



Hinckley Zone 4 Cycle Signing

All improvements identified in the previous 1, 2, and 3 zones have been incorporated to make the route network connecting Hinckley, Barwell, and Earl Shilton. Each route has been designated by colour and will clearly be signed throughout that route, by its unique number along with localities by distance of minutes.



Route 1 connects the A5 via Dodwells roundabout along the A47, with its endpoint being Earl Shilton, travel is possible to Wykin, Stapleton, Stoke Golding, and Barwell along this route and is predominantly off-road throughout most of the route.



Route 2 also starts via the A5, and connects the B4666 Coventry Road to the B4667, with direct travel to the town centre. It remains predominantly off-road, with connection onto route 3.



Route 3 is a north to south route connecting the A47 through the town centre, and the middle of Burbage. The route will be signed with localities due to its proximity to other routes, and town centre, and also remains predominantly off-road.



Route 4 connects Barwell into Hinckley via travel under the A47. The route then connects onto Route 3 for travel into Hinckley town centre. This is a mixture of on and off-road cycling.



Route 5 is another north to south route, connecting the eastern sides of Hinckley and Barwell for travel towards Stoney Stanton and Aston Flamville. The route is largely based on-road with ease of connectivity onto other routes above.

Signing along the route

Each route will be clearly designated by its Route number and colour. Destinations will be signed by way of minutes and will include localities along each route. Cycling provisions which have been provided in previous zones 1, 2, and 3, but not part of a route network, will also have signs implemented. This will ensure that all improvements made to cycling around Hinckley, will be signed accordingly.
