#### What if I can't afford the fee?

If you are in receipt of certain benefits or a low income (£25,117 joint household income, or £19,921 single household income), you might be entitled to pay the reduced fee listed in this brochure, and some benefits entitle you to attend the course for free. This may also mean you can receive help from our Learner Support Fund which can help you pay for childcare, travel, exam fees and resources relating to your attendance on our courses. If you feel you might struggle to pay your course fee all at once you might be able to pay in instalments if it is above £50, at no extra cost.

Please note refunds are not normally given except when we have to close a course.



I knew if I passed I wanted to go for the GCSE course as I enjoy learning and pushing myself and I would like to work with the elderly or young people and Maths GCSE is a requirement for the job role.

The tutors are good at explaining how to complete the tasks and I get on with them well. The other students are supportive towards each other and it's always a friendly atmosphere in the groups. After class it is nice to have a chat with students regarding how the course is going.

My learning style is visual, so having the online Learning Platform website resources to use to help me learn is crucial for me, as I sometimes struggle to take in everything in class. Also if I did miss a class I could use the resources to catch up.

I talked to Jo, the GoLearn Learning and Work Advisor, regarding where I wanted to go after completing Level 1 and Level 2 English and maths functional skills, and found it clarified what qualifications I need and what I wanted to do when I return to employment.

I would say that at school you are forced to learn but in adult education you learn because you enjoy it and it is YOU who wants to learn. The friendliness of the students and tutors make it a great environment to learn, so this is an amazing opportunity!"





We offer courses for learners whose first language is not English and who need to learn or improve their English for life, community and work in the UK. You will learn speaking, listening, reading and writing in English. Classes at different levels take place twice a week for most daytime classes and once a week for evening classes in a variety of centres around the county.

#### **ESOL** to Maths and English GCSE!

I have started to learn English when I first came in UK in 2014. I used to learn English back in Bulgaria, but when I had moved here I found that I don't know enough to live like a resident. I wanted to improve it to feel confident, to have a chance for better job, to help my daughter with her homework after school, to find new friends and so on.

I went to Loughborough Moira Centre and there I had assessment to check what level I am. I was really nervous, but the staff was so friendly and helpful. The course was local and the time was suitable for my busy schedule so I didn't have to juggle between the class, the work and my family's responsibilities.

I started my first class with Nalini. She was amazing. She explained everything clear so it was easy to listen and understand. I learned really hard and I have done all of my homework. I received free online access to GoLearn learning platform website with lots of resources that I had use to practice my English – reading, writing or listening at home. If I missed the class I could easily check there, practice myself and if I had any questions, I always had a chance to ask my teacher. The other students from my class were very supportive. They were lovely, they weren't just people, they were my friends.

In the end of the year I passed all of my exams and started to feel more confident. I started to speak with my neighbours, the other parents from my daughter's school, and the teachers. Even I have started to work as a volunteer in my daughter's school in Foundation stage. I had some new friends. I was proud with myself.

When I started to feel more confident with my English knowledge, I check for apprenticeship and I found out that to apply I need to pass Maths and English GCSE. I had already passed Level 2 Functional Skills for Maths so my tutor gave me more information, where and how to apply for GCSE which I have now passed. Of course, GCSE English just was the next step. I wasn't sure that I can pass the pre GCSE test but I have done it. So now, I have to learn really hard to have a chance for even better grade than I have for GCSE Maths.

My advice to other people, don't give up from your dreams! It is never too late. Are you from aboard? Yes. You are here in UK now, you are far from your home, but you still have a chance to follow your dreams. Start with your suitable English class, learn English and carry on with better job opportunities or go to college or even university.

#### TRAINEESHIPS

Traineeships are a new initiative specifically designed for 16 to 24-year olds who are keen to find work or an apprenticeship, but so far haven't been successful during the application stage.

A Traineeship consists of work experience with a local employer as well as time in a classroom, where you will be taught subjects such as English, Maths, work preparation skills, interview skills, CV writing, team building and employability skills.

The programme is designed to fit in with DWP guidance and will not affect your benefits. The programme could be extended to include ICT, first aid, food safety and health and safety, should this be appropriate to the type of work you are seeking. All trainees must be committed to the programme as well as seeking employment or an apprenticeship.

Leicestershire Adult Learning Service will offer information, advice and guidance throughout the programme to support your applications.


