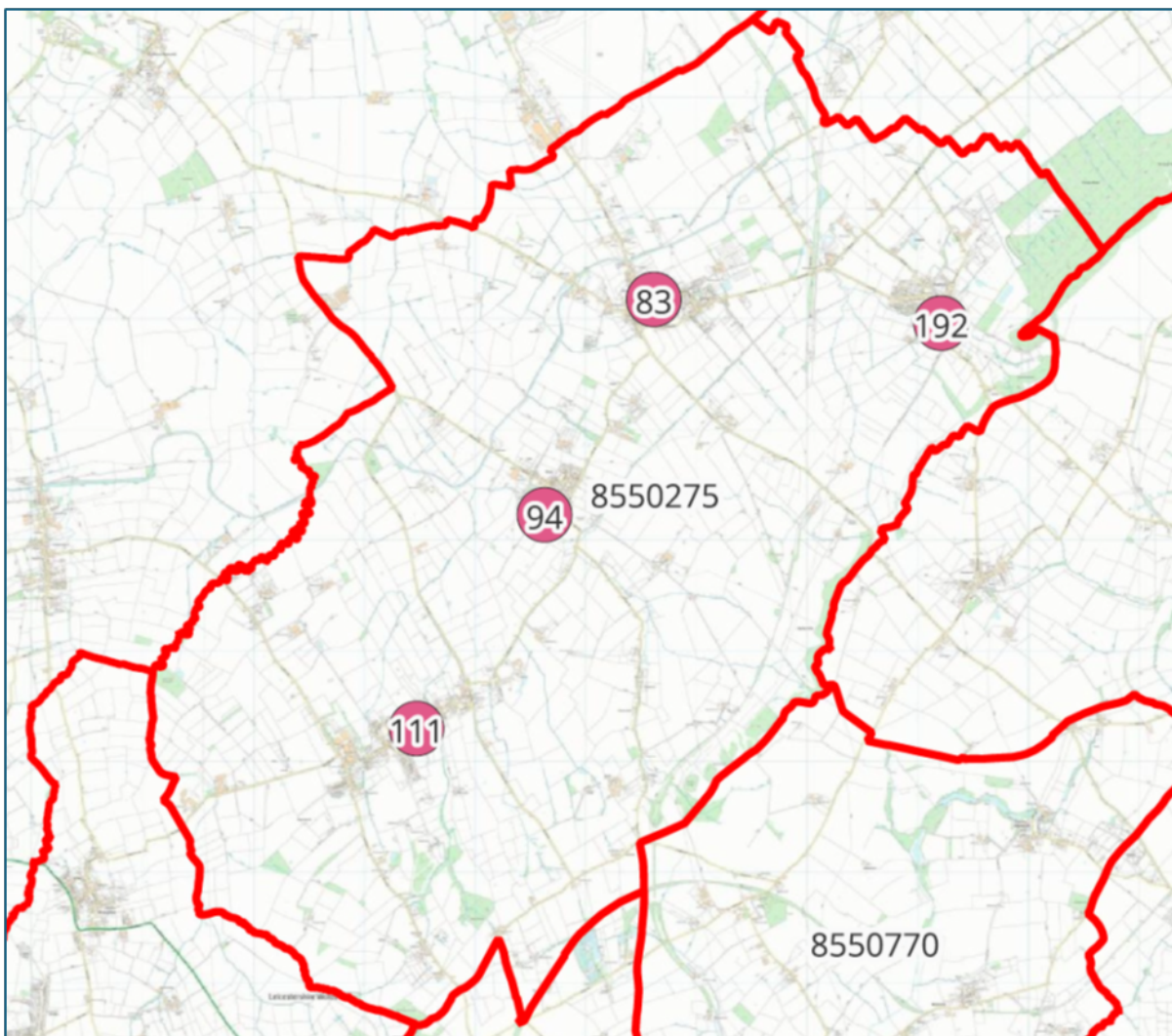

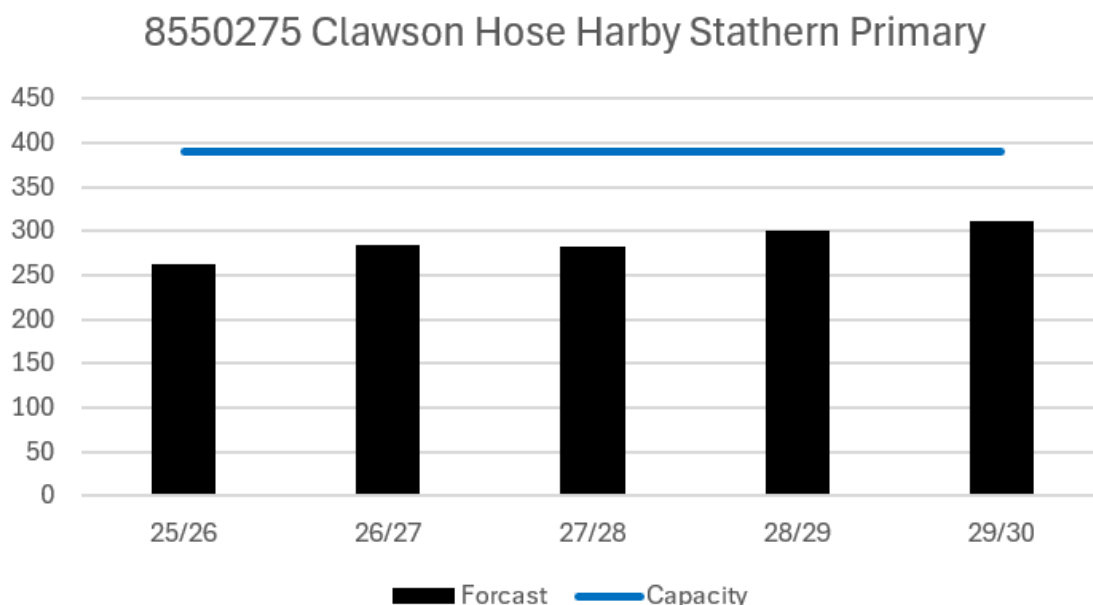

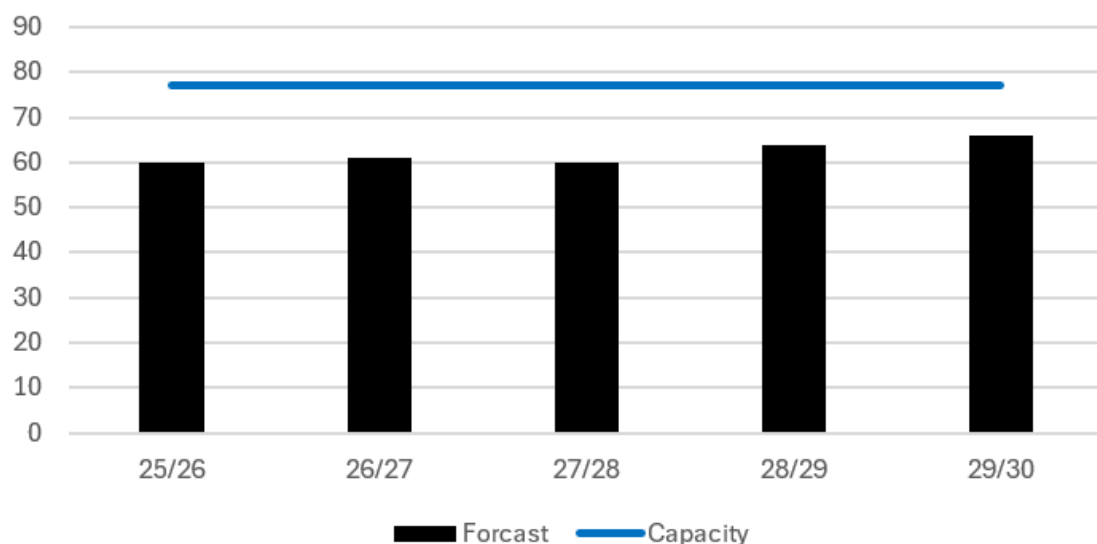


A map showing the Ab Kettleby Primary planning area. There is 1 school. The table below provides the map reference numbers alongside relevant school names.

