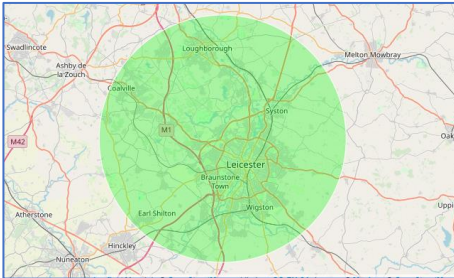


# A46/A5630 Anstey Lane Junction Improvement Scheme UPDATE January 2020

## Local Spend & Employment



Galliford Try have provided local employment and we have monitored and recorded our contract spend within a 10-mile radius of the A46 project.

**77% of subcontract value has been placed with the 10-mile radius.**  
**44% of materials are sourced within the 10-mile radius.**  
**31% of our employees including sub-contractors live within the 10-mile radius.**

### Work carried out in December 2019

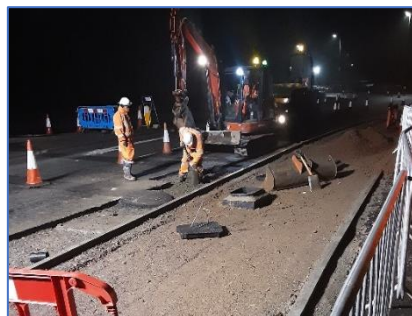


#### A46 Roundabout Works

The West bound entry slip main drainage installation and excavation progressed. The East bound exit slip embankment earthworks are complete and ready for trimming once the road construction is completed. On Leicester Road the new footpath and road widening has been constructed, with area prepared for surfacing in mid-January.

#### Anstey Lane Works Including Bennion Road Junction

We have continued work on the new road construction along Anstey Lane, installing capping for the new road. We have installed a temporary pedestrian footpath through the local Nature Reserve to allow pedestrian access along Anstey Lane.



### January 2020 planned works summary

#### A46 Eastbound exit slip

- Completion of drainage.
- Completion of new ducting.
- Surfacing to new widening.
- Raise levels in farmers field.

#### Leicester Road

- Surfacing to the new widened road section.

#### A46 Westbound entry slip/Gynsill Lane

- Completion of drainage.
- Completion of ducting.

#### Anstey Lane

- New dual carriageway kerbing.
- New carriageway construction completion.
- 

### January road closure details

#### Night shift road closures (between 20:00 & 06:00) (Sunday to Thursday only)

**A46 Eastbound exit slip, from 7<sup>th</sup> January to 28<sup>th</sup> February** – Diversion route to continue to A6 Roundabout and return on A46 Westbound back to Anstey Lane junction.

**A46 Westbound entry slip, from 19<sup>th</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> January** – Diversion route to take the A46 heading East to A6 Roundabout and return on A46 Westbound back to A50 junction.

**Leicester Road at A46 towards Anstey only, from 27<sup>th</sup> January to 29<sup>th</sup> January** – Diversion via A5630 Anstey Lane to A563 Krefeld Way, A563 Krefeld Way to Beaumont Leys Lane onto Ashton Green Road and Leicester Road. At Thurcaston, take Anstey Lane to Cropston Road and back to Leicester Road
