Statement of evidence to formally request a Definitive Map Modification Order

I am making this application that the footpath around the perimeter of the field between Barry Close and The Links and Half Acre (private houses) be included as an official right of way on the Definitive Map on behalf of a number of dog walkers and residents of Kirby Muxloe, Leicestershire in my capacity as Acting Chair of Kirby Muxloe Residents' Action Group.

There is evidence that the route has been used as a local tradition with right of access and as a highway for a period of twenty years or more as a right based on the evidence provided in the witness statements.

Under section 31 of the Highways Act 1980 a way becomes a right of way by means of presumed dedication if there has been "uninterrupted use by the public (not necessarily the same people all the time) over a period of 20 years in the belief that that use was as of right." The period of 20 years is counted back from the date on which the public's right was first brought into question, in this case through the approval of planned development on the field. (application number 14/0917/1/OX) I understand that a number of dog walkers and recreational walkers have complained that their continued use of this footpath will be jeopardised by this development.

The Defra circular Rights of Way Circular 1/09 – Guidance for Local Authorities, October 2009 v.2 page 4 point 1.5 states:

"In many areas, rights of way help to boost tourism and contribute to rural economies. They can also provide a convenient means of travelling, particularly for short journeys, in both rural and urban areas. They are important in the daily lives of many people who use them for fresh air and exercise on bicycle, on foot, on horseback or in a horse-drawn vehicle, **to walk the dog**, to improve their fitness, or to visit local shops and other facilities. Local authorities should regard public rights of way as an integral part of the complex of recreational and transport facilities within their area"

The footpath around the field in this instance is a historically very well established dog walking route and additional evidence of it's repeated, long standing use is provided by the aerial photographs which clearly show the level of indentation marking the path.

I hope the evidence submitted is sufficient to demonstrate that this route has been used for more than 20 years as a right and that the Council's Development Control & Regulatory Board make the decision that a Definitive Map Modification Order should be made under Section 53 of the Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981 as a recognition that the Authority believes a public right of way is already in existence.
