### PROPOSAL TO PROVIDE COMMUNICATION & INTERACTION (C&I) AND SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL & MENTAL HEALTH (SEMH) RESOURCE BASES AT THE MAINTAINED SCHOOLS BELOW AND EXPAND TWO MAINTAINED SPECIAL SCHOOLS TO INCREASE THEIR CAPACITY

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the Education and Inspections Act 2006 and The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013 (updated October 2018) that Leicestershire County Council of County Hall, Glenfield, Leicester LE3 8RF proposes to reconfigure existing space to provide resource bases at the schools detailed below and expand two special schools.
