THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 19, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

To impose No Waiting at Any Time Restrictions on Station Road, Thurnby from its junction with Thurncourt Road to a point 44 metres south of its junction with Thurncourt Road on both sides of the carriageway as shown in Plan TM5230/ATF5/T1/1

**TM5230/ATF5 – PROPOSED PUFFIN CROSSING AND NO WAITING AT ANY
TIME RESTRICTIONS**

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Leicestershire County Council intends to install a signal-controlled puffin crossing facility on Station Road, Thurnby

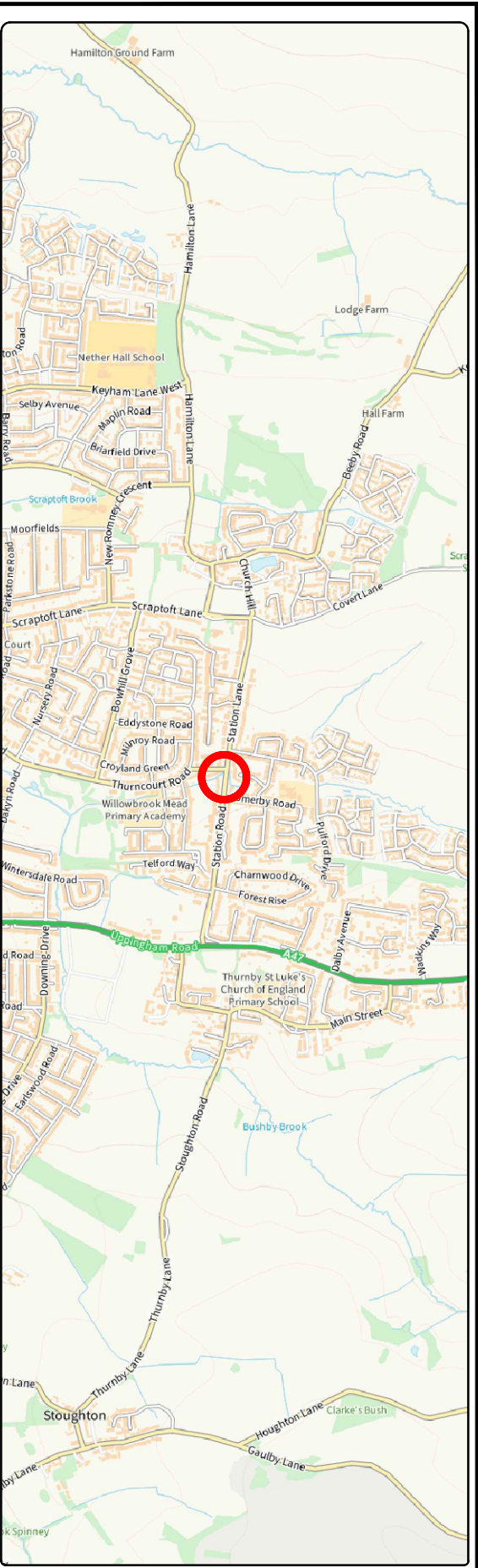
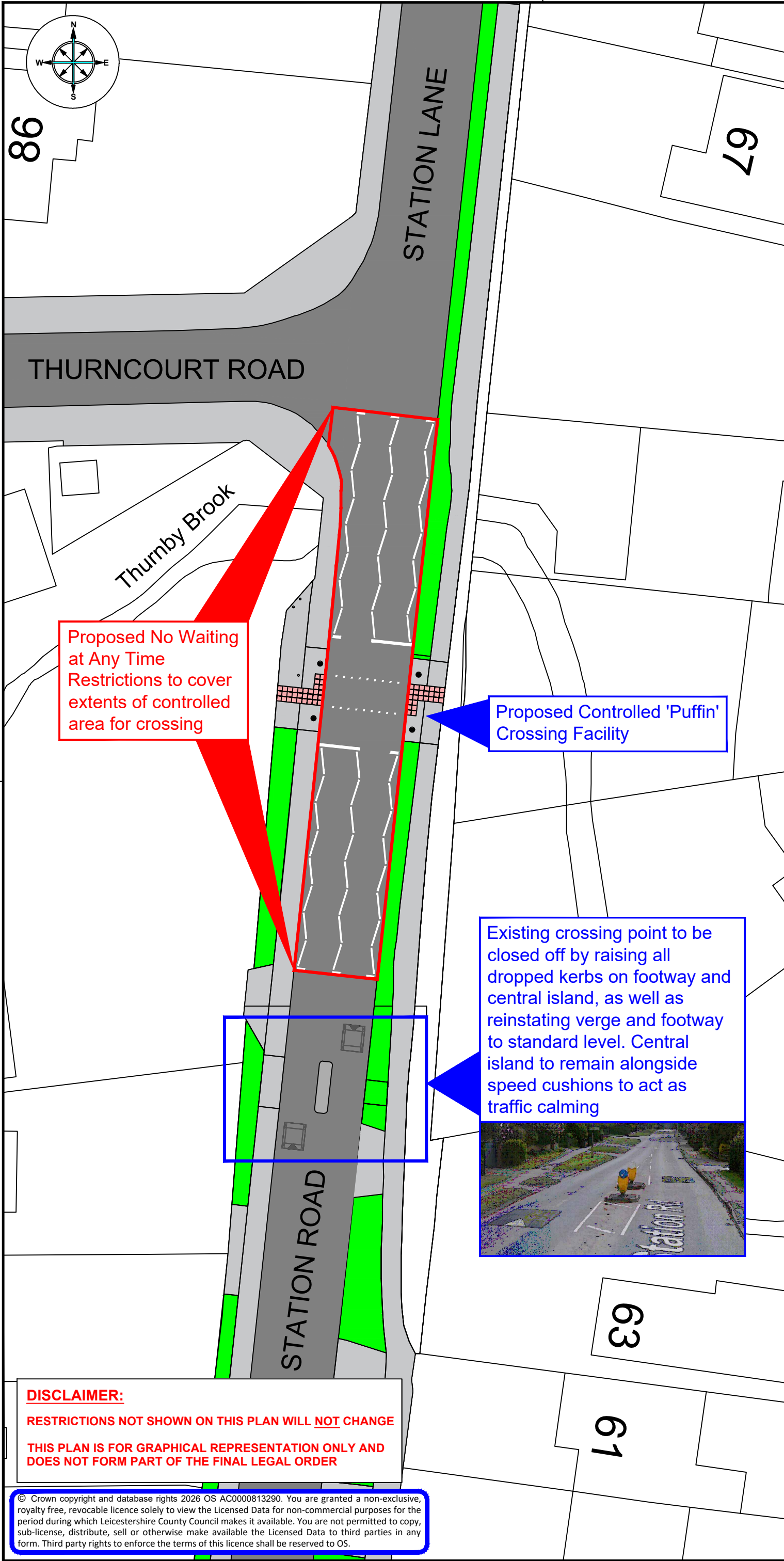
The new facility will enable pedestrians to cross Station Road in a continuous movement during a dedicated signal phase, supporting safer and more convenient active travel journeys.

