ASHBY-DEL-LA-ZOUCH, JUNCTION 13 – A42/A511/A512 ROUNDABOUT IMPROVEMENTS

As part of the ongoing works at the above location, we are now about to progress onto the next phase of the scheme. This includes the re-surfacing of the Flagstaff roundabout and widening works to the northbound exit slip off the A42. To undertake this work safely, we will need to implement a series of road closures. The road closures taking place over the coming month and are as follows:

A42 Junction 13/Northbound Exit Slip road

A full weekend closure on the northbound exit slip road will be implemented from 8pm on Friday 7th July, until 6am on Monday the 10th July i.e. all weekend, and from 8pm on Friday 21st July, until 6am on Monday the 24th July. Please note the second week end is a contingency and may not be required.

A42 Junction 13 Flagstaff Roundabout

An overnight closure will be implemented on all approaches (excluding the A511), from Monday the 10th July from 8:00pm to 6:00am, Monday to Thursday inclusive, for approximately 3 weeks. These closures are required to undertake final carriageway surfacing, road markings and loop cutting for traffic signal detection. The traffic along the A511 will be maintained under convoy and using traffic lights and delays may be experienced.

Access to Lountside will be maintained, but there may be periods of delay (up to 30mins) to access/exit, due to ongoing surfacing activities, but these will be kept to a minimum.

Please note that speed restrictions and diversion routes will be in place for the duration of the closure for both traffic and Public Transport Services. Please check with your local provider for any further information.