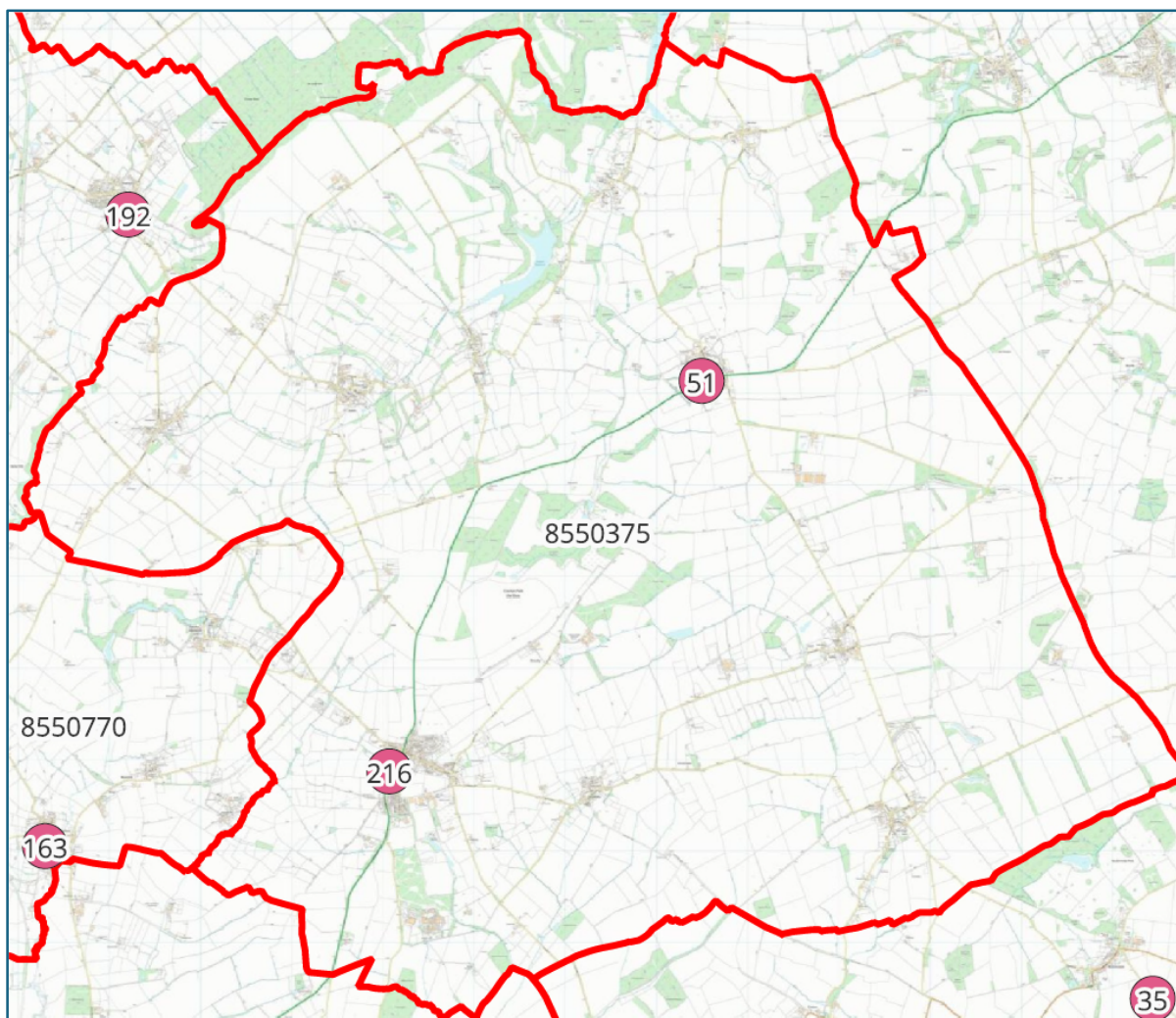

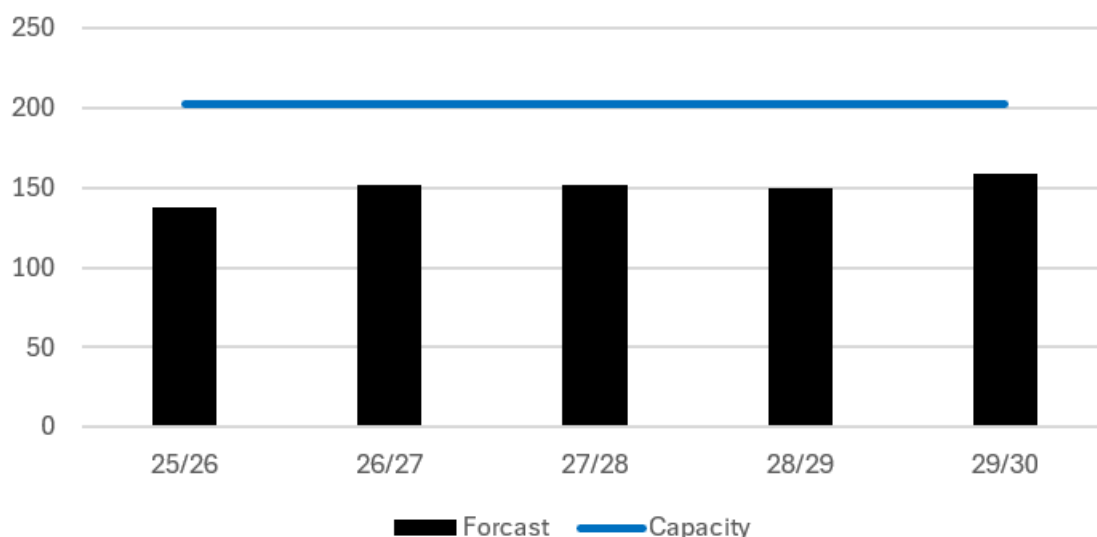


A map showing the Croxton, Waltham Primary planning area. There are 2 schools. The table below provides the map reference numbers alongside relevant school names.

