

## Highways Act 1980

### The Leicestershire County Council (A606 North and East Melton Mowbray Distributor Road Classified Road) (Side Roads) Order 2020

The Leicestershire County Council (“the Council”) hereby give notice that they have made, and submitted to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation, an Order under Section 14 and Section 125 of the Highways act 1980 authorising the Council to:-

- (a) Improve highways (including raising, lowering or otherwise altering),
- (b) Stop up highways,
- (c) Construct new highways,
- (d) Stop up private means of access to premises
- (e) Provide new means of access to the said premises

All on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road known as A606 North and East Melton Mowbray Distributor Road which the Council are proposing to construct between the A606 Nottingham Road and the A606 Burton Road.

A copy of the order and of the accompanying plans may be inspected at [www.leics.gov.uk](http://www.leics.gov.uk) and free of charge at all reasonable hours by appointment due to Covid-19 restrictions at the offices of Leicestershire County Council, County Hall, Glenfield, Leicestershire, LE3 8RA and at the offices of Melton Borough Council, Burton Street, Melton Mowbray, Leicestershire LE13 1GH.

Any person may not later than 27<sup>th</sup> November 2020 object to the confirmation of the order by notice to the Secretary of State for Transport, Casework Team, Tyneside House, Skinnerburn Road, Newcastle Business Park, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE4 7AR stating the ground of their objection.

In submitting an objection it should be noted that your personal data and correspondence will be passed to the Council to enable your objection to be considered. If you do not wish your personal data to be forwarded, please state your reasons when submitting your objection and the Secretary of State will copy your representations, with your name and address removed to the Council, and if there is to be a Public Local Inquiry they will be seen by the Inspector who may give them less weight as a result.
