THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Sections 5, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

To impose a 20MPH speed limit on parts of the following roads:

Leicester Lane, Frank Burditt Drive, Isaac Martin Lane, Burnmill Road, Upper Green Place, Main Street, Gunnsbrook Close, Chater Close, Manor Road, Langton Road, Welham Road, Welham Lane, Northfield Avenue, North Close, Nether Green, Sutton Road, The Green, Dingley Road, Station Road, Knights End Road, Horse Shoe Lane, Madeline Close, Berry Close and Bankfield Drive, Great Bowden

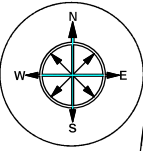

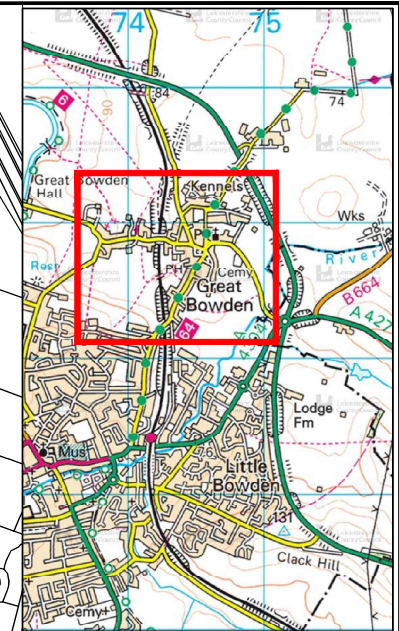
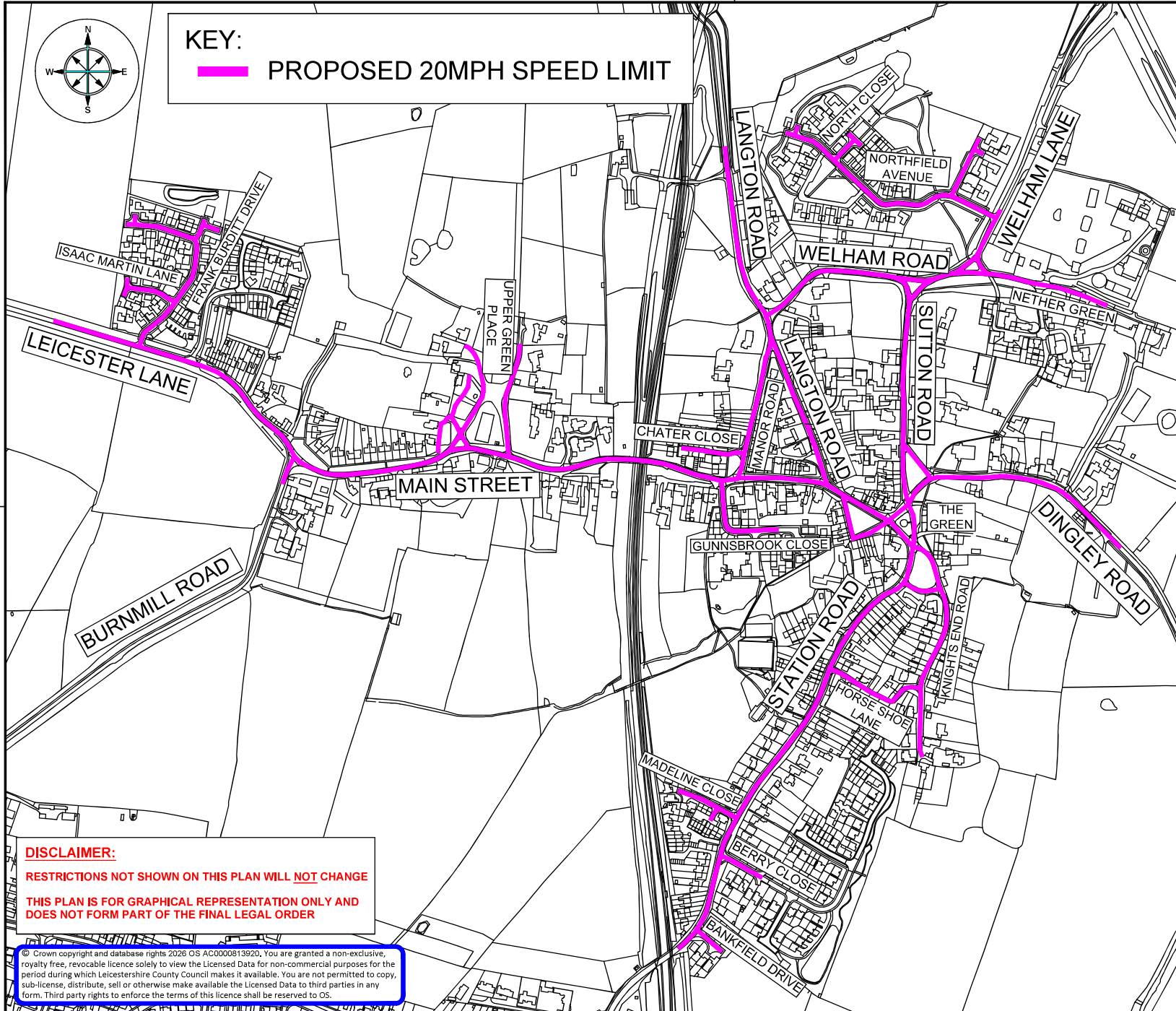

PROPOSED 20MPH SPEED LIMIT

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Leicestershire County Council (LCC) is proposing to reduce the current speed limit in the village of Great Bowden from 30mph to 20mph.

Traffic calming measures in Great Bowden have been identified as a key priority for the allocation of Section 106 (S106) funding.

Following discussions with Great Bowden Parish Council, the introduction of a 20mph speed limit forms part of a wider package of measures aimed at improving road safety within the village.

As part of the assessment process, LCC commissioned traffic speed surveys at several locations within Great Bowden. The overall results from these surveys support the introduction of a village-wide, signed-only 20mph speed limit.

Leicestershire Police have confirmed their full support for the proposed 20mph speed limit.

The order is being introduced to improve road safety.

The proposals are shown in plan: TM5213//T1/1.

Langton Road, Great Bowden - From a point 222 metres northwest of its junction with Welham Road to a point 250 metres southeast of its junction with Welham Road, Great Bowden.

Welham Lane, Great Bowden - From its junction with Nether Green, Great Bowden to a point 52 metres northeast of its junction with Nether Green, Great Bowden.

Sutton Road, Great Bowden - For its entire length.

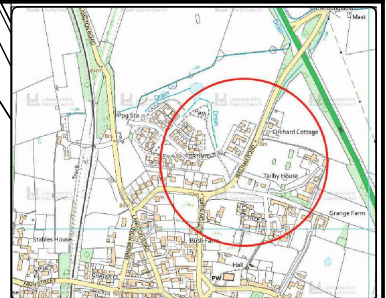
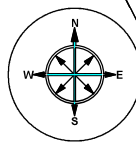
