Notice is hereby given that the developer Redrow PLC proposes to construct speed cushions on Berry Close, Great Bowden as conditioned through planning application **15/01425/OUT** and non-material amendment to planning application **25/00824/NMA**. The speed cushions will be constructed under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980.

The provisional location for the traffic calming measures are as follows and are subject to a change in position following public consultations: -

Berry Close, Great Bowden - One set of two cushions 65mm high on Berry Close, 33.81m from the junction with Station Road, adjacent to properties 4 and 5 Berry Close.

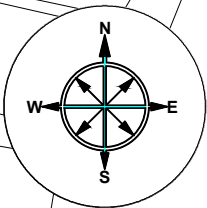

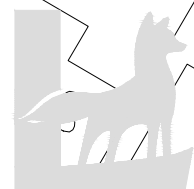

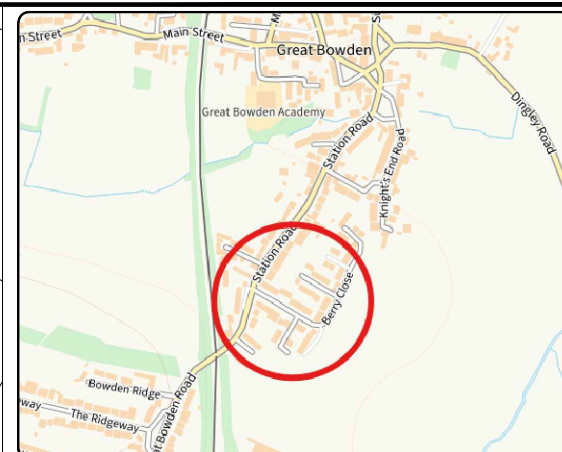

PROPOSED INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES
STATEMENT OF REASONS

Leicestershire County Council is formally advertising a scheme on behalf of Redrow Homes, who are proposing to install traffic calming measures on the publicly maintained section of Berry Close, Great Bowden.

The works are associated with a newly constructed access which leads to the housing development on the private section of Berry Close.

The proposed traffic calming measures include the installation of speed cushions.

The proposal seeks to encourage lower vehicle speeds and improve road safety for all users travelling along Berry Close in both directions.

The proposals are shown in plan **TMD.085/T1/1**.
