### PROPOSAL TO ENLARGE THE PREMISES AND INCREASE THE CAPACITY OF ANSTEY THE LATIMER PRIMARY SCHOOL FROM 315 TO 420 PLACES BURBAGE SKETCHLEY HILL PRIMARY SCHOOL FROM 420 TO 630 PLACES DESFORD COMMUNITY PRIMARY SCHOOL FROM 315 TO 420 PLACES

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013 that Leicestershire County Council of County Hall, Glenfield, Leicester LE3 8RF proposes to enlarge the premises and increase the capacity of the following schools:

The Latimer Primary School (a Community School), Latimer Street, Anstey, Leicestershire LE7 7AW	315 to 420	45 to 60	New 2 classroom block and internal alterations to existing school
Sketchley Hill Primary School (a Community School), Sketchley Road, Burbage, Leicestershire LE10 2DY	420 to 630	60 to 90	Extension to existing school buildings and new classroom block
Desford Community Primary School (a Community School), Kirkby Road, Desford, Leicestershire LE9 9JH	315 to 420	45 to 60	New 2 classroom block

The increase to admission numbers at each school will initially apply to the reception year group only with the increased admission numbers then feeding through each school year on year. Until that time the schools shall retain their current admission numbers in other year groups.

It is proposed that the increases to the admission numbers will initially apply to any admissions into the reception year group commencing on or after Tuesday, 28th August 2018.
