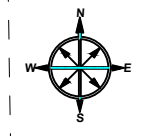

## STATEMENT OF REASONS

### LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

#### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 23

#### PUFFIN CROSSING, BOROUGH OF HINCKLEY AND BOSWORTH,

#### STOKE ROAD, HINCKLEY

Leicestershire County Council has received a request for a controlled crossing point outside the Dorothy Goodman School on Stoke Road. It has long been an accepted national practice to assess the justification for a pedestrian crossing using a calculation involving both pedestrian and vehicle flows. This evaluates the potential for conflict between vehicles and pedestrians. Having carried out the assessment the criteria is met for a puffin controlled pedestrian crossing.

The work will involve removing the existing pedestrian refuge, a footpath build out on the narrower east side to create a larger area for pedestrians to wait and be able to pass by each other with more ease, installation of traffic signal equipment, and associated signing/lining works.

Works are anticipated to last 3-4 weeks and will be mostly carried out on weekdays, during the off-peak period. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the duration of the works. It is inevitable that some inconvenience will be caused, but we will endeavour to keep any delays to a minimum.
