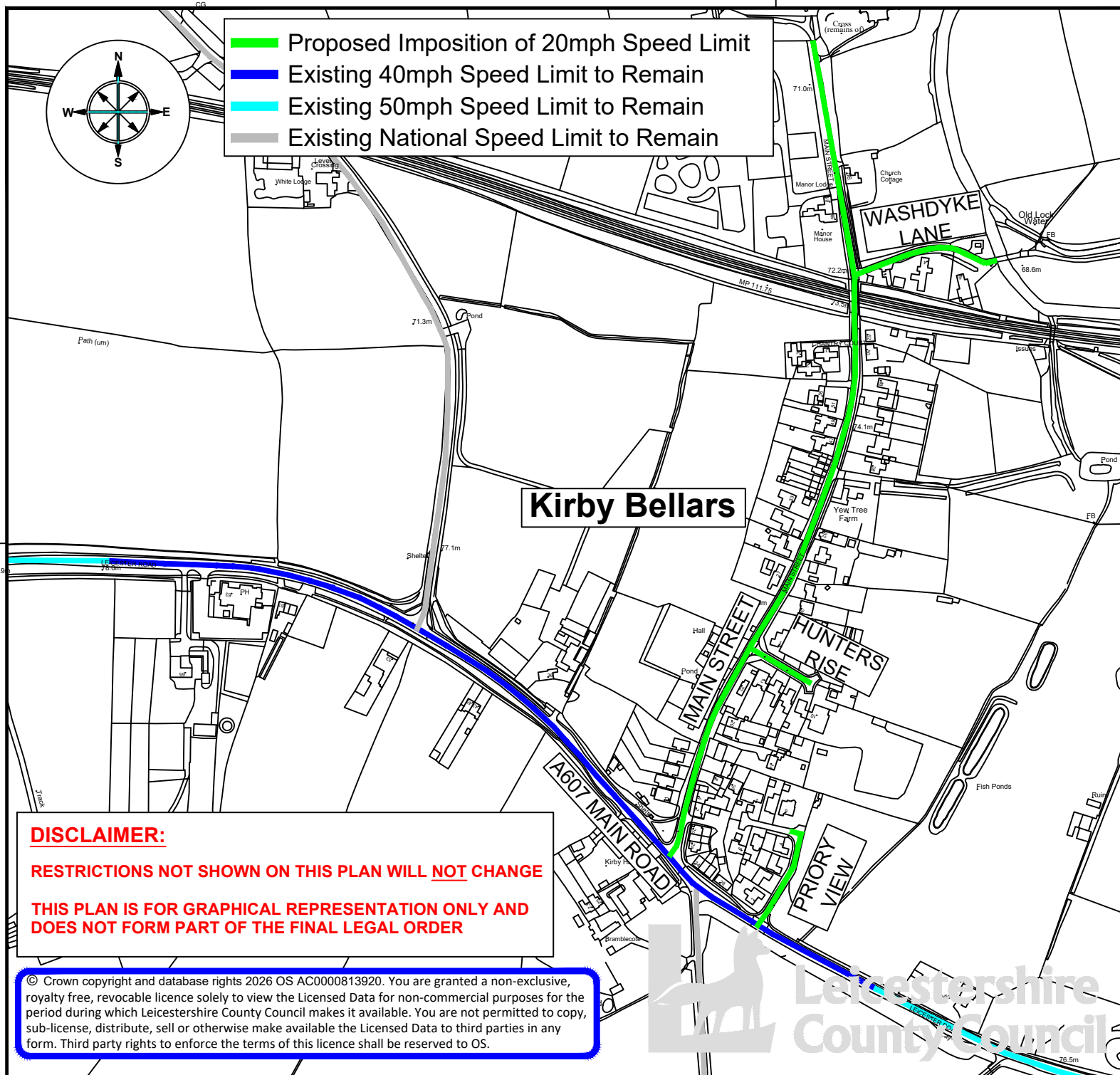
To impose a 20 MPH speed limit for the entire lengths of the following Roads:

Main Street, Priory View, Hunters Rise and Washdyke Lane, Kirby Bellars

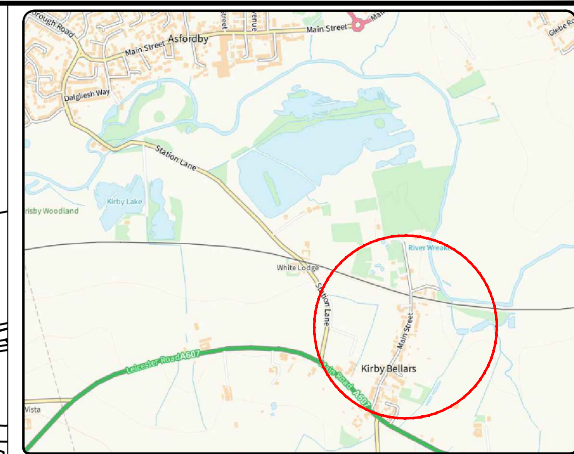


- Proposed Imposition of 20mph Speed Limit

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Leicestershire County Council is proposing to lower the speed limit from 30mph to 20mph on the following roads in the village of Kirby Bellars: Main Street, Hunters Rise, Washdyke Lane, Priory View.

Existing mean vehicle speeds are consistent with the proposed 20mph speed limit.

4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 MPH on the lengths of road as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

The County Council of the Administrative County of Leicester, in exercise of their powers under subsection (3) of section 20 and subsections (1) and (6) of section 21 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Leicester and with the consent of the Minister of Transport, hereby order and direct as follows:-

1. The direction contained in the County Council of the Administrative County of Leicester (Built-up Areas) Order, 1950 No. 2 which by virtue of subsection (2) of section 267 of and paragraph 12 of the Nineteenth Schedule to the Road Traffic Act 1960 has effect as if it were a direction that the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is to cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of section 19 of the said Act of 1960 is hereby revoked.

2. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if for the purposes of section 38 of that Act this Order were an Act of Parliament thereby repealed.

3. This Order may be cited as "The County Council of the Administrative County of Leicester (Restricted Roads) (No.2) Order, 1962."