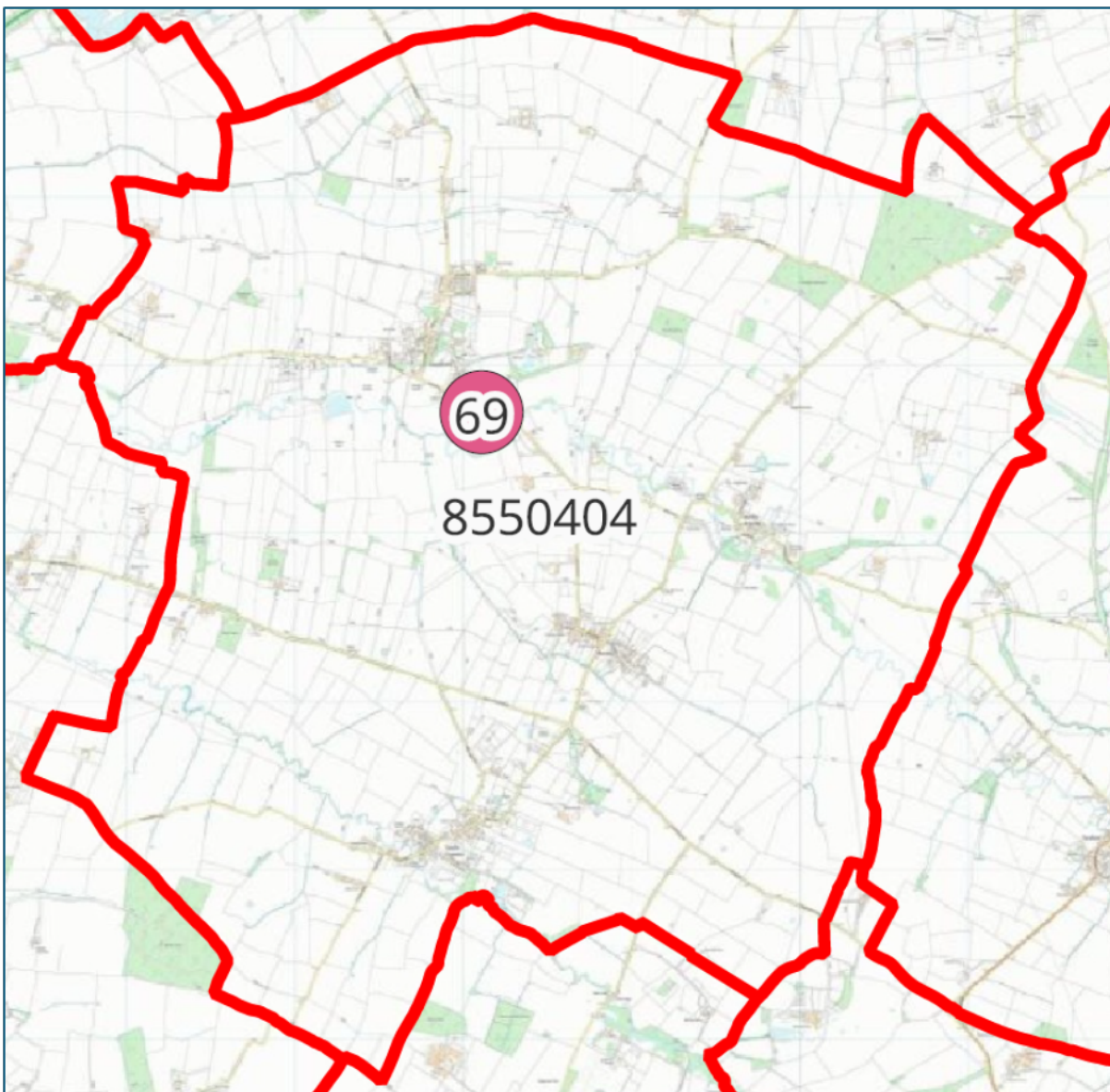

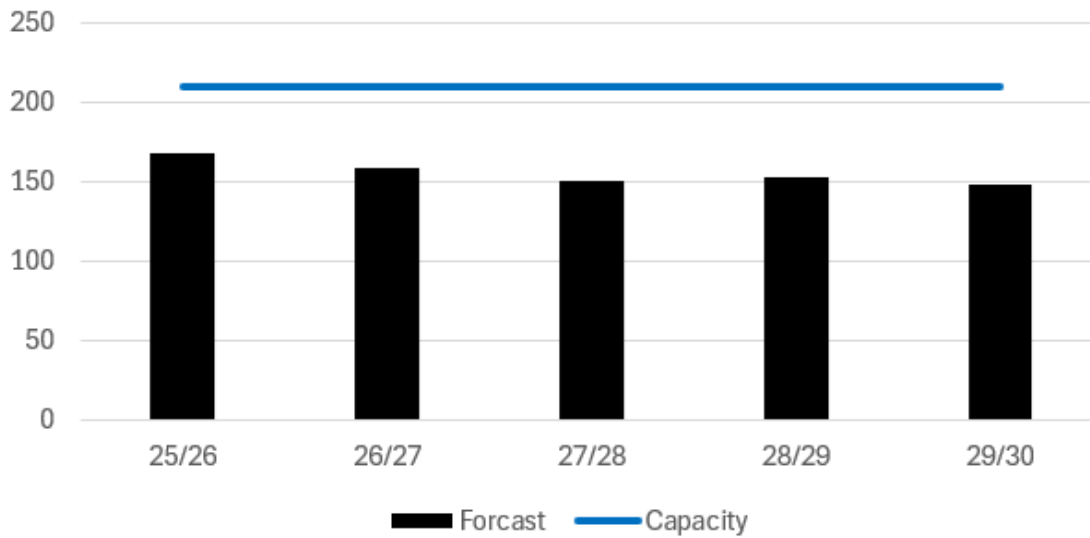


A map showing the Gaddesby Primary planning area. There is 1 school. The table below provides the map reference numbers alongside relevant school names.

