### Notice of an application to correct mistaken registration of buildings wrongly registered as village green at Bitteswell

1. An application has been made to Leicestershire County Council as Commons Registration Authority by P E Hurst (the applicant) under Section 22 Schedule 2 (8) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014. The application seeks to rectify the Register of Village Greens relating to VG60 by the removal of the land described in the schedule below.
2. If the application is granted the Registration Authority will remove the land from the Register of Village Greens.
3. Any person wishing to object to the application should send a statement of the facts on which the objection is based to the Director of Law and Governance, Leicestershire County Council, County Hall, Glenfield, Leicestershire, LE3 8RA or by email to [Anthony.cross@leics.gov.uk](mailto:Anthony.cross@leics.gov.uk) quoting reference CA (VG) 01/2016 on or before Friday 6 January 2017.

Any representations received by the Commons Registration Authority cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the applicant for comment and may be disclosed to other interested parties. Representations must include the name and postal address of the person making them and the nature of that person's interest, must be signed by the person making the representation and must also state the grounds on which they are made. Should the application be referred to the Planning Inspectorate for determination, then in accordance with Regulation 26 of the 2014 Regulations, any representations will be forwarded to the Planning Inspectorate
