

**IN THE MATTER OF THE HEALTH PROTECTION (CORONAVIRUS, RESTRICTIONS)
(ENGLAND) (NO. 3) REGULATIONS 2020**

(THE “REGULATIONS”)

DIRECTION PLACING RESTRICTIONS ON THE OPERATION OF A PREMISES.

1. Please take note that, with effect from 7pm on 2 November 2020, the **The Black Dog** public house, at 23 London Road, Oadby, Leicestershire LE2 5DL, will have restrictions on its trading.
2. For the duration of this Direction, the maximum number of customers who may simultaneously occupy the inside of the Premises and seated at tables shall not exceed 110.
3. For the duration of this Direction no persons should be allowed to mingle inside the Premises or its curtilage with other customers outside of his or her group.
4. Live sport will only be shown on two television screens within the Premises and a booking system must be in place, allowing customers to reserve their seat at an allocated table, for all customers wishing to view live sport.
5. This temporary closure is expected to last until **2 January 2021** but it will be subject to **weekly reviews**.
6. Upon the advice of the Director of Public Health, Leicestershire County Council has served a notice with the above restrictions due to the Covid 19 risks presented at the relevant premises.
1. For the sake of good order, the direction should not be construed as any criticism of food hygiene or general cleanliness standards at the public house. These temporary restrictions relates exclusively to the management of Covid 19 risks.
7. Please take notice that it is an offence for a person, without reasonable excuse to contravene the requirements of a direction pursuant to the Regulations (see *Regulation 13*).