The existing crossing point is to be closed off by raising all dropped kerbs on footway and central island, as well as reinstating verge and footway to standard level. The central island and speed cushions are to remain to act as traffic calming.

It is also proposed that no waiting at any time restrictions are implemented for the length of the crossing to ensure that parking on the footway and carriageway can be enforced.

The scheme is being funded through the Active Travel Fund.

The above proposals are illustrated in plan TM5230/ATF5/T1/1.

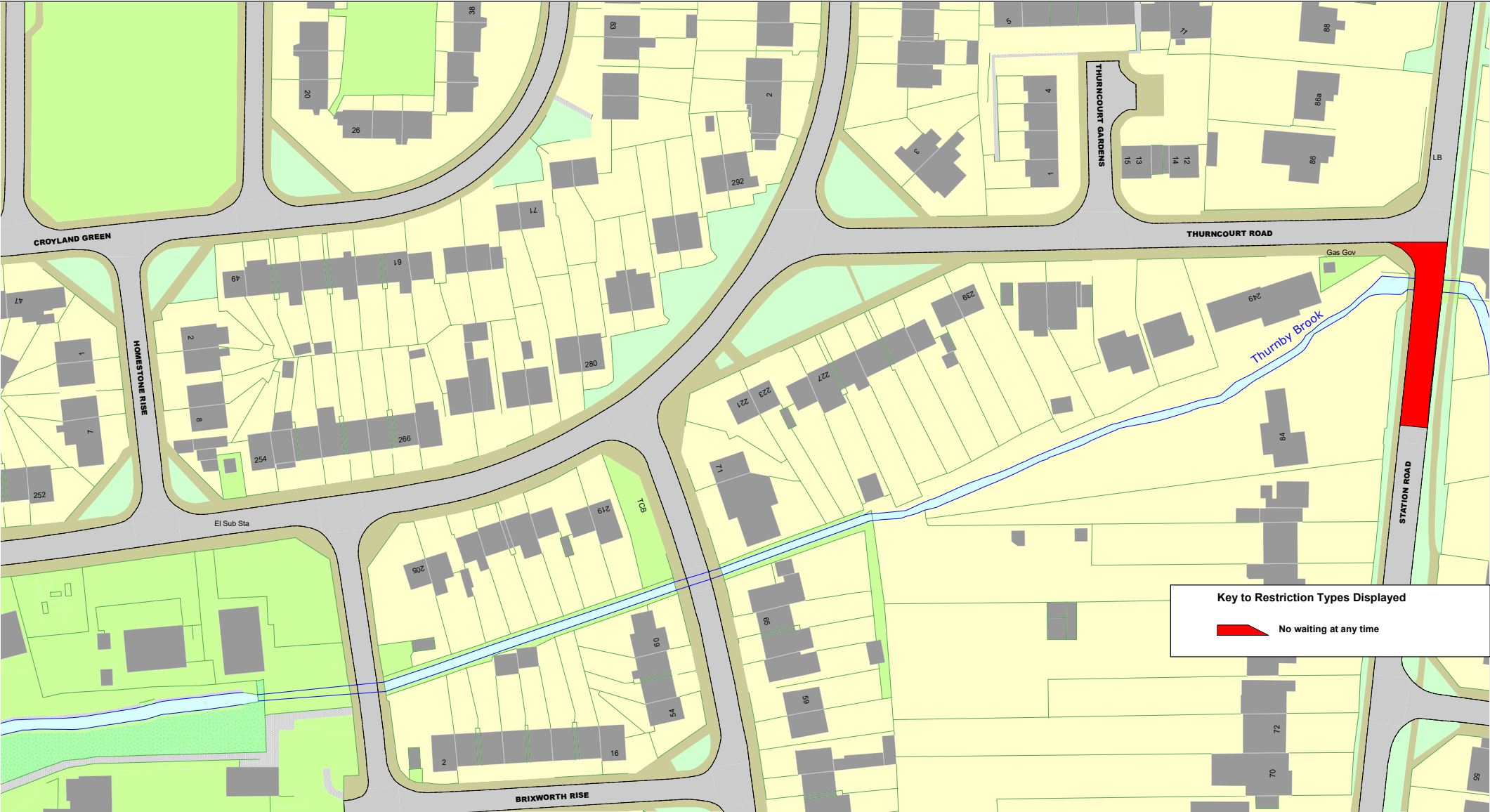
