This notice is to tell you about why we need your information and how we will handle it. This notice is for:

Environment and Transport Department – Grant Schemes

What Information do we need from you?

We need to know the following about you: your name, address, contact details, organisation financial details and details of the grant application.

Why do we need this?

We need this information so that we can:

- Provide information about grant opportunities to local community groups
- Process applications and award grants where successful
- Manage and monitor projects that are funded by successful applications

An evaluation form may be sent to successful and unsuccessful grant applicants as part of Leicestershire County Council's ongoing commitment to providing good customer service, and to help ensure that we are providing an efficient application system for the Grant schemes.

Why are we allowed to process your information?

Data protection law allows us to process your information within certain conditions. In this case we are using the compliance with a legal obligation as the lawful condition for us to do this.

No special/sensitive personal data will be processed as part of this service.

Who will we share this with?

Sometimes we need to share your information with others. We will only do this when it is necessary in order to offer you this service, or if we are required to do so by law. We do not plan to share it with anyone else or use it for anything else.

How will we keep it secure?

We will take all reasonable steps to prevent the loss, misuse or alteration of your personal information. Only the people who need to see your personal information will be allowed access to it. We will not send your information outside of the UK.

How long will we keep it for?

We will only keep this information for as long as necessary or as the law requires. Information from successful applications will normally be kept for 7 years. Information from unsuccessful applications will normally be kept for 2 years.

What if something changes?
