My child has SEND. I would like to look around. What do I need to do?

How will my child and I be made to feel welcome and how will you get ready for my child coming?

We have helpful and friendly staff who are able to support and make people feel welcome. We offer drinks and snacks, children can have a look at our computer systems and play games while we talk to parents. We can offer a free assessment to support the current curriculum and find out where we will be able to support your child.

How accessible are your premises?

We are located on Ashby Market Street and have a car park to the rear of the building. The building does have two small steps at the front entrance but only a small step to the rear.

How will you keep my child safe?

We have a locking door system. Any one who wishes to enter will press a button and the reception staff are able to release the lock. We are Ofsted registered and meet the criteria.

How will you communicate with me what my child has done, enjoyed and learnt?

Our teachers feedback to parents at the end of each lesson to let them know how they have done and what they have been set for homework.

How do you work with other professionals?

Schools refer students to us. We support local schools by delivering lessons within the school premises.

What training have you/your staff had in SEND?

Rebecca has dyslexia screening training and is able to offer advice. Stephanie Rawden has level 1 and 2 in autism training.

Our teachers offer help and support to every child within their class.

Our teachers will prepare your child for the new school year and work that will be set for them. All of our teachers are fully qualified and will be able to support children with any up and coming changes.
