To access the eligibility check you need to visit <u>www.childcarechoices.gov.uk</u> this is the first page you will see:




You then need to scroll down to the section that talks about 30 hours funding and click apply now:




You will then be transferred to the HMRC site. Here you need to choose 'options 4'

Now you will be asked to provide some information and set up your account. If you have a partner, you will also need to enter their information.

Once you have submitted your registration you will receive an email with your user ID on it which is a 12-digit figure.

Once you have signed in you will be sent as access code via email or text. This will allow you access the 'Childcare Service Account' page and from here you can choose the option for 're-apply or apply for a new child'.

Everything from here should be self explanatory. You will be asked a number of questions about the child you wish to access funding about as well as details about you and your partners (if relevant) employment status and earnings.


