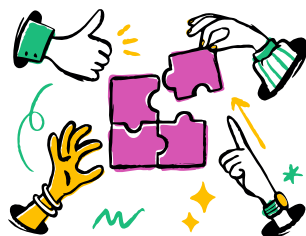
Training Offer

PURPOSE

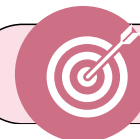
- ✓ To promote positive outcomes for children and young people.