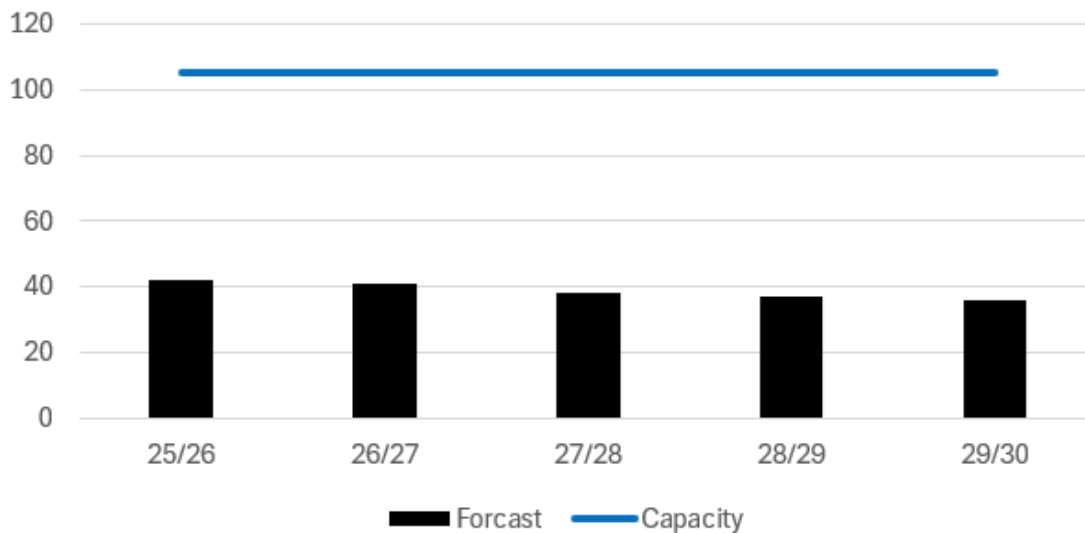

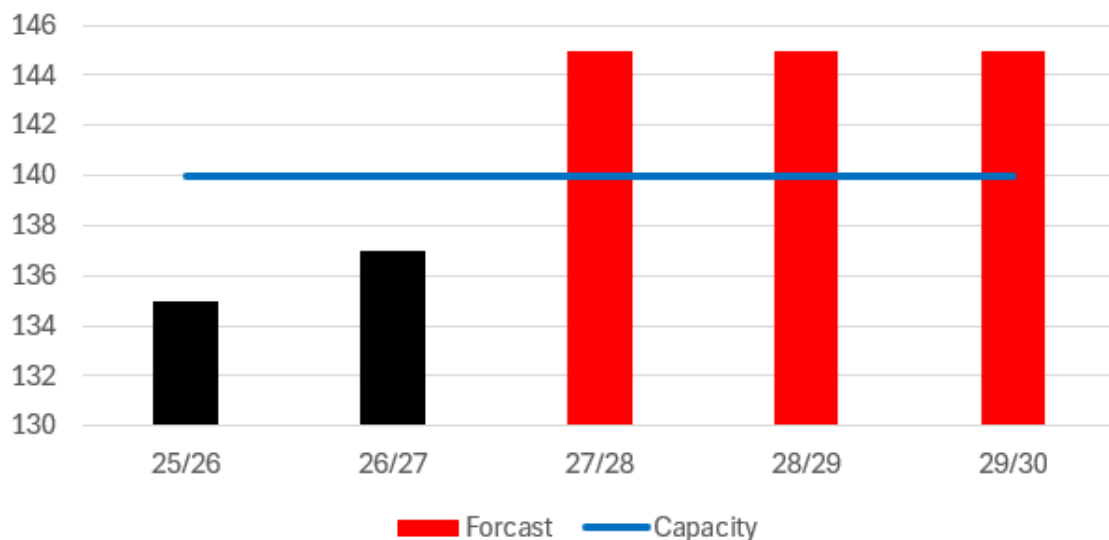

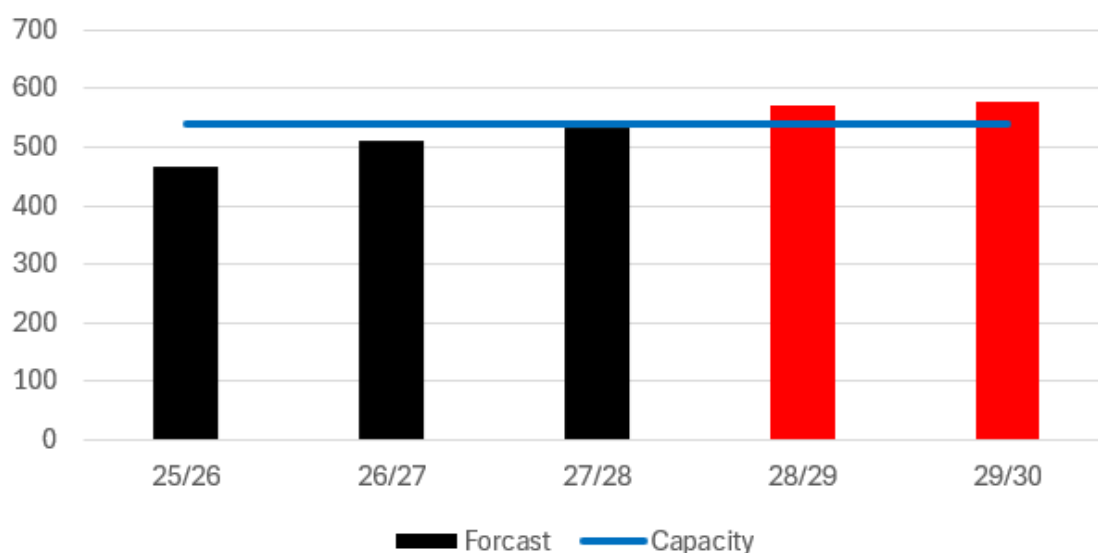


A map showing the Asfordby Frisby Primary planning area. There are 3 schools. The table below provides the map reference numbers alongside relevant school names.

