IN THE MATTER OF THE HEALTH PROTECTION (CORONAVIRUS, RESTRICTIONS) (ENGLAND) (NO. 3) REGULATIONS 2020

(THE "REGULATIONS")

PUBLIC NOTICE REGARDING RESTRICTIONS ON THE OPERATION OF A PREMISES.

- Please take note that, with effect from 6pm on 29th October 2020, <u>The Cardamom</u> <u>Lounge</u>, 58 Leicester Road, Narborough, LE19 2DG will have restrictions on its trading.
- 2. During the period of restriction, no customers will be allowed to enter onto the Premises unless they have previously made a valid booking and/or reservation and intend to dine within the Premises.
- No customers shall be allowed access to the Premises simply to order any food or pre-prepared meals to be consumed otherwise than on the Premises ('takeaway' meals).
- 4. Customers may enter the Premises to collect pre-ordered takeaway food. Such customers, herein after referred to as 'takeaway customers' must be seated in an area separate to that of the main diners.
- 5. No persons should be allowed to queue or mingle inside, the Premises or its curtilage. In particular, takeaway customers should not be permitted to mingle with those customers who constituted seated diners. The management of the premises must, at all times, manage and or otherwise control the movement of customers to ensure that this does not take place.
- These temporary restrictions are expected to last until <u>29th December 2020</u> but are subject to <u>weekly reviews.</u>
- 7. Upon the advice of the Director of Public Health, Leicestershire County Council has served a notice with the above restrictions due to the Covid 19 risks presented at the relevant premises.
- 8. Please take notice that it is an offence for a person, without reasonable excuse to contravene the requirements of a direction pursuant to the Regulations (see *Regulation 13*).
