THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Sections 5, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

To revoke the following Order in full:

The Leicestershire County Council
(Belvoir Road and Station Road, Redmile)
(30 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order 1982

To impose a 20 MPH speed limit for the entire lengths of the following roads:

Main Street, Main Road, Church Corner, Church Lane, Bakers Lane, Drift Hill, Easthorpe Lane, Post Office Lane, and Belvoir Road, Redmile

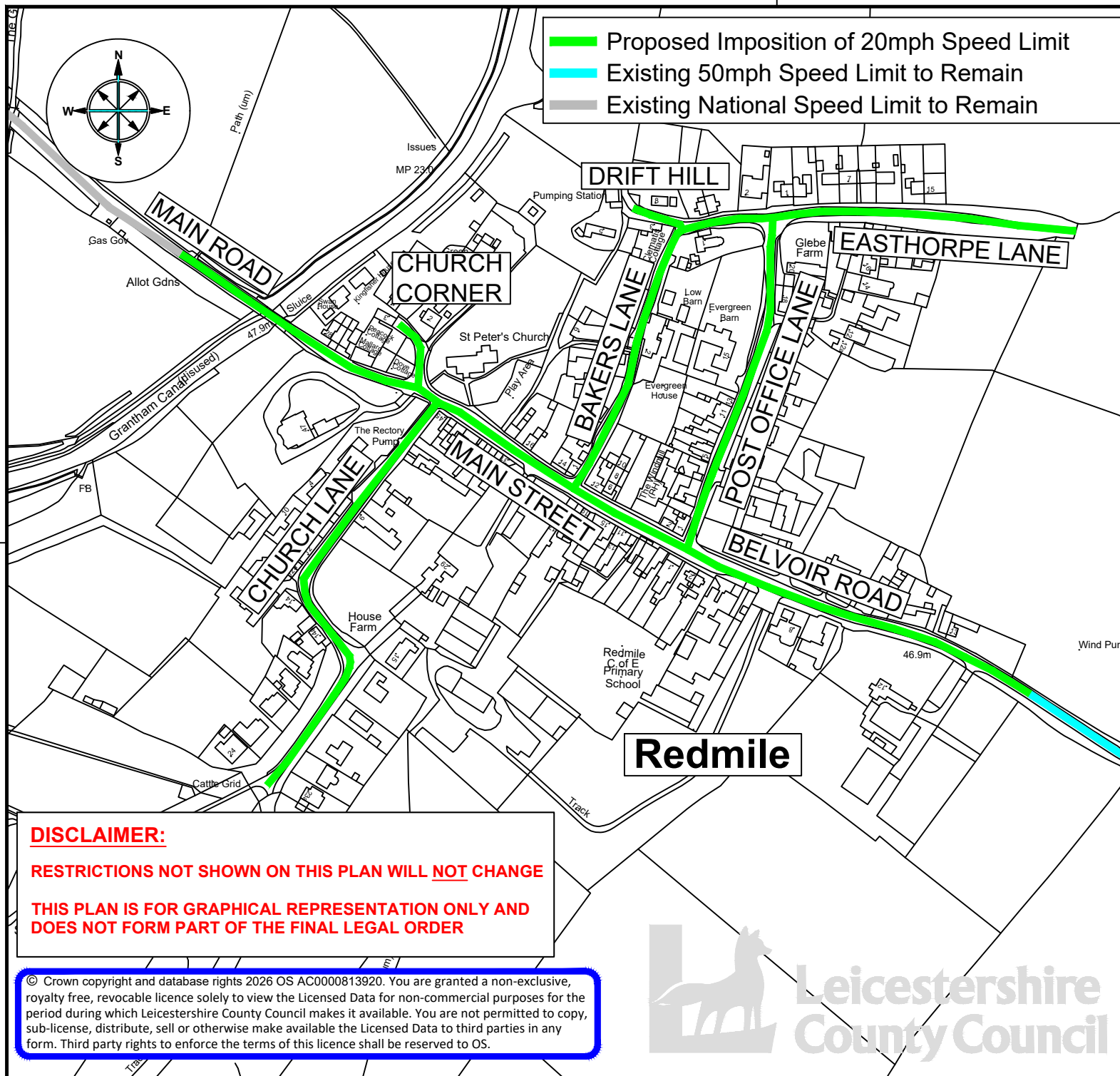

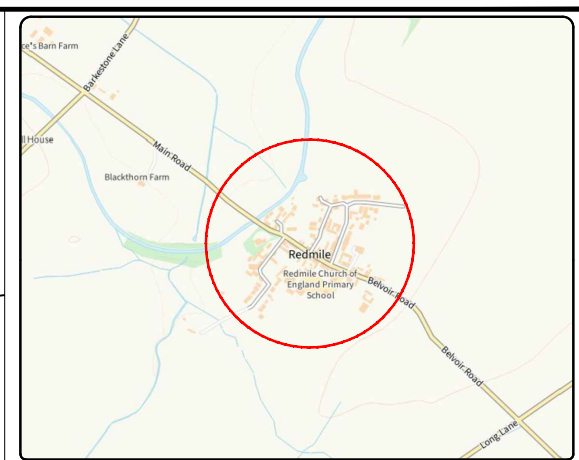

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Leicestershire County Council is proposing to lower the speed limit from 30mph to 20mph on the following roads in the village of Redmile: Main Street, Main Road, Church Corner, Church Lane, Bakers Lane, Drift Hill, Easthorpe Lane, Post Office Lane, Belvoir Road.

Existing mean vehicle speeds are consistent with the proposed 20mph speed limit.

1. This Order may be cited as "The Leicestershire County Council (Various Roads, Redmile, Borough of Melton) (Imposition of a 20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 202"

4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 MPH on the lengths of road as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

The Leicestershire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 72(3) and 73(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967", and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 840(1) of the Act of 1967, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be restricted roads for the purposes of section 71 of the Act of 1967.
2. This Order may be cited as The Leicestershire County Council (Belvoir Road and Station Road, Redmile) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 4th January 1982.

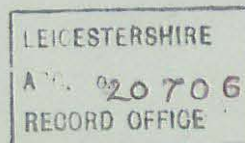
LENGTHS OF ROAD IN THE PARISH OF REDMILE

That length of road known as Station Road which extends from a point 98 yards north west of its junction with Church Lane in a north westerly direction for a distance of 85 yards.

That length of road known as Belvoir Road which extends from a point 187 yards south east of its junction with Post Office Lane in a south easterly direction for a distance of 47 yards.