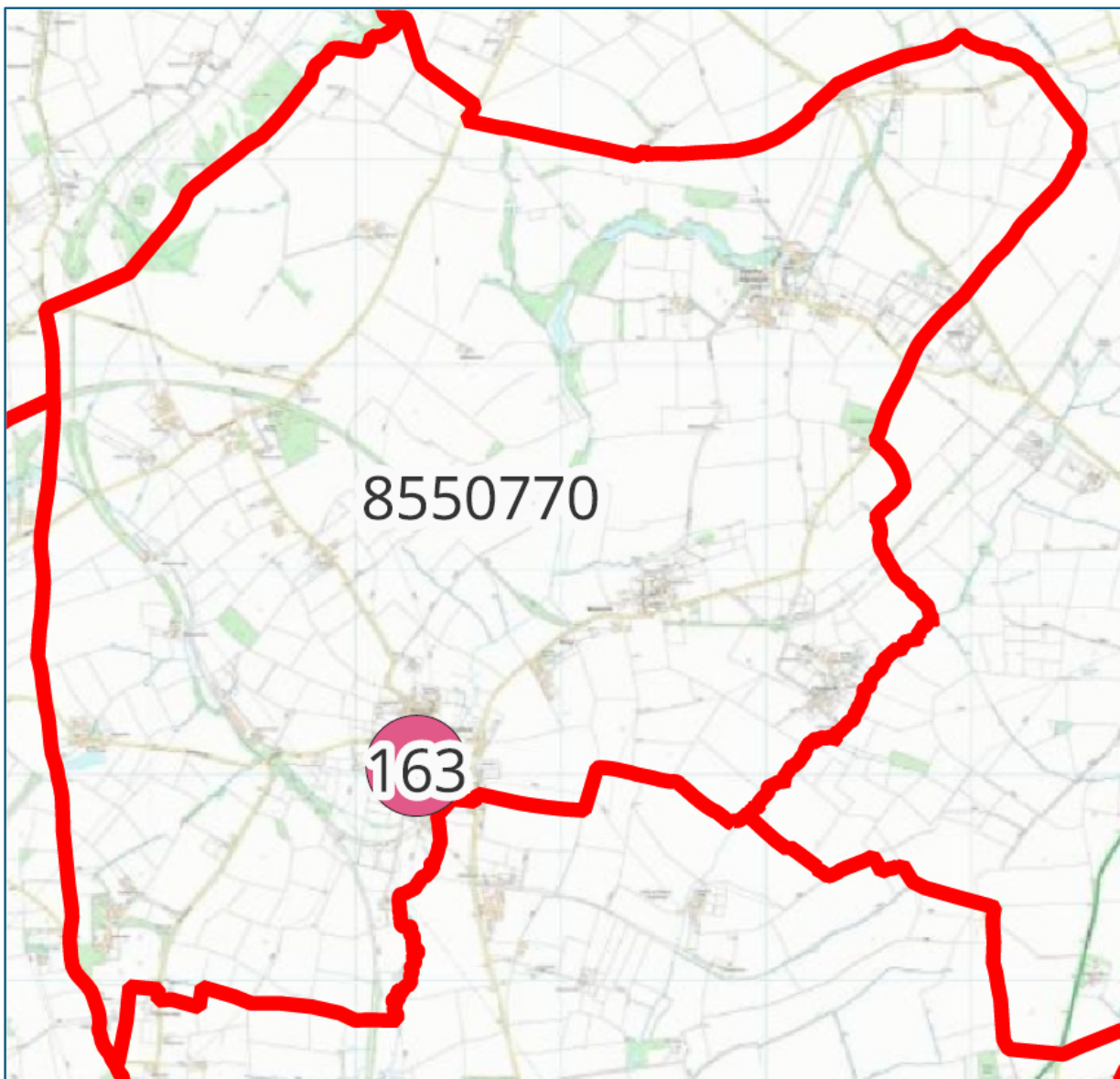

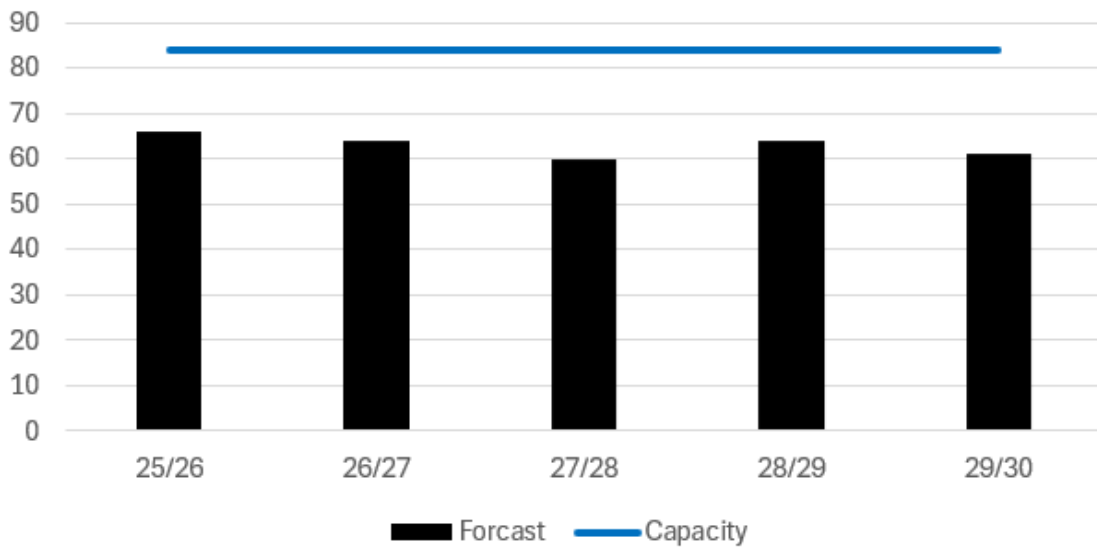


A map showing the Scalford Primary planning area. There is 1 school. The table below provides the map reference numbers alongside relevant school names.

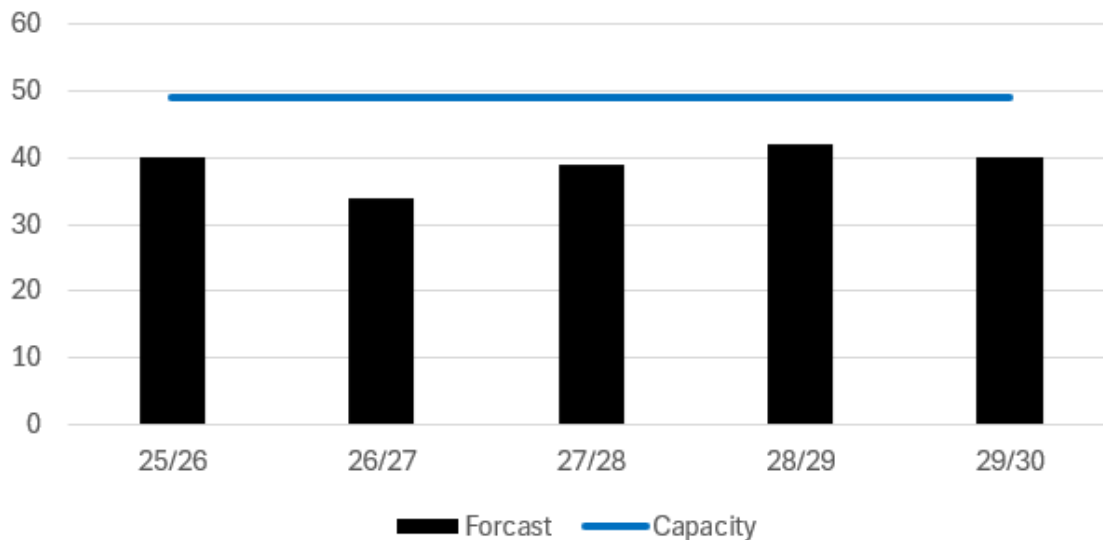

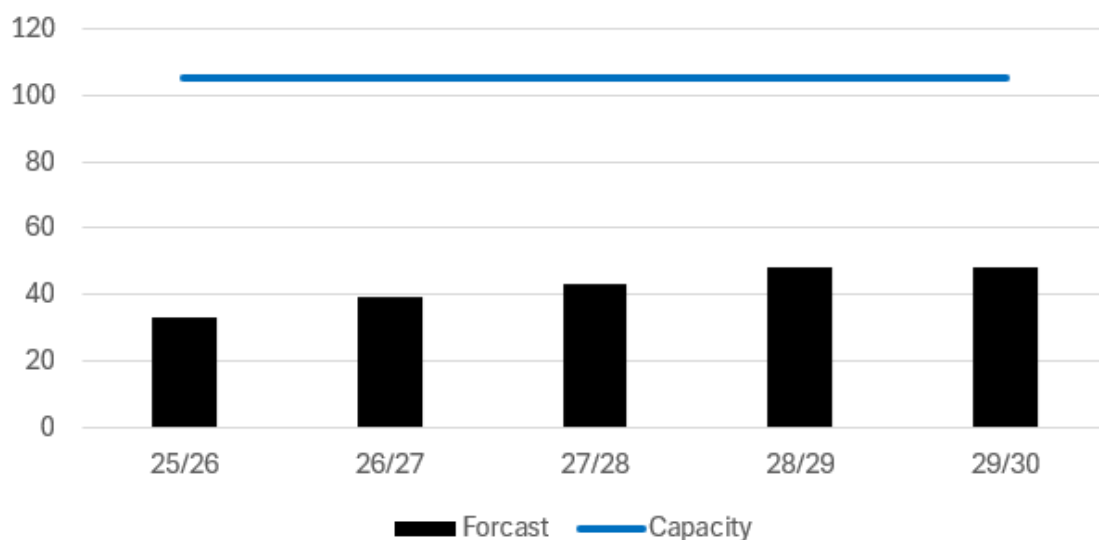


A map showing the Wymondham planning area. There is 1 school. The table below provides the map reference numbers alongside relevant school names.
